Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) confiscated a Palestinian-owned water tank from al-Khader village, south of Bethlehem in the southern occupied West Bank. The IOA entered the property of Palestinian resident Suleiman Salah and seized his water tank. (IMEMC 1 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation Army (IOA) carried out a small-scale incursion into a border area in the southeast of the besieged Gaza Strip. Seven military vehicles, including four armored bulldozers, advanced from a military post into a border area in the east of Khan Yunis in southern Gaza. (PALINFO 1 November 2021)
- Israeli occupation Army (IOA) detained at least 13 Palestinians and injured two others across the occupied territories. The (IOA) rounded up two Palestinians after breaking into the houses of their families in the Ramallah city neighborhood of al-Tireh. The (IOA) rounded up two others, including a former prisoner, after ransacking their houses in al-Mazra'a al-Qibliya village, north of Ramallah city. (WAFA 2 November 2021)
- Israeli occupation army (IOA) shot a young Palestinian man, before abducting him near Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) also prevented international diplomats from entering Shuhada Street in Hebron. Media sources said the soldiers invaded an area near the Sammoa' town, south of Hebron, and shot a young man with live fire. Palestinian medics rushed to the area but the soldiers prevented them from reaching the wounded young man and took him to an unknown destination. In addition, the (IOA) prevented more than 30 international diplomats from entering the Shuhada Street area, in the center of Hebron city. (IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)
- Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured many Palestinians in the eastern area of Nablus city, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Media sources said several army jeeps invaded the area to accompany dozens of colonizers into <u>Joseph's Tomb</u>, in the eastern part of the city, leading to protests. The (IOA) also invaded homes and occupied their rooftops, especially in the Amman Street area, to use them as monitoring towers and firing posts. The soldiers fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs at the protesters, wounding several Palestinians with the rubber-coated steel bullets and

causing many others to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)

- Many Israeli occupation army (IOA) vehicles invaded several areas in Bethlehem governorate, south of occupied Jerusalem in the West Bank, before the soldiers stormed and searched homes and stores, in addition to inspecting surveillance recordings. Local sources said dozens of (IOA) invaded the villages of Jouret ash-Sham'a, Um Salmouna, Marah Rabah, and al-Manshiyya near Teqoua town, southeast of Bethlehem. They added that the (IOA) broke into and violently searched many shops and homes, and interrogated several Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. They added that the (IOA) also inspected surveillance recordings in the invaded properties, while the army also surrounded many areas and installed roadblocks. There have been no reports of protests, injuries, or abductions during the invasions. (IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured a young man and detained another in al-Khalil. (PALINFO 3 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted a Palestinian father and his son in Yatta town, south of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (3 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) <u>injured many Palestinians</u> in the eastern area of Nablus city, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) <u>abducted a former political prisoner</u>, and <u>detained six farmers</u> from one family, in two separate incidents near Jenin, in northern West Bank. Also on Tuesday evening, the <u>(IOA) shot a young Palestinian man</u>, before abducting him near Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The army also prevented international diplomats from entering Shuhada Street in Hebron. (IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted a Palestinian man and his wife in Surif town, northwest of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 4 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Palestinian Ministry of Health announced the death of child after he was shot in the abdomen by the Israeli occupation army in Deir al-Hatab village, east of Nablus in the northern occupied West Bank. The (IOA) shot the child, identified as Mohammad Da'das, 13, in the abdomen with live ammunition during confrontations between Palestinian villagers and Israeli soldiers. (IMEMC 5 NOVEMBER 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked Palestinian civilians in Beita town, southeast of Nablus city in the northern part of the West Bank, injuring dozens, including a young man who was shot in the eye. Medical sources have confirmed that the wounded young man, Fayez Hamed Hamayel, lost his right eye, and is receiving treatment at the Najah Hospital in Nablus. In addition, at least five civilians were injured by Israeli forces, in Beita town and nearby Beit Dajan, in addition to 55 cases of teargas inhalation. (IMEMC 6 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked dozens of Palestinian protesters who were holding a procession in solidarity with the hunger-striking detainees, in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Media sources said the Palestinians marched at Hebron's northern road while carrying Palestinian flags and pictures of the hunger-striking detainees in Israeli prisons, and chanted for their freedom. They added that the (IOA) attacked the nonviolent protesters with rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades, causing dozens of injuries. (IMEMC 6 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured a young Palestinian man after the army invaded the al-Biereh city in central occupied West Bank. Eyewitnesses said many army jeeps invaded the city, leading to protests in several neighborhoods before the soldiers fired live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. They added that a young man was shot with live fire, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to cuts and bruises. The (IOA) also invaded and ransacked several homes, and occupied the rooftops of a few buildings, in addition to confiscating surveillance recordings. The (IOA) claimed it invaded the city after several shots were fired at a military post in the Psagot colony, illegally built on stolen Palestinian lands on the at-Taweel Mountain. (IMEMC 6 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked Palestinian olive harvesters in the village of Qaryout, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and forced them to end the harvest and leave their lands, according to witnesses. They said the soldiers held the farmers, seized the equipment they were using in the harvest, and trashed their harvest before forcing them at gunpoint to stop the harvest and leave their lands. The olive harvest season is one of the major annual events in Palestine and many households depend on the olive harvest for their economic wellbeing. (WAFA 6 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) poured fortified cement into a Palestinian water spring near Beit Ummar town, north of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The (IOA) accompanied by trucks invaded the ath-Thaghra area and poured the cement into the spring to permanently close it. The spring was in the ath-Thaghra area, east of Beit Ummar, in lands privately owned by two local Palestinian farmers, identified as Mohammad Abu Ayyash and Bassam 'Aadi. The attack is a serious violation targeting the Palestinians, their lands, and natural resources, and aims at denying the Palestinians access to water unless they buy it from Israeli corporations, illegally operating in the occupied Palestinian territory. (IMEMC 6 NOVEMBER 2021)
- A gang of Israeli settlers attacked a Palestinian children's playground, scattering the children who were playing there, and destroying their play equipment. The attack took place in Susiya village, southwest of Hebron in the southern occupied West Bank. The children ran from the armed men, and villagers, mainly mothers of the children, came to the site to stand up to the armed invasion. The armed colonizers also brought a German Shepherd dog with them, which they used to try to attack the children. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The israeli occupation army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinians protesting the army invasion of al-Biereh city, north of occupied Jerusalem in the central West Bank, injuring two teenagers, one of them seriously. The (IOA) stormed al-Biereh city, which prompted local Palestinian youths to resist, soldiers in turn opened fire with rubber-coated steel rounds and tear gas canisters, striking two children, both aged 16, with rubber-coated steel rounds. One of the injured teens, who was struck in the head with a steel bullet, was rushed to Palestine Medical Center in Ramallah for emergency surgery. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) shot and injured another child in Beit Ummar town, northwest of Hebron in the southern occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured a 12-year-old Palestinian boy with gunfire in the town of Beit Ummar, north of Hebron in the south of the occupied West Bank. The child was hit with a rubber-coated steel round in the head by the (IOA) while he was spending time with his family in a farm of theirs near the town. The child was

- rushed to Alia Hospital in nearby Hebron city for medical treatment, where his condition was described as stable. (WAFA 7 November 2021)
- Two Palestinian teenagers sustained injuries by the (IOA) gunfire last night, one of them seriously, during clashes with the Israeli occupation army forces who raided the city of Al-Bireh, in the center of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) fired rubber-coated rounds and teargas canisters during the clashes in the city, injuring two Palestinian teens, aged 16 both. One of the two teens was hit with a bullet in the head, and his condition was described as serious. The teen is undergoing a surgery for his injury at Palestine Medical Center in Ramallah. (WAFA 7 November 2021)
- Israeli navy ships opened fire at several Palestinian fishing boats in Gaza territorial waters in the northern and southern parts of the besieged coastal region. The navy ships fired several live rounds at the fishing boats, in the allotted fishing zones, in Khan Younis and Rafah, in the southern part of the coastal region. And the attacks did not lead to casualties or damage, but forced the fishermen back to the shore without being able to fish to provide for their families, in fear of further violations and escalation. (IMEMC 8 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) shot and injured a 12-year-old Palestinian boy in the town of Beit Ummar, north of al-Khalil. Mohammad Awad, who monitors Israeli human rights violations in the area, affirmed that the child was hit with a rubber-coated steel round in the head by Israeli gunfire while he was spending time with his family in their farm near the town. (PALINFO 8 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted four Palestinians, including a mother and her child, in Sielet al-Harithiyya and Ya'bad towns, near the northern West Bank city of Jenin. The (IOA) invaded and ransacked many homes in Sielet al-Harithiyya, west of Jenin, before abducting Sabrin Zayyoud, the wife of a political prisoner, identified as Mohammad Zayyoud who was abducted by the army several months ago, and her child Ziad Mohammad Zayyoud, 14. The (IOA) also abducted Ziad's uncle, a former political prisoner, identified as Maher Zoheir Zayyoud. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army injured dozens of Palestinians, including schoolchildren, at the main entrance of the al-'Arroub refugee camp, north of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. Eyewitnesses said several army jeeps invaded the area, especially near the Al-'Arroub Highschool for Boys, and attacked dozens of Palestinians who were holding a nonviolent procession in solidarity with the detainees, and

chanting for liberation and independence. The (IOA) fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing scores of residents, including children, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) carried out a small-scale incursion into a border area in the east of the southern Gaza Strip. Five armored bulldozers and two graders escorted by two Merkava tanks advanced from a military post into a border area in the east of Abasan al-Jadida in Khan Yunis. The heavy machinery embarked on leveling and digging swaths of agricultural land, which are located about 70 meters from the border fence. (PALINFO 9 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked today evening a rally marking the 17th-anniversary of the death of late President Yasser Arafat at the northern entrance to al-Bireh city. Israeli forces fired rubber-coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters at the rally, shooting and injuring at least 14 people, including an injury to the chest which necessitated its transfer to the hospital. Dozens of others were treated at the scene from tear-gas suffocation. The (IOA) reportedly surrounded the rally, set up several ambushes for Palestinians, and detained two people. (WAFA 11 November)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted a young Palestinian man, and detained another, in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) invaded Halhoul town, north of Hebron, and abducted Mousa Ghanem as-Sa'da, 18, before moving him to a nearby military base. The (IOA) also detained a young man, identified as Mo'awiya Abu Haikal, 19, in front of his home in Tal Romeida neighborhood in Hebron city, and took him to a military base in the Old City where he was interrogated for several hours before being released. (IMEMC 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted two Palestinians and injured 46, during protests that erupted at the northern road of the al-Biereh city, in central West Bank, after the army attacked hundreds of residents marking the 17th anniversary of the death of late President Yasser Arafat. (IMEMC 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured a Palestinian woman in the at-Tiwana village, east of Yatta town, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. (IMEMC 12 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured two Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets, and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, during the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia. (IMEMC 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked and injured at least 83 Palestinian protesters during weekly demonstrations against the ongoing illegal Israeli colonization of the occupied West Bank. In Beita town, southeast of Nablus in the northern West Bank, five young men were shot with rubber-coated steel rounds, including an international solidarity activist. Five demonstrators suffered fall related injuries, two from burns, and at least 62 protesters suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) rounded up the mother of a Palestinian prisoner and two young men in Dosheisha refugee camp in southern Bethlehem. The (IOA) soldiers forced their way into the home of prisoner Akram al-Attairi, who has been in Israeli custody for months, and took away his mother Dareen al-Maghrabi. The two young men were rounded up after breaking into their families' homes and wreaking havoc on them. (PALINFO 12 November 2021)
- At least 83 Palestinian were injured after Israeli occupation army (IOA) violently suppressed anti-settlement weekly protests in Nablus towns. Palestinian Red Crescent Society reported 5 rubber bullet injuries during the clashes in Beita town. A foreign peace activist was among the injured. Furthermore, 62 suffered from tear gas inhalation and two burn injuries were also recorded in the town due to the (IOA) assault. (PALINFO 13 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army abducted three young Palestinian men from Jerusalem, Ramallah and Hebron, in the occupied West Bank, during invasions targeting many communities in the occupied territory. The (IOA) invaded the Qalandia refugee camp, north of the city, before storming and searching homes. Also the (IOA) abducted a young man, identified as Ahmad Ezzat Hazeen, from his home, after ransacking the property during the violent search. The invasion led to protests before the soldiers fired gas bombs and rubber-coated steel bullets; no injuries were reported. In addition, the (IOA) invaded the al-Am'ari refugee camp, south of the central West Bank city of Ramallah, and abducted Samer Habboub, after invading his home and ransacking it, causing damage. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted four Palestinians from Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Many army jeeps invaded a few neighborhoods in the city before the soldiers stormed and violently searched homes. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted one Palestinian from Silwad town, north of the central West Bank city of Ramallah the (IOA) installed a sudden military roadblock on the main road leading to Silwad, before abducting Aws Haitham ash-Shawareb. They added that the soldiers stopped and searched many cars, and interrogated scores of Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards at the roadblock. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) <u>abducted three young Palestinian</u> <u>men</u> from Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Hebron, in the occupied West Bank, during invasions targeting many communities in the occupied territory. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) installed a sudden roadblock at the eastern entrance of Ya'bad town, southwest of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, before stopping and searching many cars, and interrogated several Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) <u>abducted four Palestinians</u> from Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked section 13 of Nafha Prison in the southern Negev Desert, causing several injuries, the Detainees and Ex-Detainees Committee has reported. . (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained five Palestinians during nightly raids in the occupied West Bank districts of Hebron and Ramallah. (WAFA 14 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) invaded two communities near Yatta town, south of the southern West Bank city of Hebron, dismantled and confiscated a barn, and abducted one Palestinian. (IMEMC 15 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained nine Palestinian civilians from different areas of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) invaded Al Mazraa Al Gharbia town, north of Ramallah in the central West Bank and stormed the homes of Ahmed Osama Ladawi and Abdel Moati Ladadoa, before detaining both young men. In Bethlehem, the (IOA) invaded Jabal Al-Mawaleh neighborhood, searched the home of Tamer Nasser Awad, 19, and detained him. Soldiers also invaded the Al-Fawagra neighborhood in Bethlehem, stormed and ransacked the home of Ibrahim Hani Souman, 29, before detaining him. (IMEMC 15 November 2021)
- A Palestinian youth was shot and injured with live ammunition during clashes that broke out in the city of Nablus, in the northern West Bank. The clashes broke out following an Israeli army raid to the city of Nablus. A youth was shot and injured in the knee with live ammunition and taken to hospital for medical treatment. (WAFA 15 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) stormed different areas of the West Bank and kidnaped a number of Palestinian citizens during campaigns. The IOA kidnaped two young men from al-Mazra'a al-Gharbiya town in northern Ramallah. They were identified as Ahmed Ladadwa and Abdul-Muti Ladadwa. In Bethlehem, the IOF kidnaped two young men from their homes identified as Tamer Awwad from Jabel al-Mawaleh area and Ibrahim Suman from al-Fawaghra area. Meanwhile, the IOF intensified its presence in different areas in the southwest of Jenin, with no reported arrests. (PALINFO 15 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) shot and killed a young Palestinian man during protests that took place after the army invaded Tubas city, in the northeastern part of the occupied West Bank. An (IOA) shot Saddam Hussein Bani Odeh, 26, from Tammoun town, south of Tubas, with a live round that went through his left shoulder, then his heart and lung. The Palestinian was killed during protests that took place at the main entrance of Tubas and surrounding areas, when several army jeeps invaded the city, before the soldiers fired live rounds, tear gas bombs and rubber-coated steel bullets. (IMEMC 16 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted ten Palestinians from several parts of the occupied West Bank. Several army vehicles invaded Beit Surik town, northwest of occupied Jerusalem, searched homes, causing damage, before abducting Majd Amjad Sheikh. The army also invaded Ya'bad and Zababda towns, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, searched many homes, and abducted four

former political prisoners from their homes. (IMEMC 16 November 2021)

- Dozens of schoolgirls suffocated this morning when the Israeli occupation army (IOA) fired teargas at them as they were heading to their school in al-Lubban al-Sharqiya village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The (IOA) attacked the girl students near the school located on the main Ramallah-Nablus road, firing teargas in their direction and causing a large number of suffocation cases estimated at over 70. An (IOA) hit one of the students with his gun causing her pain and bruises in the arm. She was taken to hospital. (WAFA 16 November 2021)
- At least three Palestinians were injured after the Israeli occupation army (IOA) violently stormed Nablus to the north of the West Bank. The Palestinian Red Crescent affirmed that three young men were transferred to hospital, suffering live bullets injuries. (PALINFO 16 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) stormed the village of Bi'lin west of Ramallah in the central occupied West Bank, and arrested four young men, in addition to shooting a number of family members. The army invaded the village before dawn, stormed Palestinian civilian homes and detained four young men identified as Jihad Yassin, Bara'a Burnat, Yamen Burnat, and Yassin Abu Rahma from their homes in the village. During the incursion, the (IOA) opened fire at family members of the young men, injuring at least three family members of Jihad Yassin. The (IOA) shot and injured Abdullah Yassin (uncle of Jihad), Bassem Yassin (father of Jihad), and Qamar Al Khatib (mother of Jihad), before retreating from the village. (IMEMC 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinian-owned farmlands in the central besieged Gaza Strip. The Israeli army opened fire towards farmlands located east of the Al-Bureij refugee camp without causing any casualties. (IMEMC 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) conducted live-fire military drills near the villages of Toura, Taybeh, and Thaher al-'Abed, southwest of the northern West Bank city of Jenin. Dozens of soldiers were deployed in Palestinian olive orchards and farmlands, while several armored vehicles were also roaming in the area during the drills that involved the use of live fire. The Palestinians have been denied access to their farmlands and orchards during the drills, while dozens of soldiers

were also deployed near Ya'bad town and all surrounding villages, before closing many roads and areas. (IMEMC 17 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained several Palestinian civilians from their homes in various parts of the occupied West Bank. In the northern part of the West Bank, (IOA)s stormed and ransacked the home of two young men in Jaba' town, south of Jenin before abducting them. (IMEMC 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) dismantled and seized Palestinian structures near az-Za'ayyem village, east of the occupied city of Jerusalem. Director of the village municipality, the (IOA) cordoned al-Saidi herding community, close to the village, where they dismantled two residential structures, each of which occupied 120 square meters, in addition to five sheep shelters, and seized the structures using a crane truck. (IMEMC 17 November 2021)
- Violent clashes erupted in Silwan town in Occupied Jerusalem after Israeli occupation army stormed the area amid heavy firing of teargas and sound bombs. The (IOA) closed Ein Al-Lawza Street in Silwan town, restricting the locals' movement. (PALINFO 17 November 2021)
- Israeli gunboats opened machinegun fire at Palestinian fishing boats off the coast of the besieged Gaza Strip. Gunboats fired some projectiles into the sea near boats off the shore of as-Sudaniya area, northwest of Gaza. Gunboats also opened machinegun fire at other fishing boats off the shores of different coastal areas in Gaza. (PALINFO 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) killed a Palestinian teenage boy after he allegedly stabbed two officers in the al-Wad Street, in Old City of occupied Jerusalem. The (IOA) later invaded his home before abducting his parents. In a statement, the Israeli police said two Israelis were injured before the Palestinian was killed. The slain Palestinian teen was later identified as Omar Ibrahim Abu 'Assab, 16, from the al-'Isawiya town in Jerusalem. The Police added that two officers and one civilian guard opened fire at the Palestinian teen after he carried the alleged stabbing attack out and added that two Border Police officers were injured before the teen was killed. After the incident, dozens of (IOA)s and police officers were deployed in the area and imposed a tight siege in the Old City and surrounding area. (IMEMC 18 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) invaded several towns in the occupied West Bank and detained twelve Palestinian civilians after storming and searching their homes, according to the Jerusalem (Quds) Press. In the northern West Bank, south of Jenin city, the (IOA) invaded Ya'bad town and detained four Palestinian men, identified as Ahmed Talib Abu Bakr, his brother Bilal Abu Bakr, Abdul-Jabbar Anfiat, and Muhammad Ghassan Qabha. The (IOA) stormed and searched the home of Musa Abu Libdeh, in the city of Qalqilia in the northwestern part of the West Bank, before detaining him and taking him to an unknown location. The (IOA) stormed the southern part of the West Bank and detained seven young men from in and around Bethlehem city, after invading and searching their homes. (IMEMC 18 November 2021)
- Palestinian prisoner Sami al-Amour died in Israeli jails due to deliberate medical negligence, according to the Palestinian Prisoner's Society (PPS). PPS said in a press statement said that the al-Amour, 39, a resident of Deir al-Balah city in the Gaza Strip, died in his prison cell this morning as a result of systematic intentional medical negligence at the time he was in custody. (WAFA 18 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians during protests that erupted after several army jeeps invaded the al'Isawiya town, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem. The Palestinians were protesting the death of a teenage boy who was killed by the (IOA). Medical sources in Jerusalem said the local medics provided treatment to 17 Palestinians who were shot with rubbercoated steel bullets to various parts of their bodies. It added that the medics also provided treatment to eleven Palestinians who suffered burns from Israeli gas bombs and concussion grenades, in addition to thirteen who fell while the soldiers were chasing them; two of the wounded suffered fractures to their extremities. It also said that the medics provided treatment to 95 Palestinians, including women and children, who suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians during a protest in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Palestinians marched, after performing noon prayers, towards the Bab az-Zawiya area in Hebron city, while chanting against the ongoing Israeli occupation, its settlement activities, and constant

violations. The IOA fired dozens of gas bombs and concussion grenades and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters, in addition to surrounding homes and stores, while local youngsters hurled stones at them. At least two Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation in addition to cuts and bruises. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)

- In Tulkarem, in northern West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Allar town, north of the city, and detained Mohammad Hosni Asrawi, 23, after storming his home and ransacking it. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted a Palestinian man from his shop in Beit Kahil town, northwest of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) invaded the village of al-Hashimiyya, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, and searched a home. The (IOA) stormed and ransacked the home of Khaled Hussin al-Fayed, causing damage. They added that the (IOA) interrogated the Palestinian and his family for a few hours, before leaving the property, and withdrew from the village. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured many Palestinians in Kufur Qaddoum, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, during the weekly procession. Morad Eshteiwi, the coordinator of the Popular Committee against the Annexation Wall & Colonies in Kufur Qaddoum, said the Palestinians marched from the center of the town while carrying Palestinian flags and chanting for ending the illegal Israeli occupation. He added that the s(IOA) attacked the protesters with rubber-coated steel bullets and dozens of gas bombs, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians during a protest in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) also abducted a young man near Tulkarem. The Palestinians marched, after performing noon prayers, towards the Bab az-Zawiya area in Hebron city, while chanting against the ongoing illegal Israeli occupation, its colonialist activities, and constant

violations. They added that the (IOA)s fired dozens of gas bombs and concussion grenades and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters, in addition to surrounding homes and stores, while local youngsters hurled stones at them. At least two Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation in addition to cuts and bruises. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) used fatal violence to disperse a rally called for to protest the construction of the new colonial settlement of Givat Eviatar atop Jabal Sabih (Sabih Mountain), near Beita, as well as the seizure of lands belonging to the villagers of Beita, Huwarra, and Za'tara to inaugurate a new settler-only bypass road. (WAFA 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) suppressed an anti-land-pillage rally in Beita town and Beit Dajan village, south and east of the West Bank city of Nablus, injuring some 20 people. The (IOA) used fatal violence to disperse a rally called for to protest the construction of the new colonial settlement of Givat Eviatar atop Jabal Sabih (Sabih Mountain), near Beita, as well as the seizure of lands belonging to the villagers of Beita, Huwarra, and Za'tara to inaugurate a new settler-only bypass road. (WAFA 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured 38 Palestinians during the weekly processions in Beita and Beit Dajan, south and east of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The IOA shot three Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused twenty-four others to suffer the effects of teargas inhalation, in addition to four who sustained cuts and bruises, during protests in Sbeih Mountain, threatened by Israeli settlers. Seven Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation during the protests in Beit Dajan village. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded al-'Isawiya town, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank, before the IOA invaded and ransacked at least one home, and detained three siblings, identified as Bilal, Sultan, and Mohammad Rabah Abu al-Hummus. During the invasion of their home, the IOA assaulted the three siblings along with their fourth brother who was briefly detained.(IMEMC 21 November 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) repeatedly assaulted a young man, identified as Khader Abu al-Hummus, causing various wounds before he was moved to a hospital. (IMEMC 21 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) injured a Palestinian journalist with a rubber-coated steel bullet and caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to detaining a young man, after several army jeeps invaded the central West Bank city of Ramallah and nearby al-Biereh. The IOA invaded the Ein Monjid neighborhood in Ramallah, leading to protests before the IOA fired live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The IOA shot a journalist, identified as Maher Haroun, with a rubber-coated steel bullet, and caused dozens of residents to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. Furthermore, the IOA invaded the al-Biereh city, before storming and ransacking the home of Mohammad Salamin, 28, before detaining him. The IOS also invaded Birzeit city and drove around its various neighborhoods before withdrawing. (IMEMC 21 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) rammed a young Palestinian man with their jeep, and detained another young man, during an invasion into the Wadi al-Far'a village, south of Tubas, in northeastern West Bank. The young man suffered moderate condition. The IOA sped towards the young man during protests that erupted during the invasion and rammed him with their jeep. The IOA also detained a young man, identified as Morad Rabah, after storming and ransacking his family's home in the village. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the village of Rommona, west of Jenin in the northern occupied West Bank, causing a number of Palestinian civilians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The IOA stormed the village, which provoked locals to protest the invasion. The IOA responded by opening fire with rubber-coated steel rounds, tear gas canisters, and stun grenades, in addition to assaulting a Palestinian minor. Several Palestinians suffered the toxic effects of tear gas inhalation during the confrontations, no serious injuries were reported. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) <u>fired tear gas</u> and concussion grenades at Palestinians who protested the soldiers' invasion into the southern West Bank city of Hebron. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) attacked many Palestinian protesters in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West

Bank. The IOA stationed at the permanent roadblocks leading to Shuhada Street in the center of the city, refused to allow the Palestinians through and forced them away. The IOA invaded the Bab az-Zawiya area, near the military roadblock, and chased the Palestinians away, leading to protests. The IOA fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at the residents in the Bab az-Zawiya area, also known as a major commercial center in the city; there have been no immediate reports of injuries. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed the iron gate at the main western entrance of Azzoun town, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, and prevented the Palestinians from entering or leaving the area. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- Dozens of Palestinians from Burqa town, north of the northern west bank city of Nablus, intercepted an attack by Israeli settlers against their town, and forced them to leave. The Palestinians noticed the Israeli settlers invading their community, and forced them to leave. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) also invaded the village after the settlement stormed it and started firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians. (IMEMC 23 November 2021)
- An attack took place on the Nablus-Jenin Road when the settlers hurled stones at Palestinian cars, in addition to a military invasion into Sielet ath-Thaher, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, leading to protests; The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) also fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians. (IMEMC 23 November 2021)
- Israeli soldiers invaded the al-Jalazoun refugee camp, searched homes, and abducted Nabila Hamdan Abu as-Sabri, 50, and her son, Bilal Sami Abu as-Sabri, 30, in addition to Tha'er Samad'a. The soldiers abducted Nabila in order to pressure her son, Ahmad, to turn himself in to the military. The soldiers also abducted a former political prisoner, identified as Tha'aer Zoheir Samad'a, and summoned Mohammad Hamdan Abu as-Sabri for interrogation after invading and searching their homes in the refugee camp. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation army shot three Palestinian workers with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused two to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, after the soldiers fired rubber-coated steel rounds and

gas bombs at their car, as they were driving near the al-Jalazoun refugee camp. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)

- The Israeli soldiers invaded Beit Rima town, north of Ramallah, searched homes, and abducted Osama Barghouthi, the son of Abdullah who is imprisoned by Israeli, serving sixty-seven consecutive life term. The army also invaded Deir Nitham village, north of Ramallah, and drove around its various streets before withdrawing. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained at least nine Palestinians, including an official with the Islamic religious Waqf department, from different parts of the occupied territories. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained two Palestinian youths, one in Silwan and the other in Jabal al-Mukabber neighborhoods, after breaking into and searching their family homes. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) fired rubber bullets and tear gas canisters at a Palestinian vehicle driving close to Jalazon refugee camp, hitting and injuring three passengers who required hospitalization. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) in Ramallah district, raided Jalazon refugee camp, north of Ramallah city, ransacked several houses and detained three Palestinians, including a 50-year-old woman along with her 30-year-old son. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) vehicles infiltrated the northern borders between Gaza and Israel and leveled land dozens of meters inside the besieged Gaza Strip. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- Several Israeli military vehicles invaded, Wednesday, the villages of Deir Sharaf and al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya, near the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and searched homes. Local sources said the soldiers invaded Deir Sharaf village from several directions, before surrounding and invading a few homes, and violently searched them. The sources added that the soldiers also invaded and searched the home of Jamal Tirawi, causing damage. The soldiers also installed a few roadblocks in the governorate, before stopping and searching several cars, and interrogated many. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- Israeli soldiers invaded, the home of Jerusalem governor, <u>Adnan Gheith</u>, in the al-Wista neighborhood in Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in the occupied capital and summoned him for interrogation at the al-Maskobiyya interrogation facility. Several army

jeeps invaded the town, before the soldiers surrounded Gheith's homes, and broke into it. The soldiers, accompanied by intelligence officers, violently searched the property, and assaulted Gheith in front of his family, before abducting him. (IMEMC 25 November 2021)

- A Palestinian sustained injuries and others suffocated from military gunfire as The Israeli occupation army (IOA) raided Silwad town, north of the city of Ramallah. (WAFA 25 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained 24 Palestinians and injured another in multiple raids across the West Bank. (WAFA 25 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained two others after ransacking their family house in the densely-populated refugee camp of Qalandia, north of Jerusalem. (WAFA 25 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) carried out a new small-scale incursion into a border area in the east of the Gaza Strip. (PALINFO 25 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked Palestinian residents in the east Jerusalem district of Silwan. While Jewish settlers opened fire at Palestinian homes in the northwest of Nablus. (PALINFO 25 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained four Palestinians including a minor from different areas of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 26 November 2021)
- In the northern West Bank village of Kafr al-Labad, east of Tulkarem city, The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained a father and son, both of whom have previously imprisoned by the (IOA). (IMEMC 26 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinian protesters taking part in the weekly march in Kufur Qaddoum village, east of Qalqilia in the northern occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 26 November 2021). Also at least six Palestinians were injured by the (IOA) during the weekly protest against Israeli settlement construction. (WAFA 26 November 2021)
- Israeli forces Friday afternoon suppressed an anti-land-pillage rally in Beita town, south of the West Bank city of Nablus, injuring a journalist and causing others to suffocate, according to medical sources. (WAFA 26 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) arrested eight Palestinians after breaking into several Palestinian towns in the West Bank and

Jerusalem. One Palestinian citizen was detained in Bethlehem, while several local houses were violently stormed and searched at dawn. Two ex-prisoners were also arrested in Kafr al-Labad town, east of Tulkarm. (PALINFO 26 November 2021)

- Violent clashes broke out near Jabal Sobeih in Beita town, south of Nablus, amid heavy firing of tear-gas bombs and rubber bullets on the part of Israeli occupation army (IOA), Dozens were injured during the clashes, including four journalists. (PALINFO 26 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured several Palestinians during protests in 'Aida refugee camp, north of Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. the protests took place near Bilal Bin Rabah Mosque before the soldiers fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades. (IMEMC 27 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians, including two journalists, during the weekly processions against the illegal colonialist activities, in Beita and Beit Dajan, near the northern West Bank city of Nablus. (IMEMC 27 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured several Palestinians during protests in 'Aida refugee camp, north of Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. (IMEMC 27 November 2021)
- Israeli navy ships attacked a Palestinian fishing boat with live fire and water cannons, near Gaza city, and abducted five fishermen, before releasing three. (IMEMC 27 November 2021)
- Israeli soldiers invaded, Saturday, Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in the occupied capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank, and summoned a young man for interrogation. The soldiers invaded the al-Wista neighborhood in Silwan and briefly detained Sofian Natsha. The sources added that the soldiers released the young man after ordering him to head to an interrogation facility. It is worth mentioning that Natsha, and Mohammad Ali al-Ghoul, 17, were abducted, Friday, from their homes in the al-Wista and Ras al-Amoud neighborhoods in Silwan, after the soldiers invaded their homes. Sofian was released, but Mohammad remained under interrogation and was remanded in custody until further deliberations that would be held, Monday. (IMEMC 27 November 2021)
- The Israeli Navy opened fire at Palestinian fishermen, while the army opened fire towards agricultural land in different areas of the besieged

Gaza Strip. Also the Israeli occupation army (IOA) opened fire towards Palestinian-owned farmland in al-Fakhari town in Khan Younis, in the southern Gaza Strip, with no reported injuries. (IMEMC 28 November 2021)

- Israeli occupation army (IOA) assaulted and dispersed a group of activists taking part in a demonstration outside the archeological Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron, south of the occupied West Bank, in protest of a plan by Israeli President Isac Herzog to visit the holy site later today to celebrate Hanuka holiday. (WAFA 28 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) invaded the Saff Street, in the center of Bethlehem city, in the occupied West Bank, abducted one Palestinian and injured dozens. Media sources said the soldiers invaded and ransacked the homes on Ismael al-Battat, looking for his son, Ali, but could not find him. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted a young man from the al-Obeydiyya town, east of Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted two young Palestinian men from Qalqilia governorate, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted three Palestinians from their homes in Anata and Abu Dis towns, near occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) ordered a halt on the construction of 22 houses in Qusra village, southeast of Nablus, according to local sources. (WAFA 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) attacked, on Sunday, a non-violent demonstration against the Israeli president's visit to the al-Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron, in the southern occupied West Bank. Palestinian factions encouraged civilians to gather at the <u>United Nations World Heritage site</u> in protest of the visit by Israeli president, Isac Herzog, for the lighting of the first candle in celebration of the Hannukah holiday, at the Muslim holy site. The IOA were seen <u>brutally attacking</u> the peaceful protesters and snatching Palestinian flags out of their hands. Palestinian officials in addition to Israeli rights groups

rejected and criticized the act, calling it a clear provocation against Palestinian muslims, the Palestinian News & Information Agency (WAFA) reported. The army also assaulted protesters at the military roadblocks as they held Palestinian flags and chanted in rejection of the occupation president's visit. WAFA added that the army closed the gates to the mosque, forced store owners to close shops and obstructed journalists from covering the assault. Herzog lit the first candle at the Muslim holy site while accompanied by illegal settler leaders and members of the Israeli Knesset in an explicit show of cooperation. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained several Palestinian civilians, including former prisoners and a cancer patient from different areas of the occupied West Bank, the Quds Press reported. (IMEMC 30 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained at least 14 Palestinians from various parts of the West Bank. (WAFA 30 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) detained a Palestinian merchant at Beit Hanoun crossing in the northern Gaza Strip. (WAFA 30 November 2021)
- Several Palestinians sustained injuries from the Israeli occupation army (IOA) gunfire and dozens others suffocated as (IOA) stormed Joseph's Tomb in Nablus city. (WAFA 30 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) approved today a decision to take over Palestinian-owned land in the villages of Qaruot and al-Sawiyeh to the south of Nablus. (WAFA 30 November 2021)
- Three Palestinians were injured by rubber bullets and many others suffered from their exposure to tear gas during violent The Israeli occupation army (IOA), who stormed the eastern area of Nablus City to provide protection for Jewish settlers. (PALINFO 30 November 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

• Israeli settlers assaulted a foreign diplomat and Palestinian olive harvesters in Tuqu' town, southeast of Bethlehem, according to local sources. Mayor of Tuqu', Tayseer Abu-Mefreh, said that South Africa's Counselor-Political, Lesiba Machaba, and the municipality staff joined Palestinian famers in picking olive groves isolated by the encroaching colonial settlement of Tekoa from the town before they were assaulted by the (IOA).(WAFA 3 November 2021)

- Several Palestinians sustained injuries from the (IOA) gunfire stormed Joseph's Tomb in Nablus city, according. The (IOA) escorted a convoy of buses packed with hundreds of fanatic Jewish settlers into the site, located in the Palestinian-controlled area, sparking confrontations with Palestinian residents. The soldiers opened fire on Palestinians protesting the raid and attempting to block settlers' access to the site, injuring several protestors with rubber-coated steel bullets and causing others to suffocate from tear gas. They occupied the rooftops of several houses in the Amman Street, east of the northern West Bank city, to secure the settler intrusion into the site. Settlers repeatedly break into Joseph's Tomb, located in a densely Palestinian populated area in Nablus, provoking chaos and confrontation with local residents. (WAFA 3 November 2021)
- Groups of fanatic illegal Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian cars on the main Jenin-Nablus road, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The Israeli occupation army (IOA) then attacked the Palestinians with gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets, instead of removing the settlers who attacked them. (IMEMC 4 NOVEMBER 2021)
- A group of illegal Israeli settlers attacked and injured a Palestinian child in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Furthermore, dozens of illegal settlers, accompanied by the (IOA) and police officers, invaded the courtyards of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied Jerusalem, and conducted provocative tours, while Israeli soldiers attacked many Palestinians to force them out of the holy compound. (IMEMC 4 NOVEMBER 2021)
- A Palestinian child was injured after a horde of Jewish settlers chased him in an attempt to assault him in al-Khalil City. The 12-year-old child Abdul-Majeed, suffered injuries after settlers chased him and made him hit a wall in ash-Shuhada street in al-Khalil City, adding that he was rushed to a local hospital. (PALINFO 4 November 2021)
- A group of settlers hurled rocks at Palestinian vehicles traveling on the road between Jenin and Nablus. (PALINFO 4 November 2021)
- Israeli army and settlers attackedvthe weekly anti-settlement procession in Kufur Qaddoum village, in rejection of the illegal colonial schemes by the Israeli occupation, a local official reported. Morad Eshteiwi, the media spokesman and coordinator of the popular resistance in the village, stated that during the march, calls rang out from the loudspeakers of local mosques warning villagers that settlers

from the nearby Kedumin settlement were attempting to steal the olive harvest from Palestinian farmers. (IMEMC 5 NOVEMBER 2021)

- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian farmers harvesting their olive crops in the town of Surif, northwest of the occupied West Bank city of Hebron. Hassouna Al-Hih, a group of settlers broke into an outskirt north of the town and attacked Palestinian farmers as they were harvesting their olive crops. At least one light injury was reported. (WAFA 5 November 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers attacked and attempted to destroy a children's playing ground outside the flashpoint village of Susia, to the southwest of Hebron city in the south of the occupied West Bank. Around 200 Israeli settlers attacked the playing ground and attempted to smash some of the fixtures and equipment that were installed by the France-based Action Against Hunger for the area's children. (WAFA 6 November 2021)
- Three Palestinians sustained fractures and bruises in a fresh attack by hardcore Israeli settlers on the village of Burin, to the south of Nablus in the occupied West Bank. A group of Israeli settlers who apparently came from the nearby illegal Israeli settlement of Yitzhar attacked homes of Palestinians on the outskirts of the village and assaulted local residents, causing fractures to a local Palestinian citizen, who was identified as Adel Eid. Another two Palestinians sustained bruises as a result of the attack. (WAFA 6 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian homes in Burin village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, causing damage, and wounding three Palestinians. Ghassan Daghlas, a Palestinian official who monitors Israel's illegal colonialist activities in the northern West Bank, the settlers attacked many homes in the eastern part of the village. The colonizers also assaulted Adel Eid, Khalid Bashir, and his brother Ahmad when they tried to defend their homes. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2021)
- Illegal Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinians while harvesting their olive trees in their orchards in Teqoua Palestinian village, east of Bethlehem, in the central occupied West Bank. The settlers came from the illegal Tekoa colony which was built on stolen Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2021)
- Three Palestinian citizens were injured when a horde of extremist Jewish settlers attacked homes in Burin town, south of Nablus in the

occupied West Bank. The settlers escorted by soldiers hurled rocks at homes in the eastern area of Burin and assaulted local residents. Three young men were injured as they and others tried to fend off the settlers and defend themselves, adding that Israeli soldiers fired a volley of tear gas and stun grenades at the young men to protect the settlers and secure their withdrawal from the area. The wounded young men were identified as Adel Eid, Khaled Basheer, and Ahmed Basheer. (PALINFO 7 November 2021)

- A Palestinian citizen, his wife and another woman were injured when a horde of extremist Jewish settlers assaulted locals in the Bedouin community of Tha'ala, east of Yatta town in al-Khalil province. Several settlers stormed the community and brutally attacked the local residents. (PALINFO 7 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers, illegally squatting on Palestinian lands, cut more than 45 Palestinian olive trees and destroyed a well, near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The settlers invaded Palestinian olive orchards near the Yitzhar colony and cut more than 45 trees. The attack is not the first as the settlers frequently invade Palestinian farmlands and orchards, before cutting and uprooting trees, in addition to attacking the Palestinians and their homes. In related news, a group of settlers, also from Yitzhar, destroyed a Palestinian water well, used by the farmers in the Be'er an-Nabe' as-Sofly area Madama village, south of Nablus. The well was an essential source of water to the farmers, especially since Israel keeps cutting water supplies to ensure a constant flow of water to the illegal settlements. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2021)
- Illegal settlers attacked three Palestinian civilians on their own property, east of Yatta town, south of Hebron city in the southern occupied West Bank, according to a local official. Coordinator of the Protection and Resilience Committees, at least twenty-two settlers attacked three civilians with batons, including two women, in the al-Tha'ala community. (IMEMC 8 NOVEMBER 2021)
- A horde of extremist Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian vehicles traveling on the road between Jenin and Nablus in the occupied West Bank. (PALINFO 8 November 2021)
- Illegal Israeli settlers vandalized Palestinian-owned vehicles and homes, causing damage in the central occupied West Bank city of Al-Beireh, the Quds News Network reported. Witnesses stated that the settlers entered the city overnight and slashed the tires of three

vehicles, spray-painted the star of David and hateful and threatening phrases on Palestinian-owned vehicles and homes. (IMEMC 10 November 2021)

- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinians with live fire in Khallet al-Dabe'h village, south of Hebron, injuring four. Coordinator of the Anti-Wall and Settlement Popular Committees. The Israeli settlers attacked with live fire and rocks Palestinians who gathered in response to the construction of an Israeli colonial settlement outpost in Khallet al-Dabe'h, one of Masafer Yatta hamlets, injuring four. (WAFA 11 November)
- At least one Palestinian suffered different injuries in a new settlers attack in Hawara town, south of Nablus a group of Jewish settlers assaulted Palestinian olive pickers in the Al-Lahf area, north of Hawara. (PALINFO 12 November 2021)
- A Palestinian young man sustained injuries from gunfire today after he was shot by an Israeli settler in the occupied Jerusalem neighborhood of Ras Al-Amud. Israeli settlers accompanied by an Israeli Police escort broke into the neighborhood, and that one of the settlers who was armed with a rifle opened gunfire at Palestinian civilians there, injuring one of them in his hand. The wounded young man was moved to hospital for medical treatment. (IMEMC 13 November 2021)
- Illegal Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian cars near the Za'tara military roadblock, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. Eyewitnesses said the settlers hurled stones at the cars, causing damage, in addition to trying to block Palestinian traffic and physically assault the Palestinians. Furthermore, the (IOA) installed a roadblock, closing the main Nablus-Ramallah road, starting from Beita town junction to the junction of the al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya village. The soldiers stopped and searched dozens of cars and interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards before forcing them back, without providing any reason for the closure. (IMEMC 14 November 2021)
- Three Jerusalemite citizens were injured, one by a bullet when a horde of extremist Jewish settlers stormed the east Jerusalem neighborhood of Ras al-Amud and assaulted local residents. A group of settlers from the illegal outpost near Ras al-Amud stormed the neighborhood under police escort and attacked local young men. One young man was wounded in his hand when a settler opened fire at him under the noses of police officers. He was rushed to a local hospital for medical assistance. Two other young men were also injured when the same

settlers physically attacked them. In a separate incident, another horde of settlers on the same day hurled rocks at Palestinian vehicles near the Zaatara military checkpoint in southern Nablus. Some cars sustained damage in the attack. (PALINFO 14 November 2021)

- Four illegal settler farms in the occupied West Bank have taken over Palestinian territory the size of the city of Holon (some 19,000 dunams, or 4,700 acres), or the cities of Bnei Brak (7,300 dunums) and Lod (around 12,000 dunums) combined, according to Haaretz newspaper website. (PALINFO 14 NovembeR 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian farmers near Burqa village, north of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, wounding three. The settlers assaulted Palestinian farmers on their lands near the main Jenin-Nablus road, and hurled stones at them. One Palestinian, identified as Nasser Hijja, suffered an injury to his face after a settler hurled a stone at him. Another, Palestinian, identified as Mohsin Sari, was injured in the head by a stone hurled by one of the settlers, while Shadi Abu Omar suffered cuts and bruises. The settlers also hurled stones at many Palestinian cars, causing damage to four without leading to further injuries. (IMEMC 15 November 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers, illegally squatting on Palestinian lands, burnt more than 50 Palestinian olive trees and installed two mobile homes, on lands in the Sarrara area near the illegal Asfar colony, in the Shiokh town, east of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. (IMEMC 15 November 2021)
- Dozens of Israeli settlers, escorted by Israeli police stormed the al-Aqsa Mosque compound in occupied East Jerusalem. At least 85 settlers forced their way into the mosque's compound through Bab al-Magharbeh Gate, one of the gates leading to the mosque, and carried out provocative tours in its courtyards under the protection of Israeli police. (WAFA 15 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers illegally squatting on Palestinian lands, attacked many farmers and cars near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, wounding at least three Palestinians, in addition to causing damage to several cars. Eyewitnesses said the settlers attacked many Palestinian farmers while working on their lands near Burqa village, north of Nablus, wounding at least three. (IMEMC 16 November 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers forced their way into the Al-Aqsa Mosque Compound in Occupied Jerusalem. A large group of settlers guarded by Israeli police broke into the holy Islamic site. (PALINFO 16 November 2021)

- Settlers, accompanied by Israeli soldiers, attacked today evening staff of the Land Settlement Authority while they were working in Ash-Shuyukh town to the northeast of Hebron, in the southern occupied West Bank, said WAFA correspondent. A group of settlers from the nearby illegal Israeli settlement of Asfar, attacked with stones and clubs staff of the Land Settlement Authority while they were conducting a land survey in the Ash-Shuyukh town, causing one engineer injuries to the head. Israeli soldiers stood idly by and did nothing to stop the settlers. (WAFA 17 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked with stones Palestinian vehicles passing near the entrance of the illegal Israeli settlement of Beit El, northeast of the occupied West Bank city of Ramallah. Eyewitnesses told WAFA dozens of settlers gathered along the road connecting the village of Burqa and Turmusaya town, to the east and north of Ramallah, respectively, and attacked Palestinian-registered vehicles with stones, causing damages to several cars. No injuries were reported. (WAFA 17 November 2021)
- A horde of extremist Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian vehicles traveling on a road near the illegal settlement of Beit El in the northeast of Ramallah. Settlers rallied near the traffic light at the entrance to Beit El and embarked on hurling rocks at passing cars. No one was reportedly hurt, but several cars sustained damage in the attack. (PALINFO 17 November 2021)
- A large group of Israeli settlers illegally squatting on Palestinian lands, attacked two schools near the northern West Bank city of Nablus, for the fourth consecutive days, leading to protests, before the soldiers invaded the area and fired gas bombs at the schoolchildren. (IMEMC 18 November 2021)
- Israeli soldiers and settlers attacked many Palestinian farmers and prevented them from working on their lands, in the southwestern area of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The settlers, and soldiers, attacked the farmers in the at-Tabaqa area, southwest of Hebron, and prevented them from working on their lands. And the settlers prevented the Palestinians from bringing machines, including digging tools, while the Palestinians were working on their lands in the at-Tabaqa area, west of Doura town. The settlers came from the Negohot illegal colony, which was built on stolen Palestinian lands between Dier Samit and Beit Awwa towns and the settlers repeatedly assault the farmers and try to deny them access to their lands. (IMEMC 18 November 2021)

- A large group of Israeli settlers attacked two schools near the northern West Bank city of Nablus, for the fourth consecutive days, leading to protests, before the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the area and fired gas bombs at the schoolchildren. The settlers attacked schoolchildren of the as-Sawiya Highschool and the al-Lubban Highschool for Girls, south of Nablus. The settlers also gathered in large numbers and attempted to prevent the schoolchildren from entering their educational facilities. Dozens of residents from the area, along with teachers and staffers, rushed to the schools and forced the colonizers to leave. The colonizers, accompanied by soldiers, tried to close the schools and force the students to take alternate routes when they head to their educational facilities, but the residents managed to foil the attempts. Israeli soldiers also closed the nearby main road and prevented the Palestinian cars from crossing before firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the residents. (IMEMC 18 November 2021)
- A large group of Israeli settlers attacked two schools near the northern West Bank city of Nablus, for the fourth consecutive days, leading to protests, before the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded the area and fired gas bombs at the schoolchildren. The settlers attacked schoolchildren of the as-Sawiya Highschool and the al-Lubban Highschool for Girls, south of Nablus. The settlers also gathered in large numbers and attempted to prevent the schoolchildren from entering their educational facilities. The settlers, accompanied by the IOA, tried to close the schools and force the students to take alternate routes when they head to their educational facilities, but the residents managed to foil the attempts. The IOA also closed the nearby main road and prevented the Palestinian cars from crossing before firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the residents. (IMEMC 18 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers slashed the tires of nearly a dozen Palestinian-owned vehicles in Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood in Occupied Jerusalem. A group settlers stormed a fenced-off area of Sheikh Jarrah before stabbing the tires of 13 parked cars, including one with diplomatic license plates. The cars belong to Palestinians from the local families of Shreiteh and al-Bashiti, and al-Ghazzawi, in addition to one car owned by a Palestinian who lives near the neighborhood. (PALINFO 19 November 2021)

- Several Israeli settlers hurled stones at many Palestinian cars, near Azzoun town, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, causing damage. (PALINFO 19 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian cars on the main bypass road, east of Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. A group of settlers gathered in the area and were accompanied by many Israeli soldiers. The settlers hurled stones at their cars, causing damage; no injuries were reported. (IMEMC 21 November 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers hurled stones at many Palestinian cars near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The settlers attacked many Palestinian cars on the Nablus-Ramallah Road, causing damage to several vehicles, without leading to injuries. The settlers came from the Yitzhar nearby settlement. Dozens of settlers gathered at the intersection before attacking the Palestinian cars and added that Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) were in the area but failed to intervene and stop them. (IMEMC 21 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian homes, and at least one car, in Orif village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, causing damage. The settlers came from the Yitzhar nearby settlement. The homes of Ahmad Abdul-Karim Shehada, Samir Sawalma, Jamal Abdullah Shehada, and Raed Mahmoud Rabah, sustained damage, largely to their windows and doors. The settlers caused damage to at least one car that was parked in front of one of the homes in the village. The colonizers also caused damage to one car near Turmus Ayya town, near Ramallah, causing severe damage and almost causing the driver, Nizar Abdul-Hamid Rawajba, to crash. It is worth mentioning that, on Sunday, the colonizers caused damage to dozens of Palestinian cars, driving on the main Nablus-Ramallah Road, Jenin-Nablus Road, Qalqilia-Nablus roads, and various streets linking between the various villages and towns, south of Nablus. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)
- Israeli Settlers hurled stones at many homes in the eastern part of Urif town in Nablus Governorate, causing damage. The attacked homes are owned by four Palestinians, identified as Ahmad Abdul-Karim Shehada, Jamal Abdullah Shehada, Samir Sawalma, and Raed Mahmoud Rabah. The Israeli settlers also caused damage to a parked Palestinian car, especially to its windows and windshield. (IMEMC 22 November 2021)

- Dozens of Palestinians from Burqa town, north of the northern west bank city of Nablus, intercepted an attack by Israeli settlers against their town, and forced them to leave. The Palestinians noticed the Israeli settlers invading their community, and forced them to leave. The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) also invaded the village after the settlement stormed it and started firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians. (IMEMC 23 November 2021)
- An attack took place on the Nablus-Jenin Road when the settlers hurled stones at Palestinian cars, in addition to a military invasion into Sielet ath-Thaher, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, leading to protests; The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) also fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians. (IMEMC 23 November 2021)
- Three Palestinians were today injured, one of them reported in critical condition, in Israeli settler attacks on their vehicles in the occupied West Bank. Israeli settlers threw rocks and smashed the windshield of a car driven by a Palestinian from Nablus on a road north of Ramallah causing the car to overturn. The driver was critically injured and had to be flown to hospital while his son, who was in the car, received moderate injuries. Another Palestinian was injured in a separate incident when settlers attacked his car near the village of Duma, south of Nablus, shattering the car windows. A 15-year-old girl was also moderately injured when settlers attacked a car, on a northern West Bank Road. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- Palestinian was injured in a separate incident when settlers attacked his car near the village of Duma, south of Nablus, shattering the car windows. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked today with live fire and stones Palestinian residents and their homes near the entrance to the village of Burqa, northwest of Nablus, in the northern occupied West Bank, according to a local activist. (WAFA 24 November 2021)
- Israeli forces and settlers assaulted Palestinian students on their way to school in al-Lubban Ash-Sharqiya village, south of Nablus city. Dozens of settlers, under military protection, stormed the village entrance and deliberately obstructed the arrival of students to their schools, located on the main road connecting Ramallah city to Nablus city. The soldiers, opened fire at the students and their families who came to make sure that their children safely made it schools, hitting several with rubber-

- coated steel bullets and causing others to suffocate from tear gas. (IMEMC 25 November 2021)
- Dozens of settlers, under military protection, stormed the village entrance and deliberately obstructed the arrival of students to their schools, located on the main road connecting Ramallah city to Nablus city. (IMEMC 25 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers erected a huge menorah on the roof of a historical mosque in the village of Nabi Samwil, northwest of Jerusalem. (WAFA 25 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian residents' homes in the village of Burqa to the north of Nablus, in the northern occupied West bank. (WAFA 25 November 2021)
- Illegal Israeli settlers harassed Palestinian students in the village of Al-Lubban ash-Sharqiya, south of Nablus in the northern West Bank, Quds News Network reported. And Under the full protection of the Israeli military, dozens of settlers added <u>stormed</u> the village, harassing, and chasing the students and their parents, blocking the children from reaching their school. (IMEMC 28 November 2021)
- Israeli settlers carried out a provocative rally in al-Wad Street in the Old City of occupied Jerusalem. (WAFA 30 November 2021)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) demolished a water tank in al-Khader town, south of Bethlehem. The IOA stormed Wadi ash-Shami area in the town and destroyed a water tank belonging to local residents at the pretext that it was built with no permit. (PALINFO 1 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) continued to destroy parts of the centuries-old Muslim Cemetery of Yusufiya in the Old City of Jerusalem for the eighth consecutive day, amid ongoing Palestinian protests. Jewish settlers working for the Israeli municipality in Occupied Jerusalem and the Israel nature and parks authority work day and night under police protection on bulldozing and leveling the northern part of the cemetery and preparing it for the building of a Talmudic park. (PALINFO 1 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) notified for the demolition of a Palestinian home in the town of Yabad to the west of Jenin, in the northern occupied West Bank. The IOA handed local resident Nawaf Hamdoni a notice ordering the demolition of his family house,

sheltering 11 family members, under the pretext the house was built without an Israeli-issued permit. The notice gave the family until the 11th of November to appeal the decision. (WAFA 1 November 2021)

The Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) ordered the removal of a tent used as a clinic in Khirbet Ibzeeq community in the northern Jordan Valley north of the occupied West Bank city of Tubas. The IOA recently dismantled and seized another clinic in al-Maleh community, also in the northern Jordan Valley, and also dismantled rooms belonging to the local school. Israel is trying to prevent Palestinians from developing and living in the occupied Jordan Valley, which it plans to annex. (WAFA 1 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) notified a Palestinian citizen of its intent to demolish his home in Ya'bad town, southwest of Jenin. Ya'bad mayor Samer Abu Bakr said that Nawwaf Hamdouni received a demolition notice from the (IOA)'s civil administration at the pretext of unlicensed construction. Hamdouni was given until November 11 to file an objection against the demolition order. (PALINFO 2 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) forced people to demolish, or seized eight Palestinian-owned structures across the West Bank, including East Jerusalem. This resulted in the displacement of two people, and affected the livelihoods or access to services of about 50 others, according to the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) in the occupied Palestinian territory monthly report on West Bank demolitions and displacement for the month of September. All the structures were targeted due to the lack of building permits, which are nearly impossible for Palestinians to obtain in Area C of the West Bank and East Jerusalem. (WAFA 2 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army issued demolition orders against five houses in the town of Kafr ad-Dik, west of the occupied West Bank city of Salfit, according to local sources. The (IOA) barged their way into the western part of the town, located on the main road running to the nearby town of Deir Ballut, and handed five residents notices to tear down their houses.(IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army demolished a Palestinian-owned home near Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) in east Jerusalem demolished a
 Palestinian house in Jabel Mukaber district and commercial facilities in
 Hizma town at the pretext of unlicensed construction. According to
 local sources, bulldozers escorted by police forces demolished a onestory house in the morning in as-Sal'ah area in Jabel Mukaber
 belonging to Mohamed Harroub and displaced his family. (PALINFO
 3 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) issued demolition orders against five houses in the town of Kafr ad-Dik, west of the occupied West Bank city of Salfit. The (IOA) barged their way into the western part of the town, located on the main road running to the nearby town of Deir Ballut, and handed five residents notices to tear down their houses. The (IOA) also handed another resident an order to demolish his house in the eastern part of the town, and another an order to halt the construction of his agricultural room. (PALINFO 3 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a Palestinian house and stores in the occupied city of Jerusalem, according to local sources. They said that a sizable Israeli police force escorted a bulldozer into al-Sal'a area of al-Mukkaber neighborhood, where the heavy machinery tore down a house belonging to Muhammad Harb, reducing it to rubble. Built 11 years ago, the one-storey two-apartment house was demolished purportedly for being built without a license, displacing Harb's family, which comprises eight members, including three teens under 13 years. (WAFA 3 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a Palestinian home in Jabal al-Mokabber, and several commercial facilities in Hizma town, in the occupied capital, Jerusalem, under the pretext of being built without permits. Local sources said the soldiers, accompanied by bulldozers invaded the as-Sal'a area in Jabal al-Mokabber and demolished a home, owned by Mohannad al-Hroub and his family. The sources added that, after receiving the demolition order, the Palestinian filed appeals with Israeli courts and received an order stopping the destruction of his property, but the City Council ignored the order and carried the demolitions out. The Palestinian was not granted prior notice before the soldiers invaded the area and forced him and his family out, and demolished his two-apartment home, rendering eight Palestinians, including children, homeless. In related news, dozens of soldiers invaded Hizma town, near Jerusalem, before demolishing several stores, owned by the local Khatib family. (IMEMC 4 NOVEMBER 2021)

- Israeli soldiers demolished a Palestinian mosque in Douma town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. He added that the demolished mosque, located in the Abu Saifi area, in the eastern part of the town, was built two years ago. The Israeli army claimed the mosque was built without a permit from the so-called Civil Administrative Office, the administrative branch of the illegal Israeli occupation. (IMEMC 4 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a Palestinian-owned house in Aj-Juwaya community, east of Yatta in the southern West Bank district of al-Khalil. Local sources reported that the (IOA) demolished a 150-square-meter house owned by Ismail Hussein Al-Nawaja, displacing his family, comprising 10 members. The sources affirmed that the demolition process came without any prior notice or demolition order, as a prelude to displace the community for settlement expansion aims. (PALINFO 4 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a Mosque and other structures in Duma town, southeast of Nablus. Local official Ghassan Daghlas said that a bulldozer escorted by the (IOA) stormed Duma town and knocked down a Mosque used by local residents for over two years. The (IOA) also destroyed a road, two rooms and a prefabricated structure in different areas of the town. (PALINFO 4 November 2021)
- Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a mosque in the town of Duma, south of the occupied West Bank of Nablus, local sources confirmed. The Israeli army escorted a bulldozer into the town and tore down a mosque that has been attended by worshipers for two years, east of the town. (WAFA 4 November 2021)
- The Israeli municipality ordered the demolition of a Palestinian building in Al-Tur town in the occupied city of Jerusalem. The building is housing ten Palestinian families consisting of 70 people including children. The families were given only a few days to evacuate their apartments for the demolition process. The families will self-demolish the building to avoid the heavy expenses imposed by the Israeli municipal authorities. (PALINFO 5 November 2021)
- The Israeli municipality gave the Palestinian inhabitants of an apartment building in al-Tur neighborhood, east of occupied Jerusalem, one week to demolish the four story building, Quds News Network reported. Ten Palestinian families, consisting of 70 people, are currently facing the imminent risk of displacement under the orders dictated by the occupation authorities. The Israeli municipality ordered the residents of the building, which was built in 2011, to self demolish

the structure within one week, however the families refused, so the occupation army intends to demolish the homes within that time. The municipality threatens to impose heavy fines in addition to demolition charges on the families if it carries out the demolition. The Palestinian families began evacuating their belongings early Friday morning in an effort to avoid losing their possessions when municipality crews come to destroy the building. (IMEMC 6 NOVEMBER 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished two agricultural rooms and a birds' pen in the Taybeh area in Tarqoumia town, west of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished three Palestinian homes in the al-Walaja village, west of Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank, allegedly for being built without permits. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)
- Two Palestinian families were forced to self-demolish their homes in different neighborhoods of occupied East Jerusalem. Aziz Oweisa embarked on the destruction of his own home in the Jabal al-Mokabber neighborhood in Jerusalem, under the pretext of building without an Israeli permit. Oweisa was forced to tear down his home due to the occupation army threatening to charge excessive demolition fines, after imposing an unreasonable fine of 32,000 Israeli shekels (\$10,300 US) for building without a license. The Israeli army delivered a demolition order to another Palestinian resident of the Jabal al-Mokabber neighborhood. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)
- Furthermore, in Beit Hanina town, in occupied East Jerusalem, a home was demolished by its Palestinian owner under the pretext of being built without a permit, according to the Wall and settlements Resistance Commission. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished three inhabited homes and displaced their residents in al-Walaja village, west of Bethlehem, at the pretext of unlicensed construction. The homes are located in Ein Guwaiza area of the village and belong to two brothers and their nephew from the family of Abu-Attin. The (IOA) civil administration had already demolished one of those homes before its owner rebuilt it. (PALINFO 9 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) forced a Palestinian to demolish his own house in the East Jerusalem neighborhood of Jabal al-Mukaber. Aziz Oweisa tore down his house purportedly for being built without a license after being fined 32,000 shekels (some USD \$10,000) by the occupation authorities. The Oweisa family carried out the demolition to avoid paying exorbitant fines if the Israeli municipality of Jerusalem carries out the demolition on its own. The family received the demolition order two weeks ago, nothing that they were only given until Monday evening to self-demolish the house. (AF 9 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished three Palestinian houses in al-Walaja village, west of Bethlehem. Deputy mayor of al-Walaja, Khader al-'Araj, said that Israeli forces escorted a bulldozer to the area of Ein Jwaizah, also written as Ein Jweizeh, in the northeastern part of the village, where the heavy machinery tore down a three houses, purportedly for being built without a license. The demolished houses, each of which occupied an area of some 80 square meters, belonged to three members of the Abu al-Tin family, including two brothers. (WAFA 9 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a number of structures in al-Taybeh area in the town of Tarqomiya to the west of Hebron, in the southern occupied West Bank. The (IOA) demolished two agricultural sheds and a birdhouse belonging to one of the local residents in the town. (WAFA 9 November 2021)
- Israeli forces stormed the home of Palestinian prisoner Mahmoud Jaber, demolished the inside and handed the family a demolition order for the remainder of the home, according to local sources. The (IOA) and officers of the Israeli municipality invaded the family home in the Wad al-Joz area of occupied East Jerusalem. The troops and officials proceeded to demolish the contents of the home, and demanded the family complete the demolition process or face a fine of 100,000 shekels (\$32,100 US). The demolition order is based on the commonly used pretext of being built without a license, which is nearly impossible for Palestinians to obtain. Additionally in the occupied East Jerusalem neighborhood of Beit Safafa, soldiers destroyed a 40 square meter balcony of another Palestinian-owned home, under the same pretext. (IMEMC 10 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) wreaked havoc on the interior of a Palestinian house in the east Jerusalem neighborhood of Wadi al-Joz and ordered its owners to demolish it at their own expense. According

to local sources, police forces and municipal workers went on the rampage through the house, destroying parts of its inner walls and contents. The house belongs to Jerusalemite prisoner Mahmoud Jaber, whose family started to furnish it recently to make it ready ahead of his wedding that is slated to be held following his release. (PALINFO 10 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished the inside of a Palestinian-owned house in Wad al-Joz area of occupied East Jerusalem and issued a demolition order for the entire house. The (IOA) demolished the balcony of another house in Beit Safafa neighborhood. (WAFA 10 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) had demolished a number of similar stores in the area since the start of 2021 at the pretext of their proximity to the Beit Hagai Jewish settlement. Beit Hagai has been established on Palestinian lands of Dura town and al-Khalil city since the eighties of the past century. (PALINFO 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) delivered a stop-work order against a house under construction in Artas village, south of Bethlehem. The (IOA) stormed the eastern area of Umm Rukba area in the village and handed Ismail Awad a notice ordering him to stop building a two-story house for his family. (PALINFO 14 November 2021)
- Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished three Palestinianowned structures near the Qalandia checkpoint, north of the occupied city of Jerusalem. The Israeli bulldozers demolished a supermarket, a vegetable shop, and a gas station on the West Bank side of the checkpoint. The demolitions are believed to facilitate Israeli work on two road projects for settlers that include a tunnel, and thousands of housing units for a new illegal settlement near the checkpoint. (WAFA 16 November 2021)
- The Israeli Municipality of West Jerusalem forced a Palestinian family to demolish its own home in the Ras al-Amoud neighborhood in Silwan of occupied East Jerusalem. It stated that the Burqan family began to demolish their two-storey, 300-square-meter home which they have been building for one year, in order to avoid the unreasonable fines which the municipality would impose if they were to carry out the demolition. The occupation authorities ordered the demolition one month ago, at which time the family attempted to freeze the order but it was denied. According to a family member of the home-owner, Eyad Burqan, the family had to pay 700,000 shekels (\$227,800 US) to rent the demolition equipment. (IMEMC 17 November 2021)

- Israeli authorities notified today of its intentions to demolish two agricultural shacks belonging to Palestinian residents in the village of al-Issawiya in the occupied city of Jerusalem, according to local sources. (WAFA 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authorities ordered today to stop construction and all forms of work in the Abu Sud neighborhood in the town of al-Khader, south of the occupied West Bank city of Bethlehem, according to activist Ahmed Salah. He told WAFA forces stormed the Abu Sud area and handed a local resident a notice banning construction or making any changes in the area, comprising a surface area of 100 dunums. (WAFA 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) delivered demolition and stop-work orders against 13 homes and structures in western Ramallah. The (IOA) stormed the town and put up notices informing local residents its intents to demolish a number of homes, fences and agricultural wells. Some of the demolitions will be carried out within 96 hours. (PALINFO 17 November 2021)
- The Israeli municipal authorities forced the Burqan family to self-demolish their house in Ras Al-Amoud neighborhood in Silwan, in Occupied Jerusalem. The Israeli authorities ordered the Burqan family to self-demolish their two-story home. The family, which consists of a couple and six children, was struggling to obtain an Israeli building permit over the past 20 years. (PALINFO 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) demolished two Palestinian structures in the as-Sawahra ash-Sharqiya town, east of the occupied capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. The IOA invaded the area earlier and started demolishing two agricultural structures owned by members of Obeidat and Shqeirat Palestinian families. During the invasion, personnel of the City Council in occupied Jerusalem handed another Palestinian an order to self-demolish his house in the al-Bustan neighborhood in Jerusalem. The Israeli authorities claim the structures were built without permits from the City Council; such permits are rarely granted to Palestinians, and are very difficult to obtain due to their excessively high cost. (IMEMC 21 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) demolished along with bulldozers invaded the Wadi al-Hummos area of <u>Sur Baher</u> town, southeast of Jerusalem, and demolished a three story home belonging to Ayman al-Heih. (IMEMC 23 November 2021)

- In the southern West Bank, south of Hebron, Israeli occupation Army (IOA) and bulldozers tore down a 200 square meter Palestinian-owned home in the Khirbit Maeen community in Masafer Yatta, under the pretext of building without a license. Two other houses in Khirbit al-Fakhit and Khirbit al-Markaz communities in Masafer Yatta, received demolition orders from the occupation authorities. (IMEMC 23 November 2021)
- Israeli occupation authorities along with bulldozers invaded the Wadi al-Hummos area of <u>Sur Baher</u> town, southeast of Jerusalem, and demolished a three story home belonging to Ayman al-Heih. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- In the southern West Bank, south of Hebron, Israeli forces tore down a 200 square meter Palestinian-owned home in the Khirbit Maeen community in Masafer Yatta, under the pretext of building without a license. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- Two houses in Khirbit al-Fakhit and Khirbit al-Markaz communities in Masafer Yatta, received demolition orders from the occupation authorities. (IMEMC 24 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) in the occupied capital, Jerusalem, forced a Palestinian to demolish his commercial structure and its surrounding walls. Several army jeeps invaded Jabal al-Mokabber town, in Jerusalem, and handed a Palestinian an order forcing him to demolish his structures, for being built without a permit from the city. Adham Ali Ja'abis, was forced to demolish his commercial structure and its surrounding walls. (IMEMC 27 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) in east Jerusalem has notified al-Rajabi family of its intent to demolish their apartment building in Ein al-Luza neighborhood in Silwan district at the pretext of unlicensed construction. (PALINFO 28 November 2021)
- An Israeli court has given the green light to demolish 58 Palestinian homes and displace their residents in Wadi Yasoul neighborhood in the east Jerusalem district of Silwan at the pretext of unlicensed construction. (PALINFO 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli Occupation bulldozers (IOA) demolished Palestinianowned water pipes in the northeastern occupied West Bank village of Atuf. The heavy equipment destroyed four kilometers of water line

used by farmers to irrigate their crops in Atuf village, east of Tammun town in the Jordan Valley. It is important to note that the occupation authorities frequently demolish and confiscate the essential equipment of Palestinian farmers and civilians in an attempt to force them to leave their rightfully-owned lands. In a serious violation, the army recently <u>poured cement</u> into a Palestinian water spring near Beit Ummar town, north of Hebron in the southern occupied West Bank, permanently closing it. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)

- Israeli soldiers invaded Ni'lin town, northwest of the central West Bank city of Ramallah, demolished a well and injured dozens of Palestinians who protested the violation. The Israeli military bulldozers demolished a well, owned by Fayez al-Khawaja on his own land, under the pretext that it is in a "natural reserve area." The demolished the well just a few days after it was built and was made to hold more than 270 cubic meters of water for irrigation. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation authorities ordered a halt on the construction of twenty-two houses in Qusra village, southeast of Nablus. The IOA delivered stop-construction orders against twenty-two houses besides to a demolition order against an agricultural shed in the village. (IMEMC 29 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) demolished a Palestinian-owned home in Silwan town in the occupied city of Jerusalem. The IOA accompanied by bulldozers, surrounded and invaded the Beer Ayoub neighborhood of Silwan town and proceeded to tear down the home under the pretext of having no Israeli permit to build, rendering the family homeless. The owner of the home, Mohammad Zaytoon, a married father of three children, refused to self-demolish the home he has lived in for five years. In addition soldiers assaulted and obstructed the work of journalists attempting to cover the violations. (IMEMC 30 November 2021)
- In the occupied Jerusalem of town Jabal al-Mokabber, Amir Rabay'a, was forced to demolish his own home after receiving an order from the 'Israeli municipality' to avoid paying demolition fees if the municipality destroys the home. (IMEMC 30 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) dismantled a Palestinian house in the East Jerusalem neighborhood of Silwan. (WAFA 30 November 2021)

Israeli Military Orders

- An Israeli court on Wednesday ordered seven Palestinian families to evacuate their homes in the east Jerusalem district of Sheikh Jarrah. The seven families threatened with displacement live in Kabaniyat Umm Harun area in the west of Sheikh Jarrah. (PALINFO 4 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) delivered stop-work orders against nine Palestinian homes in southern Qalqilya. According to local sources, Palestinian citizens received military notices ordering them to stop building nine homes in the hamlets of Arab al-Ramadin and Abu Farda, which are located behind the separation wall. The (IOA) justified the measure by claiming that the homes are located in Area C of the West Bank, which is under its control. 70 Palestinians live in the impoverished hamlets of Arab al-Ramadin and Abu Farda, southeast of Qalqilya. (PALINFO 8 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) ordered stop on the construction of nine homes to the southeast of the West Bank city of Qalqilya. The (IOA) stormed 'Arab ar Ramadin and Arab Abu Farda communities, isolated by the section of Israel's apartheid and annexation wall, where they handed stop-construction orders against nine homes purportedly for being located in Area C. (WAFA 8 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) delivered stop-work orders against several houses in Masafer Yatta, south of al-Khalil, as a prelude to demolishing them later. A local residents in different areas of Masafer Yatta received stop-work orders against seven homes at the pretext of unlicensed construction. (PALINFO 9 November 2021).

Confiscation & Razing of lands

- The Palestinian residents of Jerusalem's Sheikh Jarrah today rejected an Israeli court's ruling delaying their forced expulsion from their houses. Residents of the neighborhood, which became a scene of massive protests against Israel's settler-colonialism in the occupied territories, said in a press statement that they unanimously rejected the "compromise" proposed by the Israeli occupation court under which they shall be "protected tenants", not the owners of their property, while pointing that the "compromise" recognizes the ownership of the settler-colonial group Nahalat Shimon to the land and paves the way for stripping them of their ownership right to their lands. (IMEMC 3 NOVEMBER 2021)
- In the northeast of Jerusalem, a large number of (IOA) stormed an area in Hizma town near a military checkpoint and razed multiple stores

belonging to the family of al-Khateeb. The Israeli municipality demolished the stores without informing the family in advance. (PALINFO 3 November 2021)

- Israeli occupation army (IOA) razed a Palestinian house in Aj-Juwaya community, east of Yatta in the southern West Bank district of Hebron. Coordinator of the Protection and Resilience Committees, the (IOA) demolished a 150-square-meter house owned by Ismail Hussein Al-Nawaja, displacing his family, comprising 10 members. (WAFA 3 November 2021)
- A group of Israeli settlers illegally squatting on stolen Palestinian lands, attacked many Palestinian homes and burnt a small mobile home east of Surif town, north of the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The settlers came from the illegal Beit Ayin colony which was installed on Palestinian lands in khallet Shu'ab al-Qandour area, in Surif. Ghneimat added that the settlers hurled stones at many homes in the area, causing damage, in addition to burning a small mobile home owned by Khalil Abu 'Ahour. Many Palestinians gathered in the area and forced the colonizers to leave. (IMEMC 6 NOVEMBER 2021)
- A group of Jewish settlers cut down 45 olive trees in Burin town, south
 of Nablus, in the northern occupied West Bank. Ghassan Daghlas, the
 official in charge of the settlement file in the northern West Bank,
 affirmed that 45 olive trees were cut down in a settler attack in Burin
 town near Yitzhar illegal settlement. (PALINFO 6 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) sprayed toxins into a Palestinian olive orchard in Battir town, west of Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank, destroying dozens of olive saplings. (IMEMC 9 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) razed a livestock barn in al-Khader town, south of Bethlehem. The (IOA) escorted a bulldozer to al-Suwaneh area in the southwestern section of the town, where the heavy machinery tore down a livestock barn belonging to Mohammad Sbeih, purportedly for being built without a license. (WAFA 10 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) destroyed dozens of olive trees in the town of Battir, west of the occupied West Bank city of Bethlehem. The (IOA) sprayed chemicals and herbicides to damage recently-planted olive grove belonging to Ghassan Oweina, east of the town, under the pretext that they were planted in an area classified as "state land". (WAFA 10 November 2021)

- Israeli military bulldozers razed Palestinian lands east of Khan Younis in the southern besieged Gaza strip. The five bulldozers, 2 graters infiltrated into Palestinian territory, across the so-called security fence, while military tanks were situated along the fence to provide cover for the invading machines. The heavy machinery was seen razing large sections of Palestinian-owned farm land east of Abasan al-Jadida town in Khan Younis, 70 meters past the Israeli border fence. The (IOA) has maintained a brutal air, land and sea blockade on the tiny coastal enclave for the past 15 years, in addition to launching 4 major military offensives against the more than two million inhabitants. The military frequently invades Palestinian-owned farm land, opens fire on farmers, and the Navy harasses fishermen while they attempt to fish in the Mediterranean sea. (IMEMC 10 NOVEMBER 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) razed a Palestinian car parts store in al-Harayeq area, south of Hebron, according to local sources. The Israeli army escorted a bulldozer into the area, where the heavy machinery tore down his 600-square-meter car parts store, purportedly for being close to the nearby encroaching colonial settlement of Beit Hagai. (WAFA 11 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) accompanied by many settlers, uprooted more than 130 trees and bulldozed farmlands in Beit Ummar town, north of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) uprooted more than 130 almond trees, in addition to bulldozing large areas of farmlands near the illegal Karmie Tzur colony, which was built on stolen Palestinian lands. The bulldozed lands and trees are in an area of 5 Dunams, and are owned by the local families of Sa'id Ba'ran and Sabarna. (WAFA 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) razed a Palestinian auto parts store in southern al-Khalil on Thursday. Local sources said that IOF soldiers tore down the 600 square meters store owned by Ahmed Salhab. (PALINFO 12 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) leveled large tracts of land and bulldozed hundreds of olive trees belonging to Palestinians in the al-Ras area in Salfit in the central West Bank. The Israeli bulldozers uprooted around 250 olive trees, aged 7 and 10 years old, in al-Ras area under the pretext the land is located in area C of the West Bank, under full Israeli administrative and military control. Forces also leveled large tracts of land and demolished several retaining walls in the area. (WAFA 15 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) confiscated a Palestinian tractor in al-Boqei'a Meadow, in the Northern Plains of the Jordan Valley, in the occupied West Bank. The soldiers invaded Palestinian farmlands and confiscated a bulldozer, owned by Nathir Mohammad Bisharat. The lands are close to two illegal colonies that were built on Palestinian lands and are subject to frequent violations by the soldiers and the colonizers. (IMEMC 25 November 2021)
- Israeli soldiers bulldozed Palestinian farmland, and closed agricultural roads near Sbeih Mountain, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The soldiers closed agricultural roads leading to the mountain by placing sandhills to prevent the Palestinians from reaching and working on their lands. The soldiers also bulldozed lands in the area, an act that has been a recurrent violation every Thursday, aiming at preventing the Palestinian vehicles, including ambulances, from reaching the mountain. (IMEMC 25 November 2021)
- Israeli bulldozers destroyed water pipes that supplies hundreds of acres of Palestinian-owned lands in the village of Atuf, east of the town of Tammun in the Jordan Valley area, northeast of the occupied West Bank. (WAFA 28 November 2021)

Expansion of settlements

• The Israeli "Construction and Planning Committee" of the City Council in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem, has approved the construction of what is called a "new neighborhood" in the illegal Atarot colony, north of Jerusalem. The new constructions would take place on more than 1243 Dunams and added that the plan also includes a commercial area. The plan also includes hotels and public infrastructures in addition to more than a thousand residential units on the illegally occupied Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 25 November 2021)
