## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

20 September 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the ath-Thahrat area, north of Douma village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and confiscated a bulldozer while Palestinian workers were preparing for paving a new road. The bulldozer is owned by Mousa Zeineddin, and that the IOA informed him that they will keep the bulldozer “until further notice.” The IOA claimed that the new road, which is intended to be used by the villagers to reach their lands, is in Area C of the occupied West Bank, under full Israeli control. - Israeli bulldozers destroyed 200 fruit trees, in the town of Bidya, west of Salfit, in the northern occupied West Bank. The uprooted fruitful trees, belonging to Salim Khalil, were a mix of olives, figs, grapes, peaches, lemons, and perennial almonds. Some of the trees were more than 2 decades old, the harvest being his sole source of income to provide for his family. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)

## Israeli Settler Violence

- Two Palestinians were assaulted by illegal Israeli settlers near al-Walaja village, west of Bethlehem, in the southern occupied West Bank. Several Israeli settlers attacked two brothers, Ashraft Mustafa Najjar, 43, and Muhmmad, 40, both residents of al-Azzeh refugee camp, causing various injuries. One of the two men suffered serious wounds and was rushed to a Bethlehem hospital. No further details were reported. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)
- Israeli settlers chopped dozens of olive trees in Al-Sawiyah village, south of Nablus, in the northern West Bank. Locals discovered that dozens of olive trees had been cut down by settlers from the nearby illegal Israeli settlement of “Rechalim”. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)
- Hordes of Jewish settlers stormed the courtyards of the holy Aqsa Mosque from the Magharaba Gate while Israeli police desecrated Al-Qibli Mosque

in response to the calls of the Temple groups to carry out large-scale incursions in conjunction with the so-called Hebrew New Year. Dozens of Jewish settlers broke into the Aqsa wearing their biblical clothing for their holiday. The Temple groups, which are affiliated with the so-called Union of Temple Organizations, are preparing to carry out a series of daily incursions into the Aqsa Mosque during the so-called Days of Repentance which last from Sunday until next Thursday according to the Hebrew calendar. During these days Jewish settlers plan to perform individual prayers and carry out the full prostration inside the holy Islamic site led by several rabbis of extremist groups under heavy police protection. ### **Israeli Military Orders**

- Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) ordered the expropriation of 803 dunams (198 acres) of Palestinian-owned land near Douma village, located south of Nablus in the northern occupied West Bank. The army delivered notices informing local villagers of the authorities decision to seize 803 dunams of Palestinian-owned land, under the pretext of groundwater drilling. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)

### **Confiscation & Razing of lands**

- Israeli bulldozers destroyed 200 fruit trees in the town of Bidya, west of Salfit, in the northern occupied West Bank. The uprooted fruitful trees, belonging to Salim Khalil, were a mix of olives, figs, grapes, peaches, lemons, and perennial almonds. Some of the trees were more than 2 decades old, the harvest being his sole source of income to provide for his family. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) confiscated a Palestinian-owned bulldozer in Duma village, south of Nablus. The IOA appropriated the bulldozer as it was working on an agricultural road under construction in al-Dahrat area of the village. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinian farmland to the east of Deir al-Balah in central Gaza Strip. The IOA disembarked from their armored vehicles and opened fire at the agricultural land. The IOA

Shooting aimed at forcing the farmers to leave their lands. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)

## Israeli Closures

- For the second day in a row, Israeli occupation authorities continue their closure of the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron City, south of the occupied West Bank, denying access of Muslim worshippers to the site due to the Jewish holidays. The Israeli occupation authorities closed the mosque on Saturday night in order to make way for Jewish settlers to celebrate Rosh Hashanah holiday, or the Jewish New Year. (WAFA 20 September 2021)
