

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 16 November 2021

 \mathbf{T} he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats the occupied Palestinian territory, in the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers against Palestinian civilians violence and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) shot and killed a young Palestinian man during protests that took place after the army invaded Tubas city, in the northeastern part of the occupied West Bank. An (IOA) shot Saddam Hussein Bani Odeh, 26, from Tammoun town, south of Tubas, with a live round that went through his left shoulder, then his heart and lung. The Palestinian was killed during protests that took place at the main entrance of Tubas and surrounding areas, when several army jeeps invaded the city, before the soldiers fired live rounds, tear gas bombs and rubber-coated steel bullets. - The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted ten Palestinians from several parts of the occupied West Bank. Several army vehicles invaded Beit Surik town, northwest of occupied Jerusalem, searched homes, causing damage, before abducting Majd Amjad Sheikh. The army also invaded Ya'bad and Zababda towns, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, searched many homes, and abducted four former political prisoners from their homes. - Dozens of schoolgirls suffocated this morning when the Israeli occupation army (IOA) fired teargas at them as they were heading to their school in al-Lubban al-Sharqiya village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The (IOA) attacked the girl students near the school located on the main Ramallah-Nablus road, firing teargas in their direction and causing a large number of suffocation cases estimated at over 70. An (IOA) hit one of the students with his gun causing her pain and bruises in the arm. She was taken to hospital. (WAFA 16 November 2021)
- At least three Palestinians were injured after the Israeli occupation army (IOA) violently stormed Nablus to the north of the West Bank. The Palestinian Red Crescent affirmed that three young men were transferred to hospital, suffering live bullets injuries. (PALINFO 16 November 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers illegally squatting on Palestinian lands, attacked many farmers and cars near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, wounding at least three Palestinians, in addition to causing damage to several cars. Eyewitnesses said the settlers attacked many Palestinian farmers while working on their lands near Burqa village, north of Nablus, wounding at least three. (IMEMC 16 November 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers forced their way into the Al-Aqsa Mosque Compound in Occupied Jerusalem. A large group of settlers guarded by Israeli police broke into the holy Islamic site. (PALINFO 16 November 2021)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

• Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished three Palestinianowned structures near the Qalandia checkpoint, north of the occupied city of Jerusalem. The Israeli bulldozers demolished a supermarket, a vegetable shop, and a gas station on the West Bank side of the checkpoint. The demolitions are believed to facilitate Israeli work on two road projects for settlers that include a tunnel, and thousands of housing units for a new illegal settlement near the checkpoint.
