Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 8 February 2022

I he daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

• Israeli soldiers injured, on Monday evening, many Palestinians in the Al-Khader town, south of Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank. Media sources said several army jeeps invaded the town, leading to protests that the soldiers suppressed with live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. They added that many Palestinians, including those in their homes, suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers were also extensively deployed near the Annexation Wall, separating the Palestinians from their lands in the town. (IMEMC 8 February 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

• Israeli forces destroyed, on Tuesday, a 250-cubic-meter water reservoir belonging to a Palestinian resident of Furush Beit Dajan village east of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, according to a local official. Azzam al-Hajj Mohammad, the mayor of Furush Beit Dajan stated that the occupation army accompanied a bulldozer into the village and demolished a water tank owned by a local resident identified as Thabet Abu Thabet. The Israeli occupation seeks to force Palestinians to leave their land by depriving them of their natural resources, under the pretext of being located in 'Area C', which is under full Israeli civil and military control.
