Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

2 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers abducted, an international peace activist, and confiscated a car, two laptops, and cameras in the at-Tiwana village, south of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers invaded the village, in Masafer Yatta, south of Hebron, before storming the home of Suleiman al-Adra, and abducted an international peace activist in addition to confiscating his car. The soldiers also confiscated two laptops and several cameras that are used by the locals and international peace activists to document the violations committed by the soldiers and the colonizers against the locals and their properties in the area. A group of international peace activists are constantly present in the area due to the repeated attacks by the soldiers and the colonizers. (IMEMC 2 December 2021)
- A young man was rushed to a hospital in Jenin, in northern West Bank, after Israeli soldiers detained him and moved him to a military base where they repeatedly assaulted him before leaving him unconscious on the side of the road. The soldiers invaded Ya'bad town, southwest of Jenin, before detaining Raja Ahmad Abu Safat, 23. The soldiers took the young man to the Dotan Israeli military base, which was installed on stolen Palestinian lands near Ya'bad town, before repeatedly assaulting him. The soldiers then took the injured young man to the eastern entrance of the town and left him unconscious on the ground. (IMEMC 2 December 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- A group of illegal Israeli colonizers attacked, a Palestinian home and destroyed the engine of a car in addition to puncturing its tires and cutting several olive saplings, and stealing equipment, near Nablus in the northern West Bank. The colonizers came from the Ahiya colony and attacked the home of Hisham Ahmad Hammoud, in Jaloud village, south of Nablus, in addition to puncturing the tires of his car and destroying its engine. The colonizers also stole power generators and construction tools

in addition to cutting many trees in Hammoud's land. (IMEMC 2 December 2021)

- A group of Jewish settlers attacked a Palestinian house in Jalud town, south of Nablus. A group of settlers attacked the house of Hisham Hamoud in Jalud, punctured his car's tires, sabotaged its engine, destroyed dozens of trees in his yard and stole construction equipment and a power generator. (PALINFO 2 December 2022)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers escorted by Israeli police forces desecrated the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. The settlers entered the Mosque and toured its courtyards, where they performed Talmudic rituals under police protection. Jewish settlers have recently escalated their break-ins into al-Aqsa under the pretext of Jewish holidays. (PALINFO 2 December 2022)

House Demolition and Demolition Threats

- Israeli soldiers demolished, a retaining wall in the al-Walaja village, west of Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Dozens of soldiers, and employees of the City Council in occupied Jerusalem, invaded the village after surrounding it. The soldiers demolished a retaining wall, owned by Ahmad Ibrahim al-A'raj, on his land in the Ein Jweiza area in the village, allegedly for being built without a permit from the so-called "Civil Administration Office," the administrative branch of Israel's illegal occupation. - The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) demolished Palestinian homes and structures in the east of Masafer Yatta, south of al-Khalil. The IOF and their bulldozers went on the rampage through the Bedouin areas of al-Fakhit and Markaz in Masafer Yatta, destroying crude homes, cattle sheds, bathrooms, tandoors and other structures. The demolished structures belonged to Mohamed an-Najjar and an elderly woman called Safa al-Najjar. (PALINFO 2 December 2022)
