Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

22 November 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) rammed a young Palestinian man with their jeep, and detained another young man, during an invasion into the Wadi al-Far'a village, south of Tubas, in northeastern West Bank. The young man suffered moderate condition . The IOA sped towards the young man during protests that erupted during the invasion and rammed him with their jeep. The IOA also detained a young man, identified as Morad Rabah, after storming and ransacking his family's home in the village. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the village of Rommona, west of Jenin in the northern occupied West Bank, causing a number of Palestinian civilians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The IOA stormed the village, which provoked locals to protest the invasion. The IOA responded by opening fire with rubber-coated steel rounds, tear gas canisters, and stun grenades, in addition to assaulting a Palestinian minor. Several Palestinians suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation during the confrontations, no serious injuries were reported. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) fired tear gas and concussion grenades at Palestinians who protested the soldiers' invasion into the southern West Bank city of Hebron. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked many Palestinian protesters in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The IOA stationed at the permanent roadblocks leading to Shuhada Street in the center of the city, refused to allow the Palestinians through and forced them away. The IOA invaded the Bab az-Zawiya area, near the military roadblock, and chased the Palestinians away, leading to protests. The IOA fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at the residents in the Bab az-Zawiya area, also known as a major commercial center in the city; there have been no immediate reports of injuries. - The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed the iron gate at the main western entrance of Azzoun town, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, and prevented the Palestinians from entering or leaving the area. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian homes, and at least one car, in Orif village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, causing damage. The settlers came from the Yitzhar nearby settlement . The homes of Ahmad Abdul-Karim Shehada, Samir Sawalma, Jamal Abdullah Shehada, and Raed Mahmoud Rabah, sustained damage, largely to their windows and doors. The settlers caused damage to at least one car that was parked in front of one of the homes in the village. The colonizers also caused damage to one car near Turmus Ayya town, near Ramallah, causing severe damage and almost causing the driver, Nizar Abdul-Hamid Rawajba, to crash. It is worth mentioning that, on Sunday, the colonizers caused damage to dozens of Palestinian cars, driving on the main Nablus-Ramallah Road, Jenin-Nablus Road, Qalqilia-Nablus roads, and various streets linking between the various villages and towns, south of Nablus. - Israeli Settlers hurled stones at many homes in the eastern part of Urif town in Nablus Governorate, causing damage. The attacked homes are owned by four Palestinians, identified as Ahmad Abdul-Karim Shehada, Jamal Abdullah Shehada, Samir Sawalma, and Raed Mahmoud Rabah. The Israeli settlers also caused damage to a parked Palestinian car, especially to its windows and windshield. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
