Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

24 November 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers invaded the al-Jalazoun refugee camp, searched homes, and abducted Nabila Hamdan Abu as-Sabri, 50, and her son, Bilal Sami Abu as-Sabri, 30, in addition to Tha'er Samad'a. The soldiers abducted Nabila in order to pressure her son, Ahmad, to turn himself in to the military. The soldiers also abducted a former political prisoner, identified as Tha'aer Zoheir Samad'a, and summoned Mohammad Hamdan Abu as-Sabri for interrogation after invading and searching their homes in the refugee camp. - The Israeli Occupation army shot three Palestinian workers with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused two to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, after the soldiers fired rubber-coated steel rounds and gas bombs at their car, as they were driving near the al-Jalazoun refugee camp. (MEMC 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded Beit Rima town, north of Ramallah, searched homes, and abducted Osama Barghouthi, the son of Abdullah who is imprisoned by Israeli, serving sixty-seven consecutive life term. The army also invaded Deir Nitham village, north of Ramallah, and drove around its various streets before withdrawing. (MEMC 24 November 2021)The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained at least nine Palestinians, including an official with the Islamic religious Waqf department, from different parts of the occupied territories. (Wafa 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained two Palestinian youths, one in Silwan and the other in Jabal al-Mukabber neighborhoods, after breaking into and searching their family homes. (Wafa 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) fired rubber bullets and tear gas canisters at a Palestinian vehicle driving close to Jalazon refugee camp, hitting and injuring three passengers who required hospitalization. (Wafa 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) in Ramallah district, raided Jalazon refugee camp, north of Ramallah city, ransacked several houses and

detained three Palestinians, including a 50-year-old woman along with her 30-year-old son. (Wafa 24 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) vehicles infiltrated the northern borders between Gaza and Israel and leveled land dozens of meters inside the besieged Gaza Strip. (Wafa 24 November 2021)
- Several Israeli military vehicles invaded, Wednesday, the villages of Deir Sharaf and al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya, near the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and searched homes. Local sources said the soldiers invaded Deir Sharaf village from several directions, before surrounding and invading a few homes, and violently searched them. The sources added that the soldiers also invaded and searched the home of Jamal Tirawi, causing damage. The soldiers also installed a few roadblocks in the governorate, before stopping and searching several cars, and interrogated many. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)a

Israeli Settler Violence

- Three Palestinians were today injured, one of them reported in critical condition, in Israeli settler attacks on their vehicles in the occupied West Bank. Israeli settlers threw rocks and smashed the windshield of a car driven by a Palestinian from Nablus on a road north of Ramallah causing the car to overturn. The driver was critically injured and had to be flown to hospital while his son, who was in the car, received moderate injuries. Another Palestinian was injured in a separate incident when settlers attacked his car near the village of Duma, south of Nablus, shattering the car windows. A 15-year-old girl was also moderately injured when settlers attacked a car, on a northern West Bank Road. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)

- Israeli settlers attacked today with live fire and stones Palestinian residents and their homes near the entrance to the village of Burqa, northwest of Nablus, in the northern occupied West Bank, according to a local activist. (Wafa 24 November 2021)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli occupation authorities along with bulldozers invaded the Wadi al-Hummos area of Sur Baher town, southeast of Jerusalem, and demolished a three story home belonging to Ayman al-Heih. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- In the southern West Bank, south of Hebron, Israeli forces tore down a 200 square meter Palestinian-owned home in the Khirbit Maeen community in Masafer Yatta, under the pretext of building without a license. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- Two houses in Khirbit al-Fakhit and Khirbit al-Markaz communities in Masafer Yatta, received demolition orders from the occupation authorities. . (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
