Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

27 April 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers shot an elderly Palestinian man after dozens of soldiers and colonizers invaded the archeological area in Kifl Hares town, north of Salfit in the central West Bank. Hundreds of colonizers invaded the town and headed to the archeological area accompanied by dozens of soldiers and prevented the Palestinians from approaching it. The soldiers were extensively deployed, since evening hours, at all roads leading to the town before invading it. The soldiers imposed a curfew and forced all stores shut before ordering the Palestinians to leave so that the colonizers could “tour” the area. The invasion led to massive protests before the soldiers started firing live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs at the protesters and surrounding homes. An elderly man, Yousef Saleh Abu Shadi, 75, was shot with a rubber-coated steel bullet. (IMEMC 27 April 2022)
- Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian young man after shooting him with a live round in the head in the Jenin refugee camp. The slain Palestinian has been officially identified as Ahmad Mohammad Lutfi Masad, 18, from Burqin town, west of Jenin. The soldiers also shot and moderately injured three young men during the invasion. The soldiers also shot a child, 16, with a live round in the leg, a young man, 19, with a live round in the pelvis, and another young man, 19, with two live rounds in the arm and leg. The Israeli army also stormed and ransacked dozens of homes, causing excessive property damage. (IMEMC 27 April 2022)
- Israeli navy ships attacked several Palestinian fishing boats near the Rafah shore, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip, abducted six fishermen, and confiscated their boats. The navy attacked several fishing boats with live fire and water cannons before abducting six fishermen on two boats. The abducted fishermen have been identified as Mahmoud Nabil Bardaweel, Mohammad Iseed Bardaweel, Mohammad Ayman Bardaweel, Mohammad Ibrahim Bardaweel, Ibrahim Hweishel Abu Adwan, and Mohammad Is’eid Abu Baten. The six fishermen and the two boats were taken to an Ashdod Port; the attacks forced the other fishermen to leave the

- area without being able to fish to provide for their families. (IMEMC 27 April 2022)
- The Israeli army and the navy attacked many Palestinian farmers, shepherds, and fishing boats near Khan Younis and Gaza city in the besieged coastal region. The soldiers stationed on military towers across the perimeter fence fired many live rounds and gas bombs at Palestinian farmers on their lands, east of Khuza'a town, east of Khan Younis, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip. The soldiers also fired several live rounds at Palestinian shepherds in the area, forcing them to leave. The attack did not lead to casualties but forced the farmers to leave their lands, fearing further violations. In addition, Israeli navy ships fired many live rounds at Palestinian fishing boats near Gaza city shore, forcing them to leave. (IMEMC 27 April 2022)
 - An Israeli military court approved the administrative detention of Palestinian lawmaker Ahmed Attoun, an exile from Occupied Jerusalem. The court in Ofer jail approved a request filed by the Israeli intelligence to detain MP Attoun administratively for four renewable months. The Israeli occupation forces kidnaped MP Attoun on April 1, 2022 from his home in Bethlehem, south of the West Bank. He had been released eight months ago from an Israeli jail following 12 months in administrative detention. He was detained and jailed repeatedly and spent a total of 16 years in different Israeli prisons. In addition to Attoun, there are seven Palestinian lawmakers being held in Israeli jails. They are Mohamed Abu Tir, Hasan Yousef, Khaled Tafesh, Naser Abdul-Jawwad, Yasser Mansour, Ahmed Sa'daat and Marwan al-Barghouthi. (PALINFO 27 April 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli colonizers attacked a Palestinian man in Kisan village, east of Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank, wounding him in the head and several other parts of his body. The colonizers came from the illegal Abie Hanahal outpost, built on stolen Palestinian lands. The colonizers attacked the man, Raja Barakat Obeyyat, 68, with batons and pepper spray while working on his land in the Thahrat al-Mizrab area in the southern part of the village. Obeyyat suffered a deep laceration to the head, and various cuts and bruises. It is worth mentioning that the colonizers previously installed a tent on Obeyyat's land to occupy it. - Israeli colonizers attacked several Palestinian homes in Burqa village, northwest of Nablus in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers came from the area of the evacuated Homesh colony. The soldiers attacked many homes, causing damage before the locals intercepted them, leading to protests. Israeli soldiers invaded the village and started firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the locals instead of removing the colonizers, causing many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. - Israeli colonizers continued, for the third day, the bulldozing of Palestinian lands in the al-Farisiya area of the Northern Plains of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers resumed the bulldozing in the morning hours Tuesday, near a tent and a water tank they brought more than a year ago. The colonizers brought more bulldozers and other heavy machinery to continue the bulldozing and the uprooting of the Palestinian lands. The colonizers are preparing for a new outpost on the Palestinian lands in al-Farisiya. (IMEMC 27 April 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) stormed Jenin at dawn and delivered a military demolition order against the house of Raad Hazem. The IOF raided a building in Jenin refugee camp and put up a demolition notice on the door of an apartment belonging to Raad Hazem. The military order gave Hazem's family one week to file a petition against the measure. (PALINFO 27 April 2022)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

- Israeli soldiers bulldozed Palestinian agricultural lands and installed several military tents in the Masafer Yatta area, south of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers bulldozed seven kilometers of Palestinian lands in Jinba, al-Halawa, and al-Markaz communities. The soldiers are trying to impose a tight siege on the area, especially the lands near the Annexation Wall, to prevent the workers from crossing through breaches of the illegal Wall.
