Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 5 September 2020

I he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \(\) or news sources.

Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Dozens of Palestinians choked on tear-gas, as Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked the weekly demonstration, in the village of Kufur Qaddoum, east of Qalqilia, in the northern occupied West Bank. The IOA fired rubber-coated steel rounds and tear-gas at the protesters, which caused many civilians to suffer the toxic effects of tear-gas inhalation. (IMEMC 5 September 2020)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) shot and injured two Palestinian brothers during a search-and-arrest operation in Jenin refugee camp in the north of the occupied West Bank. The IOA opened live fire and injured the two brothers identified as Ahmad and Mohammad Jadoun, in their 20s, during a raid at their family home. The two were also detained by the army and were seen taken on stretchers and placed in an army ambulance before leaving the camp. One was shot in the neck and waist, and the other in the thigh. (WAFA 5 September 2020)
- The Israeli occupation police detained four Aqsa Mosque employees, one of them a female guard. Israeli police officers assaulted and detained Aqsa guard Hiba Sarhan after she prevented other officers from entering the Dome of the Rock building. The police also assaulted and detained three Aqsa employees after they intervened to defend Sarhan and prevent her arrest. They were identified as Imran al-Ashhab, Imad Abdeen and Bilal Awadallah. - Three Palestinian workers suffered bullet injuries near Hableh town in southern Qalqilya as they were on their way home from their workplaces in the 1948 occupied lands. The IOA opened fire at West Bank workers, injuring two of them in their legs and one in his face. (PALINFO 5 September 2020)

Israeli Military Orders

 The Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) are going to seize the ancient ruins of Deir Samaan, located northwest of the town of Kufr al-Dik, west of the northern West Bank city of Salfit. The IOA had published an announcement written in Hebrew declaring seizure of the site, which has an area of 6 dunums and 57 square meters, registered in plot No. 2 under the name of Khirbet Deir Samaan archaeological site. It is noteworthy that the occupation authorities recently began surrounding Deir Samaan ruins with settlement housing units, and placed a sign indicating a new settlement outpost called Leshem that will be built on the lands of the villages of Deir Ballut and Kufr al-Dik.
