## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

24 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli forces opened fire, injuring dozens of Palestinian civilians in various towns in the Nablus governorate in northern occupied West Bank, according to medical sources. Ahmed Jibril, the director of ambulance and emergency at the Palestinian Red Crescent Society in Nablus stated that five civilians were shot with rubber-coated steel rounds in the village of Burqa, northwest of Nablus, and Beita, south of Nablus. Jibril added that 43 people suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation, while three young men sustained fractures due to falls while being chased by soldiers. In Beita town, occupation soldiers opened fire with rubber-coated steel rounds, and tear gas canisters at the civilians in the non-violent anti-settlement march as they proceeded from the local mosque after Friday Prayers, to Mount Sbeih. - Israeli forces suppressed, the weekly non-violent anti-settlement procession in the village of Kufur Qaddoum, east of Qalqilia in the northern occupied West Bank, injuring dozens of civilians, according to a local official. Morad Eshteivi, the coordinator of the Popular Committee against the Annexation Wall & Colonies in Kufur Qaddoum stated that occupation soldiers fired rubber-coated steel rounds, injuring six Palestinians and tear gas canisters, which caused dozens more to suffer inhalation injuries. Soldiers occupied several rooftops of civilian homes and attempts were made to ambush demonstrators in an effort to detain them, however no arrests were reported. (IMEMC 24 December 2021)
- Israeli forces infiltrated the Gaza Strip, and razed Palestinian-owned farmland, east of Beit Lahia in the Northern besieged Gaza Strip. A number of occupation tanks and bulldozers infiltrated dozens of meters into the Palestinian territory, east of Beit Lahia, and razed a strawberry field owned by a local farmer. The occupation authorities regularly make incursions into the tiny coastal enclave, destroying crops planted with produce, which farmers sell to provide for their families. Soldiers often open fire with live fire at farmers, forcing them to leave their land for fear of being shot. (Wafa, IMEMC 24 December 2021)

- Israeli soldiers assaulted, a Palestinian man near the village of Bazariya northwest Nablus city in the northern occupied West Bank, the Palestinian News & Information Agency (WAFA) reported.
- The Palestinian civilian, identified as Mohammad Saleh Hajja, 50, was brutally assaulted by Israeli forces after they stopped him while he was on his way home. Sources stated that the man was detained and beaten while he was handcuffed and shackled, for two hours, and subsequently abandoned on the side of the road where he was found unconscious. Hajja was then transferred to the Thabet Thabet hospital in Tulkarem unconscious, when he regained consciousness he told doctors that he was injected with an unidentified substance by soldiers. ## Israeli Settler Violence

- An illegal Israeli colonist struck with his vehicle, on Friday, an elderly Palestinian woman, killing her instantly, near the entrance of the town of Sinjil, northeast of Ramallah in the central occupied West Bank. The Mayor of Sinjil, Hazem Tawafsha, stated that the victim, identified as Ghadir Anis Abdullah Masalma, 63, was standing with her husband at the entrance to the town, near the settler-only bypass Road 60 when she was killed. The slain Palestinian woman was from Sinjel town, northeast of Ramallah. Her husband, Saleh Abu Hamada, 67, said the Israeli colonizers rammed his wife with the car and fled the scene. "He didn't stop, he didn't slow down, he just rammed her with his car, and sped away," the husband stated, "We were just heading back home." (IMEMC 24 December 2021)
- Illegal Israeli colonists stormed, on Thursday, a Palestinian-owned home and a car-wash/workshop at the entrance to Burqa village, northwest of Nablus city in the northern occupied West Bank. Israeli settlers stormed the home of a local civilian, identified as Jamal Saif, before several Palestinians in the area gathered to confront them, forcing them to retreat. Meanwhile, settlers, under the full protection of the occupation army threw rocks at Palestinian homes on the outskirts of Silat ad-Dhahr

village, near the illegal Homesh colony which was evacuated in 2005, located north of Burqa. Furthermore, settlers blocked part of the Nablus-Jenin road (Route 60), denying access to Palestinians traveling on the route. (Wafa, IMEMC 24 December 2021)
