Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) killed a Palestinian close to Beit Ur al-Tahta village, west of the West Bank city of Ramallah in the early hours of the day. The IOA gunned down 39-year-old Raed Jadallah from a distance at the western entrance of the village, and left him to bleed to death. Jadallah, a father of four children, was coming home from his work in the occupied city of Jerusalem and crossing one of the military-controlled crossing points when he was killed by the Israeli military, according to Beit Ur Municipality. (WAFA 1 September 2021)
- Dozens of Palestinian protesters suffered suffocation as Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked hundreds of protesters demonstrating for the second week at the east border of Gaza in protest of the 14-year Israeli blockade. The IOA stationed along the borderline opened gunfire and teargas at the protesters to disperse them, causing several cases of suffocation from gas inhalation. At least one fatality and 80 injuries have been reported among Palestinian protesters during the ongoing border protests during the last two weeks. (WAFA 1 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained the principal of a secondary school after storming the school campus in the East Jerusalem neighborhood of Wadi al-Joz, under the flimsy pretext of meeting personnel from the Palestinian Ministry of Education. While in the school campus, the police officers seized several computers and files as they ransacked the school buildings. (WAFA 1 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) rounded up two Palestinians after breaking into and ransacking the houses of their families in Beit Rima and Kobar towns, northwest and west of Ramallah city respectively. (WAFA 1 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at a Palestinian at a military checkpoint at the entrance of Ni'lin town, west of the city. The casualty was identified as a resident of the town. (WAFA 1 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) barged their way into Fandaqumiya village, southwest of the city, where they detained a woman. The detainee was identified as the wife of a prisoner from the nearby town of Jaba'. Another Palestinian was detained as he attempted to cross the Mavo Dothan checkpoint, southeast of Yaabad town. (WAFA 1 September 2021)

- In the southern West Bank, Israeli occupation Army (IOA) conducted a raid in the Bethlehem city neighborhood of As-Saff, resulting in the detention of two others. (WAFA 1 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot, three young men with live fire, and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, during protests near the perimeter fence, east of the al-Boreij refugee camp, in central Gaza. The IOA stationed behind sand hills, and in fortified military barricades in military camps across the fence, fired dozens of live rounds and high-velocity gas bombs at Palestinian protesters, near the fence, east of the refugee camp. The IOA also fired many flares while military drones also fired gas bombs at the protesters. Three young men were shot with live fire, including one who sustained life-threatening wounds, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to cuts and bruises. (MEMC 1 September 2021)
- A Palestinian was injured by Israeli military gunfire to the east of Absan al-Kabeera town, east of Khan Younis city in the southern besieged Gaza Strip. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stationed along the borderline in fortified positions and military vehicles, east of the town, opened fire at a youth in his 20s, hitting him with an “explosive” bullet in his left thigh. (WAFA 2 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) cracked down on an anti-blockade protest east of Rafah city in the southern Gaza Strip. The IOA and snipers, stationed along the borderline in their fortified positions, opened fire towards hundreds of Palestinians demanding an end to the crippling siege imposed on the coastal enclave, injuring dozens. A protestor sustained moderate wounds after being hit with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the chest and two others sustained light injuries due to being hit with tear gas shrapnel in the thigh and pelvis. In addition, dozens others suffocated from excessive tear gas inhalation. (WAFA 2 September 2021)
- The Israeli navy targeted Palestinian fishermen offshore As-Sudaniya area, northwest of Gaza city, and injured one. The fishermen were sailing within six nautical miles when Israeli naval boats opened gunfire toward them, injuring one in his foot and forcing the others to flee for safety. (WAFA 2 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the Young Muslim Women School in occupied Jerusalem, before detaining the principal, administrative employees, and confiscated computers. Dozens of IOA and, border police officers internal security agents broke into the school, under the pretext that one of its rooms is used as an office for

the Palestinian Education Ministry. Dozens of students were in the school, including its yards when the soldiers surrounded and invaded it. During the invasion, the army detained the school principal, and several administrative employees, in addition to summoning many other employees for interrogation, and confiscating dozens of files.(IMEMC 2 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured many Palestinians during a procession on Palestinian lands near the perimeter fence, east of Rafah, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip. The IOA stationed in their fortified positions and behind dunes across the fence, fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the protesters. A young man was shot with rubber-coated steel bullets in the chest, and suffered moderate wounds. Another young man was shot with a high-velocity gas bomb in the pelvis, and a third was shot in the thigh. Many Palestinians also suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to various cuts and bruises. The IOA also fired many flares, in addition to using many surveillance drones. (IMEMC 2 September 2021)
- At least 70 Palestinians were injured by the Israeli occupation army during clashes at Jabal Sabih mount, near the village of Beita in the occupied West Bank. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) fired live gunfire, rubber-coated rounds and stun grenades at the protesters, injuring 70 of them, including 12 with rubber-coated steel rounds. Some of the protesters also sustained injuries after falling on the ground while being chased by soldiers. Meantime, some 51 protesters sustained suffocation from teargas inhalation. An ambulance was also hit with Israeli teargas canisters that smashed the front windshields. (WAFA 3 September 2021)
- A Palestinian young man has died from serious wounds he suffered after Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked protesters on Palestinian lands near the perimeter fence, in the northern part of the Gaza Strip. The young man, identified as Ahmad Mustafa Mahmoud Saleh, 26, from Jabalia refugee camp, in the northern part of the Gaza Strip, was shot by the IOA near the perimeter fence, east of the refugee camp. The IOA fired live rounds and high-velocity gas bombs at Palestinian protesters along the perimeter fence, in the eastern parts of the Gaza Strip, wounding fifteen Palestinians, among them five children including one who sustained life-threatening wounds. (IMEMC 3 September 2021)

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked Palestinian students as they were on their way to their schools in Shufat refugee camp, north of occupied East Jerusalem. The IOA raided the camp provoking clashes with the residents. The forces fired tear gas canisters and sound bombs at the students and homes in the camp causing several cases of suffocation from inhaling the gas. (Wafa 4 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) injured several Palestinians during the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum town, east of Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The IOA fired many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the protesters. It added that a young man was shot with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the head, and was rushed to a hospital in Qalqilia. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, cuts, and bruises,
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained, a young man identified as Mohammad Khader Abu al-Hummus, during a nonviolent activity against the Israeli attempts to remove and displace the Palestinian families from their homes in Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood, in occupied Jerusalem. Mohammad is from the al-'Isawiya town, in Jerusalem. (IMEMC 4 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked a group of Palestinians who were protesting the Israeli settlement expansion in Beita village, wounding at least 20. The soldiers also opened fire on four ambulances carrying people who had been wounded by army fire. Fifty more Palestinians suffered from tear gas inhalation. 20 civilians were wounded by rubber-coated metal bullets, and over a hundred Palestinian civilians suffered from tear gas inhalation as a result of the Israeli forces firing tear gas canisters, in addition to the use of unmanned drone aircraft to stop teargas canisters into the crowd. Among those who suffered from tear gas inhalation were a number of medics who were targeted while treated the wounded. (IMEMC 4 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked a group of journalists covering a protest in the South Hebron Hills several days ago, with one of the IOA telling the reporters as they seized their cameras and took them into custody that the army had orders to “go after journalists. The IOA arrested seven Palestinian journalists who were reporting on a non-violent protest against illegal settlements in the South Hebron Hills in the West Bank. Journalists were cuffed and taken to a police

station where they were later released. Mashour Wahwah, one of the detained journalists, stated that he was photographing the Israeli military abducting several Palestinian youth, but that there had been no confrontations and the army did not need to use any riot control measures. (IMEMC 4 September 2021)

- A Palestinian farmer was injured by Israeli gunfire during his presence in an agricultural area in the southeast of Gaza City. The Israeli occupation Army opened fire at a group of farmers as they were working their lands in the east of Juhor ad-Dick neighborhood, south of Gaza City. A 19-year-old farmer suffered a bullet injury in the shooting attack. His injury was moderate. Under an inhumane siege, the Israeli army keeps attacking— sometimes injuring or killing — civilians, farmers and fishermen almost on a daily basis, without any shred of respect for any ceasefire deal in Gaza or even the international law. (PALINFO 5 September 2021).
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) fired missiles, at two sites in the southern Gaza Strip, causing property damage. Israeli fighter jets invaded Palestinian airspace and struck two sites to the west of Khan Younis. The Israeli bombardment caused damage to civilian property, but there were no human casualties. (IMEMC 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) fired stun and tear gas grenades as they stormed a school forcing the town's school administration to evacuate the students from the school during their raid into the town of Zita. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- Hundreds of Israeli occupation Army (IOA) invaded dozens of areas across the Jenin governorate, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and conducted extensive searches. Dozens of IOA invaded the Arraba Medow area, south of Jenin, and conducted searches in Palestinian lands and communities, in addition to surrounding all nearby villages and towns, close to the illegal Annexation Wall. The IOA also invaded Arabbuna village, northeast of Jenin, before storming and ransacking dozens of homes. Dozens of IOA also invaded Aneen village, west of Jenin, and conducted massive searches of homes and lands, especially in areas close to the illegal Annexation Wall. Similar invasions and searches were also carried out, for the second consecutive day, in Faquq'a village, northeast of Jenin. The IOA also invaded and searched mountains near Faquq'a, in addition to stopping and interrogating dozens of residents while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)

- Israel decided to ban Muslims from praying at the Ibrahimi Mosque in the southern West Bank city of Hebron, citing the Jewish New Year as a pretext, while it will be open only for Jews. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) denied Palestinians access to the holy site along with its courtyards as the illegal settlers were preparing to mark the Jewish New Year holiday. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians after the army attacked nonviolent protesters in a protest tent in the at-Tiwana village, southeast of Yatta town, south of Hebron, in southern West Bank, and detained an elderly man and a journalist. The Palestinians, and international peace activists, were protesting the illegal Israeli colonialist activities and the escalating assaults by the settlers against the Palestinians, their homes, and lands. The IOA fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades, in addition to assaulting the nonviolent protesters with batons. The IOA also attacked many Palestinian journalists, including cameraman Mosab Shawar, who was also detained by the army, to force them away, in addition to assaulting the head of the Colonization & Wall Resistance Commission, Walid Assaf. The IOA also attacked and detained an elderly man, identified as Suleiman Hathalin, in addition to assaulting his relative Mohammad Hathalin, and several international peace activists, before holding them for about an hour. The IOA closed the entire area of al-Hamra, east of the at-Tiwana to prevent the Palestinians from entering it, especially since Israeli settlers from Ma'on and Havat Ma'on colonies, are ongoing with their attempts to occupy a Palestinian irrigation well and the surrounding Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured, several Palestinians in Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded the town and harassed several Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. The incident led to protests, before the IOA fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades at the protesters and surrounding homes, causing many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stopped many young Palestinian men in Bab al-'Amoud area in Jerusalem and interrogated them while examining their ID cards. The IOA also closed many roads in and

around Silwan as dozens of colonialist settlers were marching while waving Israeli flags. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the Wadi Maali area, in the center of Bethlehem city, before storming and ransacking a home, owned by Hasan Shouka. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)
- A young man was shot with live fire in the leg, near the junction of Beita town, southeast of Nablus in the northern West Bank. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot seven Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets, and caused more than seventeen to suffer the severe effects of tear gas inhalation. The IOA shot two Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused 72 to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation near Huwwara junction, south of Nablus. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Mohammad Mousa al-Abbassi from the courtyard of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, in occupied Jerusalem. Mohammad is a former political prisoner from Silwan town, in Jerusalem. Protests also took place in the al-Isawiya and the at-Tour towns, in Jerusalem, before the IOA fired many gas bombs at protesters and surrounding homes, causing several injuries. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians, and detained one, during protests in Arraba town, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. The IOA also invaded orchards and farmlands and conducted extensive searches. Many Israeli army jeeps invaded Arraba town, leading to protests, and fired a barrage of gas bombs, concussion grenades, rubber-coated steel bullets, and live rounds. Dozens of Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, and many sustained cuts and bruises. The IOA also invaded and ransacked several homes in the town. In addition, the IOA installed a military roadblock at the junction of Arraba town, before stopping and searching dozens of cars, and detained a young man, identified as Ezzeddin Marzouq, who is studying medicine at a university in Jenin. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked a nonviolent procession at the northern entrance of Bethlehem city, south of the occupied capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Dozens of residents marched from Bab Zqaq area, in the center of the city, and headed towards Bethlehem's

northern road, protesting the escalating Israeli violations against the detainees. The IOA fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades at the protesters, causing dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians, including a child, in Beit Ummar town, north of the southern West Bank city of Hebron, after the army attacked protesters who marched in solitary with the detainees in Israeli prisons. The Palestinians marched towards the northern entrance of the town before the IOA attacked them with live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. Several youngsters hurled stones at the soldiers who fired additional gas bombs and live rounds. Dozens of Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to cuts and bruises. A child, only eight years of age, suffered various wounds from fragments of a bullet while she was in her home in the town. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)
- In Nablus, in northern West Bank, the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) injured 174 Palestinians, including many who were shot with the rubber-coated steel bullets, in addition to those who suffered fractures and bruises after the army attacked processions in several parts of the governorate. The injuries took place when the IOA attacked protesters in Beita, Osarin, and Huwwara, south of Nablus, in addition to Beit Dajan, east of the city. Four Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, four suffered burns due to gas bombs and concussion grenades, in addition to thirty suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation near Huwwara military roadblock, close to Huwwara village. Eighteen Palestinians, including one journalist, were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, 97 suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, and 18 suffered burns and bruises, during protests in Sbeih Mountain in Beita town. Two other Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets in Osarin village, and one in Beit Dajan. It is worth mentioning that the IOA fired gas bombs at two ambulances belonging to the Palestinian Red Crescent Society (PRCS) and the Palestinian Medical Relief Society (PMRS), causing damage. (IMEMC 10 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) injured four Palestinians and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, in Kufur Qaddoum east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, during the weekly processions. Dozens of Palestinians marched towards the town's blockaded main road before the IOA started firing at them. The

IOA shot three young men with rubber-coated steel bullets, and caused many others to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation.

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked Palestinian protesters at the northern road of Azzoun town east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, and fired many rubber-coated steel bullets and gas bombs at them, wounding a young man with a rubber-coated steel bullet. The Israeli army also installed many roadblocks on all roads leading to Qalqilia city and surrounding villages and towns, leading to protests. (IMEMC 10 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) fired at Palestinian protesters close to al-Jalama military checkpoint injuring a young man. A confrontation took place near the checkpoint between the IOA and Palestinian youths. One Palestinian youth was injured in his leg by a rubber-coated metal bullet and transferred to hospital. (PALINFO 10 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation police broke into the Aqsa Mosque's courtyards in Jerusalem and quelled a march supporting Palestinian prisoners. Dozens of Israeli policemen stormed the holy Islamic site and were deployed near the Dome of the Rock and Bab el-Rahma in a bid to disperse a peaceful march in support of the prisoners, who are being violently quelled by the Israeli prison service. (PALINFO 10 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) broke into a number of houses in Bethlehem. The IOA raided several houses in Hindaza area and wreaked havoc on their furniture and citizens' property. The IOA also broke into a building in Jabal al-Mawaleh in central Bethlehem. (PALINFO 10 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained former Palestinian prisoners from Ya'bad village, west of Jenin in the northern occupied West Bank. The IOA detonated the gate of the home of Majd Ba'jawi, a former prisoner, confiscating seven cell phones which are owned by relatives of Ba'jawi's. The IOA stormed the homes of Amjad Hamarsheh, and Asa'd Qinari and detained them. The IOA invaded the home of Wahid Nifia't, and held him for a few hours before releasing him. (IMEMC 11 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained Muhammed al-Hmood from Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the southern West Bank, during confrontations with the occupation army. (IMEMC 11 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained seven Palestinian members of the Jabbarin family, while they were visiting the town of Sa'ir, in Hebron, in the southern West Bank, taking them to an unknown location. (Wafa, IMEMC 11 September 2021)
- Israeli aircraft fired missiles at several locations in the besieged Gaza Strip, causing damage. The occupation targeted sites west of Khan Younis, in the southern Gaza Strip, with two missiles, causing damage to the site and civilian homes. Israeli warplanes also fired a missile at a site in Deir al-Balah in the central Gaza Strip, causing damage to the site and adjacent civilian homes. In the north, at least one missile was fired at farm land east of Beit Hanoun town, there were no reports of any casualties. (Wafa, IMEMC 11 September 2021)
- Israeli authorities sent heavy equipment to the Gaza border to reinforce sections of the concrete Wall that had been exposed to a fire two years ago. The area that is being reinforced is at the entrance to the Israeli colonial settlement called "Kibbutz Erez", which is located next to the Israel-Gaza border. (IMEMC 12 September 2021)
- The Israeli air force fired several missiles into different parts of the besieged Gaza Strip. Israeli warplanes fired three missiles east of Al-Bureij refugee camp in the central Gaza Strip, causing major damage to the site, and nearby civilian homes. Israeli airstrikes caused damage to a seafront road in Rafah, and a site west of Khan Younis city, in the southern coastal enclave, causing damage, but no casualties. (IMEMC 12 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) announced the closure of the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron City to Muslim worshipers for one day to allow Jewish settlers to celebrate a religious event. The IOA tightened its military measures at the entrances to the Old City at the pretext of securing the place for Jewish celebrations. The IOA informed him of its intent to close the entire Mosque with its courtyards, corridors and buildings until 03:00 am on Monday. This was the second Israeli closure of the Ibrahimi Mosque during the current month. It was closed to Muslim worshipers on September 7 on allegations of allowing Jewish settlers to mark the new Hebrew year. (PALINFO 12 September 2021)
- Israeli warplanes bombed different areas of the besieged Gaza Strip, with no reported casualties. A warplane fired multiple missiles at a site near al-Maghazi camp in central Gaza. Another aerial attack targeted a site in Ein Jalut area in the west of Khan Yunis, south of Gaza. Several

air raids also targeted a site on the coastal road in the west of Rafah and destroyed a poultry farm in as-Salam neighborhood in Rafah near the border with Egypt. The aerial aggression only caused material damage to the bombed sites. (PALINFO 12 September 2021)

- Dozens of Palestinian citizens suffered from their exposure to tear gas during violent clashes with the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) in the refugee camps of al-Fawwar and al-Arroub in Hebron. Clashes broke out between local youths and Israeli occupation Army (IOA) at the main entrances to al-Fawwar and al-Arroub camps.
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked dozens of students after they organized a march in Teqoa town, southeast of Bethlehem, in solidarity with the six prisoners who recently escaped from Gilboa jail. One Palestinian was hurt when the IOA attacked the march with tear gas and stun grenades, adding that the IOF closed the northern entrance to the town. (PALINFO 12 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained two Palestinian children in Ni'lin village, west of the central West Bank city of Ramallah. Several army jeeps invaded the village before the IOA attacked Palestinians on their farmlands and detained two children. The IOA detained Mohammad Saleh Amira, 16, and Mustafa Khalil Amira, 14, and took them to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a man, identified as Mohammad Abdul-Qader Amira, after invading and ransacking his home in Ni'lin, in addition to confiscating computers and mobile phones. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured 30 Palestinians, including ten who were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, during a procession in solidarity with the Palestinian detainees, near the Huwwara military roadblock, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The Palestinians marched while carrying Palestinian flags, and chanted for liberation, independence, and the release of all political prisoners from Israeli prisons. The IOA shot ten Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets. About 20 other Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. One male journalist and one woman were also among the injured Palestinians. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) assaulted and detained two young Palestinian men near Bab Hutta, one of the gates of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem. The IOA

stopped the Palestinians while walking in the area, and repeatedly assaulted them, causing cuts and bruises. The two young men, identified as Sami Fteha and Mohammad Shalabi, were taken to a detention and interrogation facility in Jerusalem. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) installed a military roadblock at the western entrance of Beit Fajjar town, south of Bethlehem, before stopping and searching dozens of cars, and interrogated the Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot and seriously injured a young Palestinian man near Etzion Block junction, south of Bethlehem, in the occupied West Bank. The army also assaulted the wounded Palestinian man. The IOA fired several live rounds at the young man, identified as Mohammad Kamal Thawabta, from Beit Fajjar town, south of Bethlehem. After shooting the young man, the IOA and the settlers assaulted him, causing further injuries. The army also closed the area to all Palestinian traffic, before more troops arrived at the scene. Palestinian medics rushed to the area, but the IOA prevented them from reaching the wounded man. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured 30 Palestinians, including ten who were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, during a procession in solidarity with the Palestinian detainees, near the Huwwara military roadblock, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The Palestinians were marching while carrying Palestinian flags, and chanted for liberation, independence, and the release of all political prisoners from Israeli prisons. The IOA shot ten Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and about 20 other Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. One male journalist and one woman were also among the injured Palestinians. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) assaulted and detained two young Palestinian men near Bab Hutta, one of the gates of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem. The IOA stopped the Palestinians while walking in the area, and repeatedly assaulted them, causing cuts and bruises. The two young men, identified as Sami Fteha and Mohammad Shalabi, were taken to a

detention and interrogation facility in Jerusalem. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) installed a military roadblock at the western entrance of Beit Fajjar town, south of Bethlehem, before stopping and searching dozens of cars, and interrogated the Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot and seriously a Palestinian teen in Jaffa Street, in occupied Jerusalem. The Palestinian has been identified as Basel Shawamra, 17, from Doura town, south of Hebron city in the southern part of the West Bank. The Palestinian is in a serious condition. He suffered gunshot wounds to the upper and lower body. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained three Palestinian children in the at-Tour town, east of occupied East Jerusalem, and stormed the al-Makassed Hospital. The IOA attacked dozens of Palestinian protesters in the town and detained three children who remained unidentified at the time of this report. The invasion and the detention of the children took place during protests which took place shortly after an Israeli settlers rammed a young man with his car. Several Palestinians were injured during the invasion, and the IOA also invaded the al-Makassed Hospital looking for wounded Palestinians. In addition, a Palestinian woman, identified as Raghda Abu al-Hawa, was shot by the IOA with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the head when they invaded the town and was rushed to the al-Makassed hospital. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Silwan town, in Jerusalem, and fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at Palestinians who protested the invasion, causing several injuries. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- The Israeli Airforce fired, several missiles into several areas in several parts of the Gaza Strip, causing damage. The Israeli F16 jets fired two missiles into a site east of Beit Lahia, in northern Gaza, destroying it, in addition to causing damage and fire to surrounding homes and property. The army also fired three missiles into another site, east of Rafah, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip, causing damage. Furthermore, the Israeli Airforce carried out two strikes targeting sites

in Khan Younis, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip, causing serious damage. The army also fired three missiles into a building, west of Deir al-Balah, in central Gaza Strip, causing damage to the targeted structure and nearby homes. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)

- Dozens of young men torched tires on roads and hurled stones at the IOA near the Qalandia checkpoint in northern Jerusalem. Local youths also clashed with police forces who stormed the east Jerusalem cities of Silwan and Issawiya. One young man was reportedly detained by police officers from his home in Issawiya. (PALINFO 13 September 2021)
- In Jenin, a young man suffered a rubber bullet injury during clashes with the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) near the Jalamah checkpoint in the north of the City, while the IOA came under fire after they stormed Kafr Dan town in the west of Jenin. (PALINFO 13 September 2021)
- In Hebron city, The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked many schoolchildren at the Abu ar-Reesh military roadblock to the west of the Ibrahimi Mosque, leading to protests. The IOA fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at the schoolchildren, causing dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. In addition, the IOA attacked dozens of nonviolent protesters, who marched in solidarity with the detainees in Israeli prisons, in Sa'ir town, northeast of Hebron. The IOA fired many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the protesters near bypass road #60, west of Sa'ir. The IOA shot two Palestinians with gas bombs, and two with rubber-coated steel bullets, in addition to causing dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 14 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a child, identified as Ghada Kamel Kawazba, 15, and took her to a nearby military base. (IMEMC 14 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured several Palestinian schoolchildren after several army jeeps invaded Tayasir village, east of Tubas, in northeastern West Bank. 30 schoolchildren suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. The incident took place after several Israeli army jeeps invaded the village, and headed towards the local government-run Secondary Boys School and surrounded it. The IOA fired many gas bombs into the school and its surrounding area, causing at least thirty children to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 14 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained, a young Palestinian man from his home in the al-Isawiya town, in occupied Jerusalem, just two hours after his release from prison after spending more than 6 years in captivity. The IOA invaded the home of Amer Obeid, after surrounding the entire area, and detained him before moving him to an interrogation facility in Jerusalem. The detained Palestinian served of prison sentenced of 6.5 years, before he was released and went home, however, just a few hours later, the IOA invaded the property and detained him, and his father. A day earlier, the IOA invaded Obeid's home, searched the property, and confiscated posters in and around the property, welcoming Amer back home. (IMEMC 14 September 2021)
- Undercover Israeli occupation Army (IOA) and a regular army unit invaded, the Saff Street, in the center of Bethlehem city, south of occupied Jerusalem, and detained A Palestinian woman to pressure her husband to turn himself in to the army. Hours after the IOA detained his wife, *Hasan Shouka, 33, has turned himself in to the Israeli army, hoping that the IOA would release her.* The IOA detained Sharihan Shouka, 33, the wife of Hasan Shouka, after invading and ransacking their home. The IOA surrounded the entire area, looking for Hasan, but could not find him, and detained his wife instead. Hasan Shouka is a former political prisoner who was held by Israel for more than 13 years. He and his wife have a son and a daughter. Hasan was only released from prison three months ago, after spending 20 months in captivity, however, not long after his release, the IOA started invading and ransacking his home while trying to detain him. The army also detained a few of his relatives to pressure him to turn himself in to the army, and now detained his wife, in an act of collective punishment against the entire family. (IMEMC 14 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) shot a young Palestinian man during a protest near Dotan military roadblock, close to Ya'bad town, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. Dozens of Palestinians marched in solidarity with the detainees, held by Israel, chanted for their release, and the establishment of an independent, sovereign Palestinian state. The IOA fired live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs at the protesters. One Palestinian was mildly injured after the IOA shot him with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the leg. Moreover, the IOA detained a young man near the Salem military base, west of Jenin. (IMEMC 14 September 2021)

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) raided Tayasir village in Tubas and fired tear gas canisters at Tayasir secondary school students. At least 30 injuries within the students during the raid, some of the injuries were transferred to the hospital. (PALINFO 14 September 2021)
- At least 10 Palestinian citizens were injured by rubber bullets when the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked a march in southern Nablus staged in solidarity with the Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails. The Palestinians were protesting and walked towards Huwara checkpoint in southern Nablus when the IOA started attacking them. Consequently, 10 citizens, including a journalist and a woman, suffered from rubber bullet injuries. Many others also suffered from their exposure to tear gas. Meanwhile, violent clashes broke out on the same day between Palestinian youths and the IOA at the Jalamah checkpoint in western Jenin. (PALINFO 14 September 2021)
- A Palestinian man, identified as Mofeed Sharabati, 55, stated that Israeli occupation Army (IOA) refused to allow him to reach his home in the surrounded and isolated Shuhada Street, in the southern West Bank city of Hebron, and has to sleep on the side of the road. Sharabati lives in the Shuhada Street area in the center of Hebron city, where the IOA are always deployed and have a permanent military roadblock. The IOA stopped him at the roadblock, and refused to allow him through, and after several hours of holding him and many other Palestinians at the roadblock, the IOA allowed everybody through except him. It is worth mentioning that the Israeli army closed the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron, and installed additional military roadblocks to prevent the Palestinians from moving around during the Jewish holidays. (IMEMC 15 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a university student, identified as Ja'far Aziz Kayed, from his home in Ramallah, in central West Bank. Kayed is still recovering from a surgery he underwent four days ago, and he is a student at Birzeit University. (IMEMC 15 September 2021)
- At least 22 Palestinian young men suffered injuries during violent clashes with the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the Huwara checkpoint, south of Nablus. Four young men suffered from rubber bullet injuries, 16 from tear gas and two had fall injuries during the events. (PALINFO 15 September 2021)
- In Bethlehem, several young men suffered from their exposure to tear gas during similar clashes at the northern entrance to the City. (PALINFO 15 September 2021)

- Clashes took place between local youths and The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) at the Jalamah checkpoint and on the road near the settlement of Dotan in Jenin. Dozens of young men rallied in solidarity with the Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails in these two areas, where they torched tires and hurled stones at soldiers and their vehicles. (PALINFO 15 September 2021)
- A large number of Israeli troops stormed Ya'bad town and Araqah village in Jenin and carried out a large-scale search campaign. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) kidnaped two young men identified as Nazal Jamal and Mahmoud Aziz from their homes in Ya'bad town. (PALINFO 15 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Qarawat Bani Hassan town, west of Salfit in central West Bank, fired gas bombs, and assaulted a man, causing various injuries.(IMEMC 16 September 2021)
- An infant girl, only four months of age, was among many Palestinians who suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation after The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Ya'bad town, southwest of Jenin, broke into homes, and attacked protesters. The IOA invaded the town, before storming and ransacking several homes in the Abu Shamla neighborhood, and interrogated the families, in addition to inspecting recordings of surveillance cameras. The invasion led to protests before the IOA fired a barrage of gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters and surrounding homes. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, among them an infant, identified as Sila Sami Abu Bakr, only four months of age. (IMEMC 16 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked Palestinian protesters near the al-Jalama military roadblock, northeast of Jenin, in northern West Bank, and invaded several villages and towns in the area. Dozens of Palestinians marched in solidarity with the detainees in Israeli prisons and chanted for liberation and independence before the IOA attacked them with live gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets. Several Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 16 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded many villages and towns, especially Ya'bad, 'Aneen, Taybeh, Rommana, and Faququ'a, near the illegal Annexation Wall in Jenin, looking for Ayham Kamaji from Kafr Dawn, and Monadel 'Obeidat from Ya'bad. The IOA also invaded several areas in the western part of Ya'bad, in addition to installing

roadblocks, before stopping and searched dozens of cars and interrogated scores of Palestinians. (IMEMC 16 September 2021)

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) were deployed in the vicinity of Teqoa secondary school, in Teqoa village in eastern Bethlehem. The IOA obstructed the education process in the village and confrontations erupted between the soldiers and school students. The occupation forces raided the school and fired rubber-coated metal bullets and tear gas at the students, one of them was hit with a rubber bullet in his foot while others suffered breathing problems. (PALINFO 16 September 2021)
- Five activists from the Combatants for Peace Movement and a journalist were injured and more than seven other activists were detained when Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked a convoy delivering water to a Palestinian family from Al-Tiwani village in Masafer Yatta, south of Hebron, on Friday 17.09.2021. Two were moderately injured and were moved to a local hospital in Hebron, and three others suffered tear gas inhalation. Adam Rabie was among those injured who sustained injuries in his stomach when the IOA fired a tear gas canister directly at him. The convoy of activists set out from the village of at-Tiwani towards the family home of a local farmer, Abu Hani, to deliver water to the property because the family has no running water due to Israeli violations and restrictions. The IOA then stopped the convoy, assaulted the activists, and detained seven of them. The IOA also fired a barrage of stun grenades and tear gas and forced the participants to return, without allowing the water to reach the Palestinian family. (IMEMC 17 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured several nonviolent protesters and detained others, in a procession in the al-Mafqara village, east of Yatta town, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The IOA assaulted the nonviolent protesters with gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets. One woman, identified as Kholoud Abu Ra'eyya, was shot with a gas bomb in her back, and a man was shot with a gas bomb in the abdomen. Several protesters suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to cuts and bruises. The IOA also detained several nonviolent activists and fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at journalists reporting on the procession. (IMEMC 17 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked a Palestinian wedding in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank, causing

several injuries. The IOA attacked a wedding celebration near Tareq Bin Ziad Square, in the southern part of Hebron city, and fired several gas bombs. several Palestinians, including children, suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation.

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained, a Palestinian child and assaulted his father while they were planting vegetables in their hothouse, in Beit Ummar town, north of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The IOA invaded an agricultural hothouse in the Khamat al-Katla area in Beit Ummar, and detained a child, identified as Mohammad Walid Sabarna, 15, after assaulting him, causing injuries. The IOA assaulted the child's father when trying to defend his son, and fired live rounds near his legs. The IOA took the detained child to a military base in the nearby Karmie Tzur settlement. (IMEMC 17 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Qarawat Bani Hassan town, west of Salfit in central West Bank, before storming and searching two homes, owned by Abeed Omar Rayyan, 35, and Talhami Rayyan, 50. (IMEMC 17 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the area near the Ibrahim Mosque in the Old City of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank and detained two Palestinian siblings, identified as Shadi Hasan al-Mohtaseb, 38. And his brother Abdullah, 22. The incident took place after a group of Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian homes in the area, while the IOA stood and watched, before attacking the Palestinians, instead of removing the Israeli settlers, and detained the two siblings. The attacked homes are owned and inhabited by Palestinians from the local families of al-Mohtaseb, al-Beitar, Qfeisha, and Abu Hadid. Several Palestinians were injured in the attack, mainly suffering various lacerations and bruises. It is worth mentioning that the IOA also caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation near the permanent military roadblock at the entrance of Shuhada Street in Hebron. The Israeli gas bombs also forced all Palestinian shops and stores in the area to close. (IMEMC 18 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot several Palestinians, and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, during protests in Beita and Beit Dajan towns, south, and east of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The IOA shot five Palestinians with rubber-

coated steel bullets, including two who were shot in the head, and one who was shot with a sponge-tipped bullet to the head, in Beita. Among the wounded is a photojournalist, identified as Ala' Badarna, who was shot with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the chest. Three Palestinians were injured after falling while the IOA were chasing them, in addition to 63 who suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. The IOA shot two Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets, and caused 27 to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, in Beit Dajan. (IMEMC 18 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked many Palestinian protesters near the al-Jalama military roadblock, northeast of Jenin, in northern West Bank. Dozens of Palestinians marched towards the roadblock while chanting against the ongoing Israeli settlement activities, its escalating violations against the Palestinians, including the political prisoners. The IOA fired many gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters; there have been no immediate reports of injuries. (IMEMC 19 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained two young men, identified as Yazan Eshteyya and Osama Mojahed, in Bab as-Sahera, in occupied Jerusalem. (IMEMC 19 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained four young Palestinian men after Israeli settlers assaulted them along with three women, in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The Palestinians were walking in the Sahla neighborhood, near the Ibrahimi Mosque in the center of Hebron city, when a group of Israeli settlers attacked them. The settlers assaulted four young men, and three women, including an elderly woman, and struck them with batons and rifle-butts, causing many cuts and bruises. The Palestinians tried to defend themselves before the IOA arrived at the scene, attacked and detained the four young men, identified as Mohammad Fawwaz Qfeisha, 20, Dia' Tareq Qfeisha, 24, Fawzi Sa'adi Rajabi, and his brother Mohammad. The women who were assaulted by the settlers have been identified as Roweida Abdul-Mo'ti Qfeisha, Lobna Jamil Qfeisha, and her sister Maleka. (IMEMC 19 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) assaulted and kidnaped four Palestinian young men from a neighborhood near the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron City. A group of Israeli settlers and IOA savagely beat four

young men, two young women and one elderly woman from the family of Qafisha in as-Sahla neighborhood. The young men and women suffered injuries and bruises during the assault. The detained young men were identified as Mohamed Fawwaz, Diaa Tareq, Fawzi Saadi and his brother Mohamed. The young women are Lubna and Malika Jamil (sisters) and the elderly is Ruwaida Abdul-Muti. (PALINFO 19 September 2021)

- Israeli police forces rounded up two Jerusalemite young men during their presence in Bab al-Sahira area in the Old City. They were identified as Yazan Ashti and Osamah Mujahed. (PALINFO 19 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Bani Neim town, east of the southern West Bank city of Hebron, and stormed a home, before detaining one Palestinian, and confiscated 150.000 Shekels from his property. The IOA invaded and ransacked the home of Monir Farah Manasra, 47, before detaining him. The IOA confiscated 150.000 Shekels (approximately \$46,650) from the property. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young Palestinian man, and summoned his brother for interrogation, in Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded the Abu Njeim area, east of Bethlehem, before storming the home of Ibrahim Hreimi, and abducted his son Sami, 18. The IOA also summoned Sami's brother, Nouredin, for interrogation at the military crossing #300 near Bethlehem. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) fired at Gaza farmers and fishermen in eastern and western Gaza city. The IOA navy boats fired at Palestinian fishing boats off Beit Lahia and al-Sudaniyya, to the northwest of Gaza Strip, forcing them to return ashore. Meanwhile, the IOA fired tear gas canisters at bird catchers in the eastern border of Central Gaza. The IOA also fired live bullets at Palestinian farmers and shepherds in al-Fukhari village, in eastern Khan Yunus, forcing them to leave the area out of fear for their lives. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- The Israel occupation Army (IOA) detained ex-prisoner Abdel Naser al-Rabi In Qalqilya. The Palestinian Information Center, after storming and searching his house. He spent more than 7 years in total at Israeli jail. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)

- In Tulkarem, The Israel occupation Army (IOA) detained Baraa' Mazeed, Yusuf Hannun and Tamer Nassar, after storming and searching their houses. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- In Ramallah, The Israel occupation Army (IOA) raided Beit Rima village and arrested Khair al-Rimawi after storming and searching his house. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- The Israel occupation Army (IOA) raided Ein Yabroud village and detained Muhammed al-Ammori for hours. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- In Bethlehem, The Israel occupation Army (IOA) arrested Sami al-Herimi, 18, and summoned his brother for investigation after raiding their house. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- Palestinian youths clashed with Israeli occupation forces (IOF) close to Mevo Dotan checkpoint in Ya'bad village, to the south west of Jenin, on Sunday evening. IOF soldiers fired stun grenades and tear gas at the youths and a number of them suffered breathing problems. Other confrontations were witnessed in al-Jalama checkpoint, to the north east of Jenin, which has witnessed many confrontations lately. The IOF arrested the child Hilal Salah, 15, and Ziad Abu Salah from Ya'bad village. Meanwhile, Jenin city witnessed armed confrontations during the raid of IOF into the city. IOF announced that many of their vehicles were damaged by resistance bullets. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- In Occupied Jerusalem, Israeli police arrested Muath Abu al-Hawa, and detained others for field investigation. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Al-Khader Palestinian town, south of Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank, and confiscated a truck. The IOA stopped a Palestinian truck in the Abu Soud area, in the western part of the village, and confiscated it. The truck is owned by Morad Mohammad al-Mahseeri, who was conducting work on Palestinian lands in Abu Soud. The IOA briefly detained the truck owner, and confiscated the vehicle before taking it to Etzion military base and security center, south of Bethlehem. (IMEMC 21 September 2021)

- Violent clashes broke out between Palestinian young men and the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) near the northern entrance to Qalqilya City. Many young men and citizens living in the area suffered from their exposure to tear gas during the events. (IMEMC 21 September 2021)
- In occupied east Jerusalem, local youths confronted police forces who stormed Bir Ayyoub neighborhood in Silwan city. No arrests were reported during the police raid. (IMEMC 21 September 2021)
- Violent clashes broke out between Palestinian young men and the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) in the West Bank and Jerusalem. According to local sources, clashes happened between youths and soldiers near the northern entrance to Qalqilya City. Many young men and citizens living in the area suffered from their exposure to tear gas during the events. Similar clashes also broke out at the western entrance to Silwad town in the east of Ramallah. In east Jerusalem, local youths confronted police forces who stormed Bir Ayyoub neighborhood in Silwan district. No arrests were reported during the police raid. (PALINFO 21 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) shot and detained a young Palestinian man in the at-Tour town, in occupied Jerusalem. The IOA invaded the town, leading to protests, before firing rubber-coated steel bullets and gas bombs. The IOA shot Bassam Abu Sbeitan, with rubber-coated steel bullets in the leg, and assaulted him before dragging him away. The Palestinian was seen in pain trying to walk while the IOA were taking him away, without providing him with the needed medical help. (IMEMC 22 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) and a Group of settlers bulldozed, large areas of Palestinian lands near Nablus, in northern West Bank, apparently in preparation for construction of an outpost. The settlers, accompanied by many IOA, brought three bulldozers and started bulldozing the lands. The targeted Palestinian lands, at least 30 Dunams (7.41 Acres), are in the Kafr Atiyya area between the villages of Aqraba, Joreesh, and al-Majdal. The Palestinians were not informed or given any written orders from the military regarding the bulldozing of their lands, however, such violations usually precede the official illegal annexation of the lands for the construction of colonies. (IMEMC 22 September 2021)

- A Palestinian young man suffered a bullet injury when Israeli police forces attacked local residents and students in the east Jerusalem neighborhood of at-Tur. Police forces savagely attacked citizens and school students in at-Tur and injured a teenage student called Bassam Abu Isbitan in his foot with a rubber bullet. Police officers subdued the wounded student and hauling him all the way to a detention center in the holy city. The forces also assaulted a number of students during the events. In the morning, the police blocked roads and obstructed the movement of Jerusalemites in different neighborhoods in and around the holy city. (PALINFO 22 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained a Palestinian citizen during his presence near the northern maritime border of the besieged Gaza Strip. Israeli naval army detained a citizen as he was swimming off the northern shore of Gaza near the sea border with 1948 occupied Palestine (Israel). He said the man would remain in custody for further investigation. (PALINFO 22 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and bulldozed Palestinian farmlands, north of Beit Lahia, in the northern part of the Gaza Strip. Several military vehicles, and bulldozers, invaded the farmlands near the perimeter fence while firing live rounds and smoke bombs to force the farmers away. The military bulldozers uprooted the lands and installed sand hills close to the fence. (IMEMC 23 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army on Thursday morning carried out two small-scale incursions into border areas in the east and north of the besieged Gaza Strip. A reporter for the Palestinian Information Center (PIC) said that 10 military vehicles, including two Merkava tanks and four armored bulldozers, advanced from a military post into a border area in the east of Deir al-Balah in central Gaza. He added that five other bulldozers and two tanks also infiltrated limitedly into the north of Beit Lahia, north of the Strip. The bulldozers embarked on leveling and digging swaths of agricultural land in the east and north of Gaza. Military drones were also spotted overflying the areas during the incursions. (PALINFO 23 September 2021)
- The seriously injured young man, who was shot by Israeli occupation Army (IOA) in Beita town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, has died from his wounds. The young man, identified as Mohammad Ali Khabisa, 28, from Beita town, was shot with a live round in the head, in Sbeih Mountain, and was rushed to the an-Najah Hospital, in Nablus, but succumbed to his very serious injuries. The slain young man is a married father of an infant girl, only eight months of age, and is the eighth to be killed in Sbeih Mountain since

the protests started 140 days ago after Israeli settlers installed an outpost on private Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)

- Over the last several days, the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained many Palestinians, including women, from the Zahran family in Biddu town, northeast of occupied East Jerusalem. The IOA invaded and ransacked many homes in Biddu, mainly those owned by members of the Zahran family, and detained Toqa-Eddin Zahran, and her husband Ibrahim Zahran, after storming their home and ransacking it. The IOA fired several live rounds at the home, before invading it, causing damage. Their detention came just a few days after the IOA detained six other Palestinians from the same family.
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained Asma' Aassi from her home in Beit Liqya village, west of Ramallah, after they were unable to locate and detain her husband, Ahmad Zahran. Ahmad's mother said the family was awakened by the sound of live fire before the IOA detonated the main door of their home and broke into it while shouting at them. The IOA searched and ransacked her home and the homes of her sons for more than two hours. The IOA blindfolded her sons and forced them onto the ground, while shouting at us and accusing us of hiding her son, Ahmad. The IOA also summoned several members of the family for interrogation in Ofer Israeli prison and military base and abducted two of them when they headed there. Mohammad Zahran, the brother of Ahmad, stated that the IOA summoned him and five family members for interrogation, and added that they headed to Ofer prison, where they were interrogated for about twelve hours before the IOA detained two. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) injured four Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, during the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum, east of Qalqilia, in northern West Bank. The Palestinians marched from the center of the village while chanting against the ongoing Israeli violation against them and their lands. The IOA instantly attacked the procession with rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Four young men were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)

- Several Palestinians were injured, after a group of Israeli settlers attacked them during a visit by a delegation from the European Union to Susiya village, near Yatta town, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The settlers attacked and injured the residents in front of Israeli occupation Army (IOA), during a visit by a delegation from the EU to the Tiwani and Susiya villages, to observe their daily challenges due to constant Israeli violations. The settlers tried to invade the village during the visit of the EU delegation before the residents intercepted their attack. Several Palestinians were wounded, among them Rateb Jabour, the coordinator of the Wall & Colonization Commission, who was injured in the chest and the head. The IOA also briefly detained the visiting delegation and declared Susiya a closed military zone. The army also fired gas bombs at the Palestinians, causing several injuries. Before the attack, the EU delegation, and international diplomats, including the EU representative in Jerusalem, visited the Tiwani village and Masafer Yatta, and observed the daily suffering and challenges the Palestinian face due to the constant Israeli violations and the attacks by the Israeli settlers. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the neighborhood of at-Tira, in the central West Bank city of Ramallah, and injured several Palestinians during ensuing protests. The invasion came from the direction of Ein Qiniya village, northwest of Ramallah. The invasion was carried out by the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) to accompany many Israeli settlers into an archeological area in the village. The IOA fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing several Palestinians, including those in their homes, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)
- Palestinian youths clashed with Israeli occupation Army (IOA) in al-Khader village in southern Bethlehem. The IOA fired stun grenades and tear gas at the youths and no injuries were reported. The confrontations took place after the funeral of ex-prisoner Hussein Masalmeh, who died of health complications, which he started suffering from in Israeli jails as a result of his exposure to medical neglect. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation police assaulted a number of Jerusalemite young men during their presence in Bab al-Amud area in the holy city. One of those young men said that police officers detained them with no reason, hauled them to an observation post in Bab al-Amud and assaulted them before releasing them later. (PALINFO 25 September 2021)

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) arrested Muhammed al-Barghouti, son of Hamas martyr Abu Asef al-Barghouti, after storming and searching his house in Kuber village in northern Ramallah. The IOA broke into the family's home and wreaked havoc on it before arresting him. (PALINFO 25 September 2021)
- Palestinians confronted with the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) who invaded Nablus city, in northern West Bank, to accompany dozens of settlers into Joseph's Tomb, in the city. The confrontations took place in Amman Street in Nablus forcing the IOA to evacuate the settlers from the area of the tomb and to accompany them out of the city. (IMEMC 26 September 2021)
- Several army jeeps invaded Husan village, west of Bethlehem, and fired live rounds, gas bombs, and rubber-coated steel bullets and Palestinians who protested the invasion and hurled stones at them. (IMEMC 26 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured Several Palestinians and abducted three, including two siblings, in several parts of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. The IOA invaded Biddu and Beit Ijza villages, northwest of Jerusalem, leading to protests, and fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Several Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, especially when the army fired gas bombs at homes in the villages. The IOA also detained two siblings, identified as Ahmad and Saleh Diwan, from Beit Ijza. The invasions and protests mainly took place near the Annexation Wall separating the two villages. (IMEMC 26 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) assaulted several Palestinians and detained one, in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank, after Israeli settlers hurled stones at their homes. A group of Israeli settlers from Havat Gal outpost, hurled stones at Palestinian homes in the Jabal Jales area. The Palestinians, from the local Tamimi family, tried to fend the attack off before the IOA invaded the area and assaulted an elderly man, identified as Rashed Hamed Tamimi, 63, in addition to Hamed, Faraj, and Shaker Tamimi. The IOA also assaulted Faraj Tamim, before detaining him, and took him to a nearby military base. (IMEMC 26 September 2021)

- Violent clashes broke out between Palestinian young men and Israeli police forces in Shuafat refugee camp, northeast of Occupied Jerusalem. The clashes started after police forces stormed Shuafat camp, spread near its main entrance and in Ras Khamis neighborhood and set up a makeshift checkpoint on the Anata road. Soon later, many local youths rallied on the streets and started hurling stones and empty bottles at the police forces, who responded by firing rubber bullets sporadically and volleys of tear gas and stun grenades. There was no information about wounded young men in the events. (PALINFO 26 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained a Palestinian young man after assaulting him and others in Jabel Jales area in the east of al-Khalil City. The IOA stormed Jabel Jales area and severely beat a young man called Faraj al-Tamimi before detaining him. The IOA also physically attacked others in the same area as a horde of Jewish settlers were hurling stones at homes belonging to the family of al-Tamimi. Three citizens from the family of al-Tamimi, including an elderly man, suffered bruises in the IOA attack. The local residents in Jabel Jales are exposed to repeated attacks by the IOA and settlers from the illegal outpost of Havat Gal. (PALINFO 26 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) went on the rampage through Hammamat al-Maleh hamlet in the northern Jordan Valley. The IOA stormed and ransacked all the tents in Hammamet al-Maleh and wreaked havoc on the local residents' belongings. (PALINFO 26 September 2021)
- Violent confrontations took place after hundreds of Jewish settlers, under the protection of Israeli occupation Army (IOA), broke into Joseph's Tomb, in eastern Nablus. Palestinian youths confronted the settlers break in and clashed with IOA. The shooting attempt and the confrontations forced the IOA to evacuate the settlers from the site before finishing the planned rituals. (PALINFO 27 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) attacked Palestinian protesters at the northern entrance of the al-Biereh city, in central West Bank, causing several injuries, including a photojournalist. The IOA shot the photojournalist, identified as Yousef Shehada, with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the leg. Several Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. The IOA deliberately targeted Palestinian journalists to force them away. (IMEMC 27 September 2021)
- An Israeli settler opened fire at Palestinian students in Ras al-Amoud in occupied Jerusalem, before the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked them and detained one. Th students were leaving their school

in the Schools Street in Ras al-Amoud when the colonizer opened fire at them. They added that the attack did not lead to physical injuries, but caused some of them to suffer anxiety attacks. Israeli soldiers arrived at the scene, and instead of arresting the colonizer, they abducted one student and briefly detained another. Earlier Monday, hundreds of colonizers, accompanied by dozens of soldiers and police officers, stormed the courtyards of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem, while the soldiers imposed restrictions on Palestinian worshippers trying to enter the holy site. In Hebron, in the southern West Bank, Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian shepherds on their lands near Lasefer village, in Masafer Yatta, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron, and forced them away. (MEMC 28 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot two young Palestinian men with live fire, and detained a former political prisoner, in Qabatia and Kafr Ra'ey, near Jenin, in the northern West Bank. A large military force, including undercover IOA, invaded the Zakarna Mountain area in Qanatia town, south of Jenin, leading to protests. The IOA fired many live rounds, gas bombs and concussion grenades, wounding two young men in the legs and causing several others to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The IOA also invaded and ransacked the homes of two political prisoners, identified as Ali Taiseer Zakarna and Ala Abu Farasha. In addition, the IOA detained a former political prisoner, Ahmad Mustafa Milhim, from Kafr Ra'ey, south of Jenin after stopping him at a roadblock while heading to Nablus. (MEMC 28 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) positioned in the town of Beit Anan fired rubber-coated metal bullets, stun and tear gas canisters towards citizens for alleged stoning. (NAD 28 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) positioned in the Jabal Junction area in the town of Abu Dis, fired rubber-coated metal bullets, stun and tear gas canisters towards citizens for alleged stoning. (NAD 28 September 2021)
The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) positioned in the village of Al-Isawiya fired rubber-coated metal bullets, stun and tear gas canisters towards citizens for alleged stoning. (NAD 28 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained five Palestinians, including two who were detained by undercover Israeli Occupation Army (IOA), and fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades at

Palestinian protesters in occupied Jerusalem. The IOA attacked many young Palestinian men, and interrogated them while inspecting their Id cards, before abducting three, near Bab al-'Amoud, in Jerusalem. In addition, dozens of IOA invaded the al-Isawiya village, in Jerusalem, especially the Obeid neighborhood, leading to massive protesters. The IOA fired a barrage of gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters, and sprayed many streets and homes with wastewater mixed with chemicals. Furthermore, several undercover IOA infiltrated al-Isawiya, before detained two young men, and took them to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 29 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) shot a Palestinian child with a live round, at the entrance of the al-Arroub refugee camp, north of the southern West Bank city of Hebron, and caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. Dozens of soldiers invaded the Jawabra and Omar Madhi neighborhood in the refugee camp, leading to protests, and added that military sharpshooters also took positions in the streets and alleys, and fired many live rounds at the protesters. The Palestinian Health Ministry said the soldiers shot a child, 16 years of age, with a live round in the abdomen, causing a moderate-to-severe injury. It added that the child received treatment in Hebron before being rushed to the Arab Society Hospital, in Bethlehem, where he had undergone emergency surgery, and his condition was adjusted to stable. Furthermore, the soldiers fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing several Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 29 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) chased many Palestinian schoolchildren on their way to their school in the al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The children, from al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya, were walking to their school near the main Nablus-Ramallah road when the IOA started shouting at them before chasing them. The IOA detained several children, refused to allow them through, forcing them to walk through a rough terrain in the area to reach their school. (IMEMC 29 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) killed a young Palestinian man in Burqin town, west of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. The IOA and uncover officers were operating in the area to detain Palestinians. The slain young man has been identified as Ala' Nasser Zayyoud, 22, from Siolet al-Harithiya town, northwest of Jenin. The young was shot

from a close range and that the IOA wanted to take his corpse away when Palestinians managed to retrieve the corpse. (IMEMC 30 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) detained a young Palestinian man and injured two others in the neck and the back, in Burqin town, southwest of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. The IOA invaded and ransacked the home of Mohammad Marwan Sabah, causing serious damage, before detaining him. The IOA also invaded and ransacked several homes, and interrogated many Palestinians. The invasion led to protests before the IOA fired many live rounds, wounding two young men with shrapnel in the back and chest. (IMEMC 30 September 2021)
- During confrontations with the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) at the entrance to Al-Arroub camp in Hebron, a Palestinian child was injured and is identified as Salama Jamal Al-Jundi - 12 years old. (NAD 30 September 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- 81 Jewish settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under Israeli police protection. The settlers entered the holy Islamic site through Maghariba gate and left through al-Silsila gate. Israeli police allow Jewish settlers to break into Aqsa Mosque in two periods daily, morning and afternoon, except on Fridays and Saturdays, while imposing restrictions on Muslim worshipers wishing to enter the Mosque. (PALINFO 1 September 2021)
- Israeli settlers stoned a Palestinian house and vandalized two vehicles in the village of Burin, south of the occupied West Bank city of Nablus. A group of settlers attacked a house in the southern outskirts of the village, smashing its windows, and destroying crops and trees in its vicinity. Settlers also threw stones at two vehicles parked in the area, smashing their windshields. The settlers came from Yitzhar settlement. (WAFA 2 September 2021)
- A Jewish settler driving at high speed ran over a Palestinian child student and injured him on a road in al-Husain area, east of Hebron City in the occupied West Bank. A settler rammed his car into the child as he was walking to his school in the area and fled the scene. The child suffered multiple injuries and bruises (PALINFO 2 September 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers attacked a Palestinian house and damaged two vehicles in Burin village, south of Nablus in the occupied

Jerusalem. The settlers from the settlement of Yitzhar hurled stones at the house of Umm Ayman Sufan in the village, causing damage to some of its windows. The settlers also smashed windows of two vehicles and wreaked havoc on crops near the house. The house had been exposed to settler attacks several times before because of its location near Yitzhar settlement. (PALINFO 2 September 2021)

- Dozens of Jewish settlers broke into the archaeological site in Sebastia village near Nablus under protection of the Israeli occupation forces (IOF). The settlers and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) want to impose a fait accompli on the site. Sebasita village is repeatedly stormed by the IOF soldiers who close off the archaeological site to facilitate the entry of Jewish settlers to allow them perform religious rituals. (PALINFO 3 September 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under police escort. At least 165 settlers, including rabbi Yehuda Glick, entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards in the morning and later in the afternoon. A number of settlers also performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. (PALINFO 5 September 2021).
- Dozens of Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. 144 settlers stormed the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. A number of settlers also performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. (PALINFO 5 September 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers, under the protection of the Israeli occupation police, stormed the courtyards of Al-Aqsa Mosque, and made provocative tours of its courtyards and facilities. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers broke into the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli police. The settlers entered the holy Islamic site through Maghariba gate, embarked on a provocative tour in the Aqsa compound before leaving through al-Silsila gate. The settlers listened to lectures on the alleged Temple and performed Talmudic rituals inside the holy Islamic site. The Jewish Temple groups have urged the Jewish settlers to break into the Aqsa Mosque en masse as part of celebrating the new Hebrew Year. (PALINFO 8 September 2021)
- Israeli Settlers attacked a Palestinian family on their lands in Lasefer village, in Masafer Yatta, souther of the southern West Bank city of Hebron, wounding nine, including a child. A Child, only four years of

age, suffered fractures in the skull. Eight Palestinians were injured, some suffered fractures, and others were stabbed or slashed by the Israeli settlers. Israeli occupation Army (IOA) arrived at the scene and fired many concussion grenades and gas bombs at the Palestinians, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The family's land is isolated behind the illegal Annexation Wall, and a week ago, they were able to enter it and work on it after receiving a permit from the Israeli army. The Palestinians, from Abu Qbeita local family, were working on their lands before several Israeli settlers assaulted them, wounding Othman Qbeita. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)

- A group of Israeli settlers attacked many parked Palestinian cars in the Old City of Hebron in the southern part of the occupied West Bank, causing damage, in addition to attacking several homes. The settlers came from the Kiryat Arba' settlers. Settlers attacked many parked Palestinian cars in the Jaber neighborhood, causing serious damage, in addition to throwing rocks at homes and attempting to invade them. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrived at the scene and started fire concussion grenades and gas bombs at the Palestinians who were defending their property, and secured the retreat of the assailing colonizers. (IMEMC 9 September 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers wreaked havoc on multiple Palestinian vehicles near the Ibrahimi Mosque in the Old City of Hebron, south of the occupied West Bank. Settlers from the settlement of Kiryat Arba infiltrated overnight into Jaber neighborhood near the Ibrahimi Mosque and went on the rampage through its streets, denting a number of parked cars and smashing their windows. Local residents tried to fend off the assailants, but Israeli soldiers fired tear gas and stun grenades to protect them. (PALINFO 9 September 2021)
- Israeli settlers uprooted dozens of olive saplings in Wad al-Hajjar area, west of Kisan village, east of Bethlehem, in the occupied West Bank. Israeli settlers came from the Abei Hanahal settlement and uprooted at least 50 olive saplings in an orchard, owned by a local farmer, identified as Ayyoub Yousef Obeyyat. (IMEMC 10 September 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers broke into archaeological sites in Artas and Solomon Pools in southern Bethlehem. More than 200 settlers made their way, through Palestinians' lands to Solomon's Pools and Khirbet Ayesh in southern Bethlehem. In 1979, the Israeli occupation authority built a road through the lands of Palestinian citizens in southern Bethlehem to connect settlements nearby and since then the Palestinian

- villages and sites have been exposed to raids by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) and settlers. (PALINFO 10 September 2021)
- In the northern part of Jerusalem, in the Palestinian town of Ar-Ram, an Israeli settler took out a rifle and began to fire live rounds at a group of Palestinian children who were on the street. The bullets whizzed past the children and luckily they were not hit. An Israeli settler armed with a rifle reportedly arrived by car at the northern entrance to the town, before he opened gunfire in the direction of the three Palestinian children. The shooter has not been identified or apprehended, and the Israeli police have not issued any statement that they plan to investigate the incident. (IMEMC 11 September 2021)
 - An armed Jewish settler opened fire at three Palestinian children in the central occupied West Bank. A settler driving a car arrived at the road junction of al-Ram town in northern Jerusalem and fired his gun at three kids in the area. None of the kids was hurt in the shooting attack. (PALINFO 11 September 2021)
 - A group of armed Israeli settlers from Kiryat Arba settlement opened fire at homes belonging to the family of Abu Sa'ifan in Wadi al-Hasin area, east of Hebron City. The shooting attack only caused property damage. (PALINFO 11 September 2021)
 - Dozens of Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem and later in the afternoon. At least 105 settlers stormed the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. A number of settlers also received lectures from rabbis and performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. Later in the afternoon, about 38 settlers defiled the Mosque. The Aqsa Mosque is exposed to daily desecration by Jewish settlers and police forces in the morning and the afternoon except on Fridays and Saturdays. The Israeli police close al-Maghariba Gate, which is used by Jews to enter the Mosque, at 10:30 am after the settlers complete their morning tours at the holy site. Later in the afternoon, the same gate is reopened for evening tours by settlers. During the presence of settlers inside the Mosque compound, entry restrictions are imposed on Muslim worshipers at the entrances leading to the Mosque and their IDs are seized until they leave the holy place. (PALINFO 12 September 2021)
 - A group of Israeli settlers attacked a Palestinian house in Burin village, south of Nablus in the occupied West Bank. Settlers from the settlement of Yitzhar hurled stones at a house belonging to the family of Sufan. Local residents clashed with Israeli occupation Army (IOA),

who provided protection for the settlers, pointing out that the same house was attacked by settlers a few days ago. Settlers from the settlements of Yitzhar and Bracha recently set fire to dozens of olive trees on the eastern outskirts of the village. (PALINFO 12 September 2021)

- Dozens of Jewish settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli police. The settlers entered the holy Islamic site through al-Maghariba gate and listened to lectures on the alleged Temple. Israeli police allow Jewish settlers to break into the Aqsa Mosque in two periods daily, morning and afternoon, except on Fridays and Saturdays, while imposing restrictions on Muslim worshipers wishing to enter the Mosque in the same period. (PALINFO 13 September 2021)
- Scores of Israeli settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. 257 settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police escort. A number of settlers also performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. (PALINFO 14 September 2021)
- Many Israeli settlers attacked several Palestinian homes in Jaber neighborhood, near the Ibrahimi Mosque, in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The settlers invaded the neighborhood while firing live rounds in the air, before storming homes. The settlers attacked the neighborhood while firing live rounds, and then the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) came and invaded one citizen's home instead of removing the settlers who attacked. More settlers were seen gathering in the area, and sounds of additional live fire could be heard before they stormed a few homes in the area. (IMEMC 15 September 2021)
- Over 200 Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. 205 settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards. A number of settlers also performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. A day before, Jewish temple groups announced their intent to organize massive settler break-ins at the Aqsa Mosque to mark what they called the Yom Kippur occasion. According to these groups, senior rabbis will lead public prayers and there will be an attempt to blow a Jewish horn (Shofar) at the Aqsa Mosque. (PALINFO 15 September 2021)

- Dozens of settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli police. The settlers entered the holy Islamic site through al-Maghariba gate, provocatively toured its courtyards and performed Talmudic rituals in its eastern area. (PALINFO 16 September 2021)
- A Palestinian man who works with an Israeli bus company was injured, after an Israeli settler stabbed him in Jerusalem. The wounded young man has been identified as Mohammad Abu Naab. The Palestinian, works as a driver with the Israeli Egged bus company, suffered moderate wounds before he was rushed to a hospital. The Palestinian, from Silwan town in occupied Jerusalem, was stabbed in the Givat Shaul area. (IMEMC 17 September 2021)
- Israeli settlers assaulted under military protection a number of Palestinian citizens from the families of al-Muhtasib, al-Bitar, Qafisha and Abu Hadid during their presence near the Ibrahimi Mosque. Some of those citizens were injured. (PALINFO 19 September 2021)
- Dozens of settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. 74 settlers in total entered the Mosque through its Maghariba Gate in the morning and later in the afternoon and toured its courtyards. (PALINFO 19 September 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli police. 48 settlers entered the holy Islamic site through al-Maghariba gate and provocatively toured its courtyards. The Jewish settlers have intensified their desecration of the holy Islamic site recently while the Israeli occupation authorities restricted movement of Palestinians in the holy city and closed a number of roads at the pretext of the Jewish holidays. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- A Jerusalemite taxi driver survived a murder attempt by an Israeli man in Occupied Jerusalem. The Israeli man tried to strangle the Palestinian driver Samir Mujahid with his seatbelt. The driver managed to free himself and survived with minor bruises. A group of Israeli settlers stabbed a Palestinian bus driver also in Occupied Jerusalem three days ago. The driver Mohammed Abu Nab survived with moderate wounds. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- Groups of Jewish settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under the protection of Israeli police. 104 settlers entered the holy Islamic site through al-Maghariba gate, provocatively toured its courtyards and performed Talmudic rituals in its eastern area. During the presence of settlers inside the Mosque compound, entry restrictions are imposed on Muslim worshipers at the entrances leading to the

- Mosque and their IDs are seized until they leave the holy place. (PALINFO 21 September 2021)
- Hundreds of Israeli settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem to mark a religious occasion. At least 552 settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police escort. A senior police commander and other officers also participated in the mass settler break-ins at the Mosque to mark the occasion. A number of rabbis delivered lectures about the alleged temple mount, while other settlers performed Talmudic prayers during the morning tours. Meanwhile, the police intensified the presence of its forces in the Old City of Jerusalem and around the Aqsa Mosque, particularly at its entrances and gates, and imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers from the holy city and 1948 occupied Palestine (Israel). A number of Muslim worshipers were also prevented from entering the Islamic holy site during the morning settler tours. (PALINFO 22 September 2021)
 - Hundreds of Jewish settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem and the Israeli police arrested two Palestinians from the Mosque's courtyards. Hundreds of Jewish settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards and performed Talmudic rituals under police protection. Israeli police arrested Raeda Saed and Saif al-Qawasmi, during their presence in the courtyard of the Aqsa Mosque. (PALINFO 23 September 2021)
 - A large group of Israeli settlers invaded the village of Birin, east of Yatta, south of the southern West Bank city of Nablus, before attacking home and hurling insults at the families. The attack was carried out by dozens of settlers, and added that the Israeli occupation Army (IOA) were also deployed at the main entrance of the village. The settlers gathered in front of the local Village Council, and tried to invade homes while chanting racist slogans. (PALINFO 24 September 2021)
 - A group of Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian families in Susya village in southern al-Khalil, under the protection of Israeli occupation Army (IOA), during an EU delegation visit to the village. Several civilians were injured including the coordinator of apartheid wall and settlement resistance commission Ratib Jabbour, who was injured in his head and chest. The EU delegation's visit took place to look at the challenges and difficulties facing the Susya, Masafer Yatta, and Tuani villages. The IOA detained members of the delegation and declared Susya a closed military zone. (PALINFO 24 September 2021)

- A Group of Jewish settlers raided Birin village, to the east of Yatta, under the protection of Israeli Occupation Army (IOA). The settlers voiced threats against the Palestinian citizens and insulted them. (PALINFO 24 September 2021)
- Hundreds of Jewish settlers broke into the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron. The settlers, who broke into the Mosque since the early dawn hours, performed Talmudic rituals in its courtyards. (PALINFO 26 September 2021)
- At least 1,024 Jewish settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem in the morning and later in the afternoon to mark a religious occasion. 651 settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate in the morning and toured its courtyards under police escort. Many settlers provocatively performed Talmudic prayers or rituals during their tours at the Islamic holy site. Later in the afternoon, 373 settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque, according to al-Qastal news website. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed entry restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Mosque's gates and the entrances leading to it and banned many of them from going in. (PALINFO 26 September 2021)
- Jewish settler opened fire on Palestinian school students in Ras al-Amud neighborhood in Occupied Jerusalem. The settler opened fire from his machinegun toward the school students spreading panic among them. No one was hurt but a number of nearby vehicles were hit with the stray bullets. (PALINFO 27 September 2021)
- Large groups of Jewish settlers defiled the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem and performed Talmudic rituals under the protection of Israeli police. The settlers, in a serious violation, raised the Israeli flag during the break-in, the sources added. For more than two weeks, the settler groups intensified their desecration of the Aqsa Mosque at the pretext of celebrating Jewish holidays. A Palestinian young man was arrested by Israeli police officers while praying at one of the Aqsa courtyards during the settlers' incursion. (PALINFO 27 September 2021)
- Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian shepherds of Lasifer hamlet to the east of Masafer Yatta in al-Khalil and forced them to leave their lands. The settlers insulted the shepherds and forced them under gun threat to leave their lands. The Israeli occupation authority isolated Lasifir hamlet by the Apartheid Wall and obstructed the movement of people to their lands. (PALINFO 27 September 2021)
- An Israeli settler and Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) harassed students at al-Lubban al-Sharqiya School for Girls located on the Ramallah-

Nablus road. A settler parked his car at the entrance to the school in a step intended to provoke the students and teachers, while the IOA closed the gate to the school and prevented the students from entering or leaving it for a while. (IMEMC 27 September 2021)

- A Israeli settler positioned in the Ras al-Amoud neighborhood in Jerusalem fired indiscriminately towards school students while they were leaving the School Street. (NAD 28 September 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers stopped his vehicle at the eastern gate of the Al-Lubban Girls School, and provoked the teaching staff and students and as a result, the Israeli occupation army (IOA) intervened and closed the doors of the school and prevented entry or exit from it. (NAD 28 September 2021)
- A group of settlers from the outpost "Yacoub Talia", which is located in the Al-Musafer area, east of Yatta town, attacked a number of shepherds in the Masifer area, preventing them from grazing their livestock in the pastoral lands, and forcing them to leave the area. (NAD 28 September 2021)
- Israeli settlers infiltrated a Palestinian barn and stabbed several goats, killing four, in the al-Mafqara village, in Masafer Yatta, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The settlers infiltrated into the community at dawn and invaded a barn before stabbing several goats. The attack led to the death of four goats, and the injury of several others. The families in the area are shepherds and depend on raising livestock as their only source of income. (IMEMC 29 September 2021)
- An attack by a group of settlers at Palestinians while grazing sheep in the Al-Musafer area resulted in the injury of Othman Muhammad Abu Qubaita who sustained head injuries and bruises throughout his body. (NAD 30 September 2021)
- Israeli settlers planted a Palestinian-owned plot of land as a means to seize it in Tuqu' town, east of Bethlehem. A group of settlers planted a plot of land, east of the town, with olive saplings as a prelude to seize it. The land belongs to Khalil Hmeid. (IMEMC 30 September 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers, under the protection of the Israeli occupation police, stormed the courtyards of Al-Aqsa Mosque, and made provocative tours of its courtyards and facilities. (NAD 30 September 2021)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Dozens of Jewish settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under police escort. At least 165 settlers, including rabbi Yehuda Glick, entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards in the morning and later in the afternoon. A number of settlers also performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. (PALINFO 5 September 2021).
- Dozens of Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. 144 settlers stormed the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. A number of settlers also performed Talmudic rituals or prayers during their tours at the Islamic holy site, mainly in its eastern area. (PALINFO 5 September 2021)
- A Palestinian citizen from the occupied Jerusalem neighborhood of Silwan embarked on demolishing his own home after he was forced to do so by Israeli municipality of West Jerusalem to avoid paying exorbitant costs if the municipality carries out the demolition on its own. Ayman Abu Wahdan said he was forced to demolish his own home after the Israeli municipality issued a demolition order for the home under the pretext it was built without a permit. Abu wahdan had no choice but to demolish the 50-square-meter home to avoid paying unreasonable demolition costs to the Israeli municipality. (IMEMC 4 September 2021)
- The Israeli army forced a Palestinian to demolish his under-construction home in Wadi ar-Rababa neighborhood, in Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, in occupied Jerusalem. The home is owned by Ahmad Younes Abu Hadwan, and was built on his land. Abu Hadwan had to demolish his 50 square/meter under construction home using basic handheld tools to avoid the excessively high fines and fees, especially if the City Council in occupied Jerusalem uses its workers and equipment. It is worth mentioning that the family stopped the construction of their home ten years ago, after receiving a demolition order, and have since been going to court and trying to obtain all needed permits and documents. While Israel continues to build and expand its illegal colonies, Palestinian communities and towns, in occupied Jerusalem, and various areas in the occupied West Bank, continue to be denied the right to build or expand homes and property. Israel has been issuing hundreds of demolition orders against existing Palestinian homes and property, including under-construction structures, and has already demolished many of them. (IMEMC 5 September 2021)

- Israeli occupation authorities embarked on levelling parts of the Al-Yusufiya Cemetery in the old city of occupied Jerusalem, in a prelude to establish a biblical national park on the site of the cemetery, according to local sources. The levelling works came after an Israeli court approved an order by the Israeli municipality of Jerusalem to resume the levelling works, which had been put on hold for a while. The court's order allows the transfer of the land of the cemetery into a national park so that Palestinian Muslims will no longer be able to build new graves there, which is part of the overall "Judaization" of Jerusalem by the Israeli occupation authorities. The cemetery houses the graves of Palestinian, Jordanian and Iraqi martyrs. In December 2020, the Israeli occupation authorities demolished the wall of the cemetery adjacent to the al-Asbat Gate and removed its archaeological stairs in addition to the stairs leading to the martyrs' cemetery. The cemetery is one of the most prominent Islamic landmarks in occupied Jerusalem, and houses the remains of senior Arab and Palestinian scholars, along with hundreds of martyrs. (IMEMC 5 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) forced a Jerusalemite young man to demolish part of his house in Beit Hanina town, northeast of Jerusalem. Fayez Izhiman, the homeowner, stated that the Israeli municipality ordered him at first to demolish the concrete ceiling of a room in the house and gave him the option of replacing it with a wooden ceiling, so he had to do so before it recently asked him to knock down all the room's walls. Izhaiman said that the municipality also sent a crew later to put marks on the room's walls that must be demolished and gave him until next month to carry out the measure. That part of the house was a living room and its demolition led the other room to lose some of its walls. In June 2020, the Israeli municipality also forced him to demolish part of his house and pay a fine of 9,000 shekels, but later he had to rebuild it because he had no other place to live in. (PALINFO 6 September 2021)
- A Palestinian family from the al-Bustan neighborhood in Silwan town, in occupied Jerusalem, was forced to demolish its home after the City Council denied their appeals. The Dweik local family was forced to demolish its own home to avoid the excessively high fines and fees, especially if the City Council uses its workers and equipment to demolish the property. The family received the demolition order twenty days ago, and tried to appeal the decision but to no avail. The 80 square/meter home provided shelter to nine family members, including 7 children between the ages of 7 and 16m, and was constructed in the year 2017. (IMEMC 8 September 2021)

- The Jerusalemite man Nedal al-Rajabi refused to self-demolish his own house in Silwan in Occupied Jerusalem after the Israeli occupation authority (IOA) delivered him a demolition order that should be carried out within a 21 days deadline. Rajabi said that if the IOA wants to demolish his house, then they have to implement it on its own. (PALINFO 23 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and stopped the rehabilitation work of a road, in addition to confiscating a bulldozer. The IOA attacked workers, and pointed their guns at them, before confiscating a bulldozer. The workers were rehabilitating the road as part of a project which was initiated by the Village Council a month ago. (IMEMC 24 September 2021)

Israeli Military Orders

- The Israeli government issued an order for the illegal annexation of 48.700 Dunams of Palestinian lands in Kisan village, east of Bethlehem, south of the occupied Palestinian capital Jerusalem, in the West Bank. The lands are entirely privately owned by the local family of Awadallah, in the southeastern area of the village. Israel decided, without prior notice, to take the lands from their Palestinian owners to turn them into what the occupation government dubbed as a “natural reserve.” The decision was made to allow the expansion of the illegal Abie HaNahal settlement, which was built on stolen Palestinian lands. Immediately after the decision was made, Israeli settlers from Abie HaNahal started the preparation for a new segregated road on a Palestinian mountain overlooking the Wad al-Hajjar valley, northwest of Kisan. The planned road would be 4 meters wide and extend 2 kilometers on the Palestinian lands. Settlers are also planning to link the annexed lands with the Industrial zone which was built on stolen Palestinian lands west of the village, in addition to plans to install solar panels and a recycling factory. (IMEMC 21 September 2021)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) notified four Palestinian citizens of intent to bulldoze their grapevine plantations in Battir town, west of Bethlehem. Those citizens planted their own swaths of land with grapevines about five years ago in al-Qusair area of the town and they have documents proving their ownership of their lands. The Israeli army justified its intended measure by claiming that the entire area is

Israeli state land. The vineyards belong to Khalil Abu Ni'mah, Ghassan Abu Ni'mah, Ameen Farrah and Hijazi Asila. (PALINFO 6 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) bulldozed Palestinian lands close to the separation Wall, west of Deir al-Ghosoun town, north of Tulkarem, in northern West Bank. The bulldozed lands are two dunams owned by a local man, identified as Thafer Na'im Ghanem. The IOA accompanied by bulldozers, invaded the lands and started bulldozing them without a prior warning or a 'justification.' The IOA also informed the Palestinians that they are not allowed to enter the lands for a month. The lands were previously planted with vegetables, and had a few hothouses, however, due to repeated Israeli invasions, and uprooting, in addition to the repeated firing of gas bombs into the hothouses, the Palestinian turned them mostly into a garage and a car repair facility. It is worth mentioning that, during the invasion and the bulldozing of the lands, the IOA fired gas bombs and attacked Palestinian reporters to push them away. (IMEMC 13 September 2021)
- Israeli military bulldozers advanced into eastern al-Maghazi refugee camp in Gaza Strip. the bulldozers entered through al-Serhi gate and bulldozed Palestinian agriculture lands. (PALINFO 14 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded and bulldozed large areas of Palestinian lands and closed all roads leading to [Sbeih Mountain](#), in Beita town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The IOA bulldozed large areas of Palestinian lands in the al-Masbah area, in addition to destroying irrigation pipelines and several structures. The IOA placed sandhills on all roads leading to the mountain, to prevent the Palestinians from marching to their lands to protest the outpost that was installed on them. (IMEMC 17 September 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) confiscated the recordings of surveillance cameras at homes and stores after raiding the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan in the occupied West Bank province of Salfit. Israeli army units raided the village, confiscated the recordings of surveillance cameras and interrogated a number of local Palestinian residents after briefly detaining them. (Wafa 19 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) has continued to bulldoze swaths of Palestinian land in Kardala hamlet in the northern Jordan Valley to carry out a project for Jewish settlers. The Israeli water company, Mekorot, started a few days ago, under military protection, to prepare the area for the building of a huge concrete tank to supply Jewish settlers with water. Israeli bulldozers were leveling swaths of land in the southern area of the hamlet. There were fears among the

local residents that such project would lead to the annexation of more of their lands in the area. (PALINFO 22 September 2021)

- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) bulldozed about 30 dunums of Palestinian land in southern Nablus. The bulldozed lands are located in an area known as Kafr Atiya, which is part of the towns of Qusra, Jorish and Aqraba. The IOA might intend to prepare the area for the establishment of a new settler outpost in the area. (PALINFO 22 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) leveled a large tract of Palestinian land to the south of the West Bank city of Nablus. The Israeli bulldozers razed 30 donums of land belonging to the villagers of Qusra, Jurish and Aqraba, as a step to construct a new colonial settlement outpost in the area. (WAFSA 22 September 2021)

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Nabi Saleh, to search vehicles and check the identities of citizens until 10:10. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Beitin village, to search vehicles and check citizens' identities until 11:45.
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Ur al-Tahta, to search vehicles and check the identities of the citizens. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint near the junction of Deir Abu Daeef village, to search vehicles and check the identities of citizens. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint at the western entrance to the city of Jenin to search vehicles and check the identities of citizens. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Janata town, to search vehicles and check citizens' identities until 12:20.
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint on the road between Nahalin town and Husan village, to search vehicles and check citizens' identities until 17:10. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) set up a checkpoint near the Bilal Bin Rabah Mosque (Al-Qubba) north of Bethlehem, to search vehicles and check the identities of the citizens. (NAD 7 September 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) installed roadblocks on roads in the northern and southern parts of Hebron city, in addition to the roads leading to Sa'ir and Halhoul towns, before stopping and searching cars, and interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 20 September 2021)

Israeli Closures

- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) imposed a complete closure on the governorates of the West Bank and the Gaza Strip on the occasion of the "Hebrew New Year's Day" for the Jews, and prevented citizens and workers, including permit holders, from entering Jerusalem and Israel, with the exception of diplomatic and international missions and cases Humanitarian and emergency medical cases after prior coordination, until 24:00 on 09/08/ 2021. (NAD 7 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authorities imposed a hermetic closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip on the occasion of the Jewish holy day, Yom Kippur. The closure starts at noon Wednesday and ends at midnight Thursday. (PALINFO 15 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) imposed a hermetic closure on the West Bank and Gaza Strip on the occasion of the Jewish holy day, Sukkot. The closure starts at noon Monday and ends at midnight Wednesday. This is the third closure imposed on the occupied Palestinian territories this month, the first was for Hebrew new year, and the second was for Yom Kippur. The IOA yearly imposes these closures during the Jewish holidays, which badly affect the Palestinians in West Bank and Gaza Strip. In the West Bank, thousands of Palestinian workers are deprived of going to work, others face difficulties of moving between the cities due to the IOA strict security measures. In Gaza, patients are deprived of travel for treatment in the West Bank or the 1948 Occupied Palestine (Israel). (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) closed the Karm Abu Salem crossing in Gaza Strip for two days starting Monday. The IOA closed the crossing due to Jewish holidays and would reopen it on Wednesday morning. Karm Abu Salem is the only commercial crossing between Gaza Strip and 1948 Occupied Palestine (Israel) through which most of the besieged enclave's commercial needs pass. (PALINFO 20 September 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the archeological area in Sebastia Palestinian town, north of Nablus, in northern West Bank.

Several Israeli army jeeps, accompanied by bulldozers, invaded the town before heading to the site, and closed it along with the surrounding areas. The invasion was carried out by dozens of IOA, who were also deployed on the town's entrances and main roads, including the road leading to the archeological site. The IOA also forced all Palestinian stores to close and prevented the residents from entering the area. The invasion was carried out in preparation for allowing large groups of colonialist settlers to tour the site. (IMEMC 22 September 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) announced the closure of the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron City to Muslim worshipers for some days to allow Jewish settlers to celebrate a religious event. The Israeli army informed the administration of the Ibrahimi Mosque of its intent to close the Mosque on Tuesday night and until midnight next Friday. Scores of Jewish settlers would defile the Mosque during the coming days to mark what they call the Sukkot occasion. Meanwhile, the Israeli army imposed movement restrictions on the Palestinians at the entrances to the Old City of Hebron at the pretext of securing the area for Jewish celebrations. This was the third Israeli closure of the Ibrahimi Mosque during the current month on allegations of allowing settlers to enter the holy site to mark religious occasions. (PALINFO 22 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) closed the western entrance to Ya'bad town and other nearby side roads in the southwest of Jenin. The IOA closed many secondary roads and the vital road that had been built recently by the Ya'bad municipality in the area. The IOA blocked this important road as a mass punitive measure against the local residents. (PALINFO 23 September 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) Closed the gate of al-Labbun secondary school in southern Nablus. The IOA closed the school's gate located on the Nablus-Ramallah road and forced the students to follow other ways to a second gate for the school. 420 students from three villages around the school face difficulty in getting to the school from the other gate due to road maintenance leading to it. (PALINFO 27 September 2021)

Other

- The Israeli municipality in Occupied Jerusalem has started to Judaize and change the Arabic names of historic streets in the Old City into

Hebrew names. An Israeli municipal crew recently removed the wall sign of “al-Wad Street” in the Old City and replaced it with a new plate carrying the Hebrew name “Hagevura.” Al-Wad Street starts from Bab al-Amud area in the north of the Old City and runs southwards to al-Wad neighborhood near the Aqsa Mosque’s western wall. Israeli municipality had also Judaized the name of the Umayyad Palaces area near the Aqsa Mosque’s southern wall as well as alleys and streets in the east Jerusalem district of Silwan, south of the Old City.
