Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

27 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli forces attacked, on Monday, for a second day in a row, Palestinian schoolchildren in al-Khader town, southwest of Bethlehem, in the southern occupied West Bank, causing dozens to suffocate on tear gas, according to local sources. Dozens of children were exposed to the toxic effects of tear gas when Israeli soldiers fired tear gas canisters and concussion grenades at them while they were leaving their educational facilities. Many children suffered acute anxiety and suffocated on tear gas as a result of the attack, which sparked confrontations between the local Palestinian civilians and the army. Salah added that soldiers fired a tear gas canister into the windshield of a local journalist who was attempting to cover the events at the scene. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- Medical sources have reported that several Palestinians have been injured, Monday, when dozens of Israeli soldiers and illegal colonizers invaded the Ras al-Jabal area in the al-Midya village, west of the central West Bank city of Ramallah. Local sources said dozens of colonizers and soldiers invaded the Ras al-Jabal area and headed to an archeological site on Palestinian lands. They added that the colonizers attacked the Palestinians to force them away, before the soldiers fired several gas bombs at the residents, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. Palestinian medics rushed to the area before the soldiers stopped them and forced them to wait, and later allowed them to provide treatment to the wounded residents. It is worth mentioning that the colonizers, accompanied by soldiers, invade the area every week. During these invasions, the soldiers force the Palestinians to leave and repeatedly fire live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at them. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- Israeli soldiers invaded Monday, several homes and detonated the front door of a store before breaking into it, in the al-'Isawiya town in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Mohammad Abu al-Hummus, a member of the Follow-up Committee in al-'Isawiya, said the soldiers wired and detonated the front door of a store, owned by Morad Obeid, before invading and ransacking it. He added that the soldiers also invaded and ransacked several homes and confiscated

- surveillance recordings and equipment. During the invasions, the soldiers interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- Several Israeli military vehicles invaded, Monday, Khirbat Ibziq village, and searched homes, in addition to installing a roadblock near Atouf village, in the northern plains of the occupied West Bank. Mo'taz Bisharat, a Palestinian official who monitors Israel's colonialist activities in Tubas and the Northern Plains, said the soldiers invaded the village before photographing several structures. He added that the soldiers also searched structures before withdrawing from the village. In addition, the soldiers installed a roadblock, east of Atouf village, before stopping many cars heading to the Northern Plains and the al-Boqei'a Meadow area. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
 - The Israeli soldiers invaded the western area of Deir Istiya town, north of Salfit in the central West Bank, stormed homes and stores, and confiscated surveillance recordings. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
 - Israeli soldiers attacked, on Sunday evening, dozens of nonviolent Palestinian protesters in the al-Jalazoun refugee camp, north of the central West Bank city of Ramallah, while marching against the seriously escalating violations by the illegal Israeli colonialist settlers against the Palestinians and their property. Media sources said dozens of Palestinians marched towards the main entrance of the refugee camp while chanting against the constant Israeli violations, especially the recent serious assaults and escalation by the illegal colonialist settlers across the occupied West Bank. They added that Israeli soldiers fired many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the nonviolent protesters, causing several injuries. The procession came in solidarity with the various villages and towns, subject to the escalating Israeli violations. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
 - Several Israeli army jeeps invaded, Sunday, the town of Teqoua', east of Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem in the West Bank. Local activist Mustafa al-Badan said the military vehicles invaded several areas in the town, especially around the local schools, and fired gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets at Palestinians who protested the invasion. Al-Badan added that the soldiers detained one Palestinian,

identified as Ayman Mohammad Froukh, and interrogated him for a few hours before releasing him. The soldiers also closed the iron gate at the northern entrance of the town, and prevented the Palestinians from crossing, while many army jeeps were also deployed on roads around the town. - Israeli forces attacked, on Sunday, several non-violent demonstrations in various cities across the occupied West Bank, shooting a teen with rubber-coated steel round and causing others to suffocate on tear gas, the Palestinian News & Information Agency (WAFA) reported. In the northern occupied West Bank, in Kufur Qaddoum village, east of Qalqilia, Israeli forces shot a 16-year-old in the chest with a rubber-coated steel bullet, causing a moderate injury. The condition of the minor was unknown at the time of this report. Also in the northern West Bank, soldiers opened fire with tear gas and rubber-coated steel rounds at Palestinian youths who gathered on the Nablus-Qalqilia street, east of Qalqilia, in northern West Bank. Activists organized the protest to express their rejection of the escalating settler violence particularly in Burqa village, northwest of Nablus in the northern West Bank. Akef Jom'a a local activist, stated that the rally was held to support the people of Burqa village in the face of the escalating Israeli settler crimes against them. Demonstrators raised the Palestinian flag and shouted slogans rejecting the colonists' attacks on civilians and their properties. Jom'a added that the soldiers detained some young men, in addition, several young men suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation, they were all treated on site. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- In the northern occupied West Bank, in Kufur Qaddoum village, east of Qalqilia, Israeli forces shot a 16-year-old in the chest with a rubber-coated steel bullet, causing a moderate injury. The condition of the minor was unknown at the time of this report. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- In the northern West Bank, soldiers opened fire with tear gas and rubber-coated steel rounds at Palestinian youths who gathered on the Nablus-Qalqilia street, east of Qalqilia, in northern West Bank. Activists organized the protest to express their rejection of the escalating settler violence particularly in Burqa village, northwest of Nablus in the northern West Bank. The rally was held to support the people of Burqa village in the face of the escalating Israeli settler crimes against them. The soldiers detained

some young men, in addition, several young men suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation, they were all treated on site. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)

- In the central West Bank, at the entrance to the Al-Jalazoun refugee camp, north of Ramallah, hundreds of local youths confronted the army who attempted to suppress the rally in rejection of the escalating settler crimes. The military fired rubber-coated steel rounds, tear gas canisters, and sound bombs at the crowd. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- In the village of Al-Mughayyir, northeast of Ramallah, Israeli soldiers fired tear gas and stun grenades at local youths who gathered to resist the military incursion, no injuries were reported. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- Additionally, the army suppressed protests in the Sahal al-Baqai'a area in the northern Jordan Valley, firing tear gas and stun grenades, no injuries were reported. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Dozens of illegal Israeli colonists stormed the northern entrance of Sinjil town, north of Ramallah under the full protection of the occupation army, blocking the road. (IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. At least 120 settlers, including 35 students of religious institutes, entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under tight police protection, according to local sources. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (PALINFO 27 December 2021)

House Demolition and Demolition Threats

- Israeli forces destroyed Ten Palestinian-owned structures in Hizma town, north of occupied Jerusalem in the West Bank. The stores included a gas station, stores for selling car accessories and auto repair shops. Seven of these stores belonged to a local resident from Hizma called Saad al-Khatib. Occupation authorities justified the demolition under the pretext of being located in Area C, under full Israeli military and administrative control. The demolished car repair facilities were the only means for Palestinians to make a living by providing a service to residents. Khatib added that the heavy machinery destroyed all the equipment inside the buildings, causing thousands of dollars in losses. (PALINFO, IMEMC 27 December 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) issued a decision allowing the demolition of the house of martyr Fadi Abu Shukhaydam, a noted figure and teacher from east Jerusalem. The family of Abu Shukhaydam was notified of an Israeli decision to demolish its home in Anata street in Shuafat refugee camp and was given one week to file a petition against the measure. (PALINFO 27 December 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) displaced three Palestinian families after demolishing their three-story building in the east Jerusalem town of Issawiya at the pretext of unlicensed construction. Dozens of police officers cordoned off the area where the building was located before bulldozers embarked on knocking down the building. The building belonged to a Jerusalemite citizen called Yassin Mustafa, who built it about 10 years ago. Three families, including 20 individuals and one with special needs, lived in that building.
