## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

8 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers assaulted, many Palestinians in Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. dozens of soldiers and police officers invaded the neighborhood, and attacked many Palestinians, especially young men, to force them to leave, wounding at least four who were assaulted and maced with pepper spray. The soldiers closed all roads leading to the neighborhood, and prevented the Palestinians, solidarity activists, and journalists from entering it. The soldiers attacked the Palestinians and isolated the neighborhood to allow groups of illegal colonialist settlers to march there. The colonizers, under heavy police and military protection, marched while carrying Israeli flags and chanting “death to Arabs,” before the locals tried to stop them, especially when they invaded a residential neighborhood. Israeli soldiers then invaded the building and attacked the Palestinians, instead of removing the colonizers. It is worth mentioning that several Israeli right-wing groups called for processions in Sheikh Jarrah, to “support the settlers in Shimon HaTzadik” colonialist outpost in the Palestinian neighborhood. After the attack, Israeli soldiers removed the protest tent that was installed in solidarity with the al-Kurd family, in Sheikh Jarrah, six months ago, after Israeli ordered their eviction and removal from their home. The soldiers also removed posters that include the names of all families that are still facing the threat of displacement by Israel for the benefit of the illegal colonialist settlers. - Israeli soldiers shot, two young Palestinian men and abducted one of them, after the army invaded the southern area of Ya’bad town, west of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. several army jeeps invaded the town, leading to protests before the soldiers fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot two Palestinians with live rounds in their legs, causing moderate wounds, before abducting one of them, identified as Khaled Ashraf Abu Bakr. The second injured Palestinian was rushed by Palestinian medics to a hospital in Jenin; sources at the hospital said his condition is stable. It is worth

- mentioning that the soldiers stopped and prevented many Palestinian ambulances from entering the town. (IMEMC 8 December 2021)
- In occupied Jerusalem, the soldiers invaded a school in Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood, and violently searched it, before abducting two teenage sibling girls, in addition to a teacher and the principal. The soldiers interrogated the principal before abducting her and another female teacher, and violently searched the school, causing damage, before abducting the teenage sibling girls. (IMEMC 8 December 2021)
  - In Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, the Israeli soldiers abducted eight Palestinians after invading and ransacking their homes in several parts of the governorate. The soldiers abducted a young woman, a former political prisoner identified as Shorouq Mohammad al-Badan, 28, from her home in Teqoua' town, east of Bethlehem. The soldiers also abducted Amir Morad Taqatqa, 19, Mohammad Ibrahim Thalji, Mohammad Ibrahim Deeriyya, 17, and Karam Moshref Deeriyya, 19, from their homes in Beit Fajjar town, south of Bethlehem. The soldiers also invaded Beit Sahour, east of Bethlehem, searched several homes before abducting Qussai Eyad al-'Asleeni, 23, Luay Haitham al-'Asleeni, 20, and Ahmad Abdullah Shu'eibat, 27. In Nablus, in northern West Bank, the soldiers abducted Islam Nasser Shorafa, 34, and Sharar Mifleh Hamayel, 29, from Beita town, southeast of the city, in addition to Bashir Abu Jesh, 38, from Beit Dajan, and a former political prisoner, Abdullah Abdul-Karim Halabi, 47, from Rojeeb town, east of Nablus. In Ramallah, in the central West Bank, the soldiers abducted Mojahed as-Saq'an, from his home. (IMEMC 8 December 2021)
  - Israeli soldiers injured dozens of Palestinians during protests that erupted after several army jeeps invaded Deir Nitham village, west of the central West Bank city of Ramallah. The soldiers fired a few live rounds, in addition to gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing dozens of Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. It is worth mentioning that, ten days ago, the soldiers closed the roads leading to the village, except the northern entrance, in addition to the frequent invasions the town, and the repeated assaults targeting the Palestinians and their property. ## Israeli Settler Violence

- Illegal Israeli colonizers invaded, a Palestinian orchard near the southern West Bank city of Hebron, and cut at least seventy olive trees. The colonizers came from the Mitzpe Yair colony. The colonizers invaded a Palestinian olive orchard in Khallet ad-Dabe' area in Masafer Yatta, before cutting at least seventy olive trees, owned by Jamil al-Amour. The colonizers also brought their cattle to the Palestinian lands to feed on plants and crops. (IMEMC 8 December 2021)
- A group of Jewish settlers chopped off dozens of Palestinian olive trees in Masafer Yatta, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. Dozens of settlers from the illegal settlement of Mitzpe Yair chopped down 70 olive trees in Khillit al-Dabe hamlet of Masafer Yatta owned by a local resident. The settlers had also let their herd of sheep free on planted agricultural land, destroying the crops. (PALINFO 8 December 2021)

### **House Demolition and Demolition Threats**

- Israeli soldiers demolished, several retaining walls surrounding a Palestinian-owned land in Jabal al-Mokabber town, in occupied Jerusalem. Several army jeeps and bulldozers invaded the Sal'a neighborhood in Jabal al-Mokabber after isolating it. The soldiers demolished several retaining walls, surrounding the land belonging to Kayed Naim Fatafta, in addition to destroying his crops. The walls cost the Palestinian nearly 100,000 Israeli Shekels (\$31,900 USD), in addition to the losses resulting from destroying and uprooting his crops. (IMEMC 8 December 2021)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) mapped the house of martyr Fadi Abu Shukhaydam, a Hamas-affiliated noted figure from east Jerusalem. A large number of Israeli soldiers stormed Anata street in Shuafat refugee camp, raided the house of Abu Shukhaydam before military engineers embarked on taking its measurements as a prelude to demolishing it later. On 23rd November, the IOF broke into and ransacked the house of Abu Shukhaydam and removed banners and pictures of Abu Shukhaydam from its front wall. Abu Shukhaydam's family has been exposed to different forms of persecution at the hands of the Israeli military and security forces. (PALINFO 8 December 2021)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) demolished a house in Abu Khashaba area in the south of Hebron City and displaced a family of 13 individuals.

The IOF also demolished a water well and wreaked havoc on swaths of land in the same area. The entire property, including the house, belongs to Adel Abu Turki. (PALINFO 8 December 2021)

## Land Razing and Confiscation

- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) bulldozed 60 dunums of Palestinian-owned land in Fateh Sadrah area in Masafer Yatta, south of Hebron south of the occupied West Bank. (PALINFO 8 December 2021)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) bulldozed 40 dunums of land in the Bedouin community of Badawi al-Zuwaidin and five other dunums in Sarara area near ash-Shuyukh town, northeast of Hebron. All these dunums of land belong to different Palestinian families in Hebron. (PALINFO 8 December 2021)

## Others

- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) has prevented the Palestinian Awqaf Ministry from completing restoration and maintenance works at the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron. The Israeli forces prevented workers and employees from Hebron Rehabilitation Committee from finishing renovation works at the Ibrahimi Mosque. It is worth pointing out that Israeli excavations and diggings are still ongoing in the Ibrahimi Mosque's outer courtyards as part of several Judaization activities targeting the Islamic holy site.
