Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

17 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers opened fire, with rubber-coated steel rounds and tear gas towards Palestinian protesters in various towns in the Nablus governorate in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. soldiers shot and injured five Palestinian young men with rubber-coated steel rounds in Beita town southwest of Nablus, while five others suffered after being chased by the army. 40 additional young men at the non-violent protest suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- In Beit Dajan village, east of Nablus, the army attacked peaceful demonstrations to protest the illegal expropriation of Palestinian-owned lands, injuring 19 people including 5 with rubber-coated steel rounds, while 14 suffered inhalation injuries from tear gas. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- Dozens of Palestinian civilians were injured by Israeli forces following an attempt by illegal colonists to invade the village of Burqa, northwest of Nablus in the northern occupied West Bank. While Palestinian civilians resisted a settler invasion, the army protected the settlers by opening fire with tear gas canisters towards the Palestinians, striking one young man in the head with a tear gas canister. Dozens more suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation, all of whom were treated on site by local medics. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- Israeli soldiers injured several Palestinians and abducted two, during a nonviolent procession against the Israeli attempts to confiscate a Palestinian home, in Sheikh Jarrah, in occupied Jerusalem. several army and police vehicles invaded the neighborhood before attacking many Palestinians who nonviolently gathered in solidarity with the local Salem family, threatened with displacement. The soldiers assaulted the Palestinians, including a journalist, identified as Mahmoud Oleyyan, who was wounded in the eye and face; several Palestinians suffered cuts and bruises. Furthermore, the soldiers abducted Mohammad Hasan Kiswani, 17, and Mohammad Gheith, 23, before moving them to an interrogation facility. The violations took place after several nonviolent activists

- organized a nonviolent solidarity protest on social media, including Friday prayers in front of the Salem family house. Earlier on Thursday, dozens of illegal Israeli colonizers invaded a land owned by the family and fenced it in a move aiming at confiscating it. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded Burqa village, north of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, leading to protests, before shooting a young man with a gas bomb in the head, and caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The incident took place when the Palestinians intercepted an attack by a group of illegal colonizers who stormed the village. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
 - The Israeli soldiers invaded Thaher al-Maleh village, northwest of Jenin, and confiscated a car, owned by Mustafa Mohammad Khatib. Dozens of soldiers were also deployed around various villages and towns, south of Jenin, especially Siolet ath-Thaher, in addition to invading the villages of Zabbouba, Rommana, and Taybeh, west of Jenin. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
 - Israeli soldiers injured, three Palestinian children, and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, in the al-'Aroub refugee camp, and in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers invaded the refugee camp, leading to protests, before firing many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Two children were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets before the medics rushed them to a hospital. Dozens of residents suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
 - The Israeli soldiers assaulted and injured a Palestinian child, identified as Mohannad Ammad Misk, in the az-Zahed area, in Hebron city, and tried to abduct him. The child's mother, and two Palestinians who were walking in the area, were also assaulted by the soldiers while trying to prevent them from abducting him. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Illegal Israeli colonizers attacked, many Palestinian cars, and broke into a car repair facility near the main entrance of Sebastia town, north of Nablus, in northern West Bank. colonizers broke into a car repair facility, owned by Odai Younes al-Haj, and ransacked it, causing damage. The colonizers also attacked and damaged several cars, parked near the facility. In addition, Israeli soldiers also invaded and ransacked homes in the same area, especially those close to the illegal Shavei Shomron colony, and the main Jenin-Nablus Road. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- Dozens of Israeli colonizers attacked many homes in Qaryout town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, causing damage, and injured several Palestinians, in addition to attempting to abduct one man. The colonizers attacked many homes in the town, causing damage, and assaulted the families. Many Palestinians were injured in the attack . The colonizers snatched a man, identified as Wa’el Bahjat, and tried to kidnap him. The colonizers also stormed and ransacked at least Bahjat’s, causing extensive property damage, before assaulting him, causing various injuries. At least two other Palestinains were injured in the attack. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- Israeli colonizers attacked many Palestinian cars near Siolet ath-Thaher town, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, before Israeli soldiers invaded and searched homes and shops, and confiscated surveillance equipment. In Jenin said the colonizers hurled stones and empty bottles at many Palestinian cars, causing damage. The colonizers gathered in large groups in the area, before attacking the Palestinian cars, and chased many residents. Furthermore, Israeli soldiers invaded the town before storming and ransacking several homes and stores, and confiscated surveillance equipment. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- Many illegal Israeli colonizers attacked dozens of cars near Huwwara town, causing excessive property damage. the colonizers hurled stones at cars on the main Nablus-Qalqilia road and Nablus-Tulkarem road, causing damage. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
- A group of illegal Israeli colonizers attacked, many Palestinian cars and closed a main road, east of Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. dozens of colonizers gathered on the road near the illegal Kharsina colony, east of Hebron. The soldiers hurled stones at the

Palestinian cars, causing damage, and closed the main road linking Hebron city with the towns of Bani Neim, Sammoa' and Yatta. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)

House Demolition and Demolition Threats

- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) demolished two Palestinian-owned houses under construction in Al-Dyouk Al-Tahta town, west of the West Bank city of Jericho, on Thursday. Local sources reported that IOF troops stormed the town in large numbers and demolished two neighboring houses owned by the local resident, Hamdan Al-Ajlouni. The Israeli authorities are pursuing various forms of harassment against Palestinians, as a means of forcing them to leave their land— thereby leaving it clear for the expansion of Jewish-only settlements. (PALINFO 17 December 2021)

Erection of Israeli Checkpoints

- The Israeli soldiers installed roadblocks at the junction of Arraba town, and the Wad Da'ouq area, in addition to the main Arraba-Ya'bad road, before stopping and searching dozens of cars, and interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)

Israeli Closure

- Israeli soldiers imposed a tight siege on the Nablus governorate, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, while Israeli colonizers attacked many cars, including the convoy of Palestinian Agriculture Minister Riyad al-'Atari and several staffers, near Nablus. The soldiers closed Huwwara roadblock, south of Nablus, Sorra roadblock, west of Nablus, Shavei Shomron roadblock, north of Nablus, and Beit Forik roadblock, east of the city. The army deployed dozens of additional soldiers on the main Nablus-Jenin Road, before stopping and searching hundreds of Palestinian cars. (IMEMC 17 December 2021)
