Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

18 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers assaulted a Palestinian woman in the southern occupied West Bank city of Hebron. The incident took place at an army roadblock near the Ibrahimi Mosque, where the woman was identified as Sadyeh Salem Farajallah, 65. Israeli troops assaulted the elderly woman causing her to lose consciousness, and prevented medical crews from providing first aid treatment. Israeli soldiers took the woman to an interrogation center. (IMEMC 18 December 2021)
- Israeli soldiers abducted, a former political prisoner, and continued the extensive and violent searches of homes and property in the Jenin governorate, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. dozens of soldiers invaded Ya'bad town, south of Jenin, before breaking into and ransacking many homes, stores, and buildings, causing extensive damage. The soldiers abducted a former political prisoner, identified as Ezzeddin Taleb Atatra, after invading his home and ransacking it, in Ya'bad town, south of the city. The soldiers also invaded the towns of Qabatia and Kafr Ra'ey, south of Jenin, searched several homes, and interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. It is worth mentioning that the soldiers invaded many shops and homes in Jenin, and Burqa village along with several surrounding communities in Nablus, in northern West Bank, before violently searching them and confiscating surveillance recordings and equipment. The invasions led to protests across Jenin and Nablus before the soldiers fired several live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. Furthermore, the Jenin-Nablus Road remained blocked by the soldiers for the second day, preventing the Palestinians from crossing and isolating many villages and towns. (IMEMC 18 December 2021)
- Israeli forces opened fire, at Palestinian protesters taking part in the weekly march in Kufur Qaddoum village, east of Qalqilia in the northern occupied West Bank according to a local official. soldiers fired rubber-coated steel rounds injuring two young men, in addition to firing tear gas canisters, causing dozens to suffer the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation. - The Israeli occupation police assaulted Palestinian citizens and kidnaped two of them as they rallied in solidarity with the family of Salem, who is threatened with displacement from its home in the east Jerusalem neighborhood of Sheikh Jarrah. Dozens of Jerusalemite citizens performed the Friday prayer outside the house of Salem to express their solidarity with the family, but police forces violently assaulted them following the prayer and showered them with stun grenades. Two young men were reportedly rounded up by police officers during the events in the neighborhood. (PALINFO 18 December 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Several Israeli colonizers attacked, a few Palestinians in the Old City of the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Local sources said the colonists attacked the Palestinians in the al-Wad Street in the Old City and added that the assailants were also armed. They stated that many young Palestinian men rushed to the aid of the assaulted residents and managed to force the Israeli assailants to leave. Dozens of soldiers also invaded the area and forced the Palestinians to leave instead of removing the assailing colonizers. It is worth mentioning that various areas of the West Bank witnessed, Friday, dozens of attacks and violations against the Palestinians and their property, resulting in many injuries. - A group of Jewish settlers set up an outpost (Givat Yehuda) near the settlement of Kiryat Arba in the south of al-Khalil City. Dozens of settlers escorted by soldiers deployed a prefabricated home and some tents on a hill near Kiryat Arba. The settlers put their structures on a tract of land belonging to a local resident called Hammuda Jaber. Some journalists tried to report about the new outpost, but soldiers chased them and prevented them from taking photos. (PALINFO 18 December 2021)

Erection of Israeli Outposts

- Israeli settlers set up a new settlement outpost on Palestinian-owned lands near the illegal Kiryat Arba colony, located east of Hebron city in the southern occupied West Bank. Dozens of illegal colonists set up caravans and tents on a hill under the full protection of the Israeli military who

forced journalists away from the scene, obstructing their ability to cover the incident. The expropriated land, located near the bypass road east of Hebron belongs to a local resident, identified as Hamouda Jaber. (IMEMC QUDS PRESS 18 December 2021)
