Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 8 April 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- A Palestinian child lost his left eye after being directly shot with a rubber bullet during Israeli occupation forces (IOF) attacks on protestors near al-Ram village's northern intersection, north of occupied East Jerusalem. Dozens of Palestinian young men and boys gathered near the northern The Palestinian child was identified as Mohammed Eyad Mousa Motawer (17) and he sustained a rubber bullet in his left eye while present -along with other children- 15 meters away from the Israeli soldiers. The boy had sustained wounds in his right eye 10 year ago; hence, he is now severely visually impaired. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians in Sbeih Mountain in Beit Dajan village, east of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The Palestinians held the weekly procession against Israel's illegal activities and ongoing violations before the soldiers attacked them with gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets. The soldiers caused eleven Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The Israeli concussion grenades caused burns to one Palestinian and a young man was shot with a gas bomb in the back. Two Palestinians were also injured after falling while the soldiers chased them. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured four Palestinians during the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum, east of Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers attacked the procession with rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Four Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets and several others suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
- Israeli navy ships fired several live rounds at Palestinian fishing boats near Rafah and Gaza city in the besieged Gaza Strip before abducting four fishermen and confiscating two boats. The navy fired many live rounds and used water cannons against the fishing boats near the Rafah shore, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip. The navy confiscated two boats and abducted the four fishermen on board before moving them to Ashdod Port. After a few hours in captivity, the fishermen were released, but their boats were confiscated. Also, the navy fired live rounds at Palestinian fishing

boats in the Sudaniyya Sea area, northwest of Gaza city, causing damage and forcing the fishermen to return to the shore. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)

- Israeli soldiers shot three young Palestinian men with live ammunition west of Tulkarem, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers fired many live rounds and rubber-coated steel bullets at Palestinians near the Annexation Wall, west of Tulkarem. The soldiers shot three young men, between the ages of 20 and 22, with live ammunition in their backs. It is worth mentioning that the army deployed hundreds of soldiers across the Annexation Wall in the northern, western, and southern areas of Tulkarem to prevent the workers from heading to their work in Jerusalem and other areas across the wall. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
- Three Palestinian young men were injured as clashes broke out at dawn in the vicinity of the Israeli Gishori industrial complex, west of Tulkarem, between Israeli occupation forces (IOF) and Palestinian youths. The clashes erupted after the IOF opened fire at a group of youths, injuring three of them aged between 20 and 22. The injured Palestinians suffered gunshot injuries in the back and thigh. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)
- Israeli Soldiers reinforced military presence near the separation wall, south and west of Tulkarem, and prevented Palestinian workers from reaching their workplaces within the Green Line. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces (IOF) arrested two young men after shooting them near the village of Turmusiya, north of Ramallah, in the central West Bank. The IOF soldiers opened fire at the young men near the village of Turmusiya, injuring two young men with live bullets, before arresting them. The youths were from the nearby village of Abu Falah. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)
- Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) imposed more restrictions on West Bankers' entry to the al-Aqsa Mosque compound in Jerusalem on the first Friday prayer in the holy month of Ramadan. Large numbers of Palestinians, above the age of 50, were stopped and prevented from crossing Qalandia checkpoint, north of Occupied Jerusalem, although the Israeli liaison office with the Palestinians allowed men over the age of 50 and women of all ages to attend the Friday prayer. Israeli forces, stationed at Qalandia checkpoint, demanded special permits to allow West Bankers' entry. 3,200 Israeli police officers were deployed across the occupied city of Jerusalem. Israeli occupation forces also closed Al-Jalama checkpoint, north of Jenin, in the northern West Bank. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)

• A number of Palestinian young men were injured by Israeli occupation forces (IOF) gunfire during West Bank protests. IOF soldiers opened gunfire and fired gas bombs at Palestinian protestors to quell the antisettlement marches, injuring several youths in separate places in the West Bank. A Palestinian young man was injured in his thigh, another in his back, four young men with rubber-coated metal bullets, and 11 suffered breathing difficulties in different areas in the occupied West Bank. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli colonizers attacked many Palestinian cars near Beit Furik junction, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers gathered near the Israeli military roadblock at Beit Furik's main entrance and started throwing stones at the Palestinian cars. They added that the attacks caused damage to several Palestinian cars without leading to injuries. Israeli soldiers stationed at the roadblock did not try to remove the colonizers and instead ordered the Palestinians to leave the area. Similar attacks by the colonizers occurred in many areas along the Ramallah-Nablus Road and near Gush Etzion junction, south of Bethlehem, causing damage to several Palestinian vehicles. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
- Israeli colonizers shot two Palestinians at the main entrance of Turmus Ayya town, north of Ramallah in the central West Bank. Israeli colonizers shot the two young men before many Israeli army jeeps rushed to the area. Their conditions and the reason for the shooting remained unknown. An ambulance from the Palestinian Red Crescent Society (PRCS) also arrived at the scene; however, the army did not allow the medics to approach the wounded Palestinians. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
- A group of Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian vehicles near the entrance to Beit Furik town, east of Nablus, damaging many of them. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)
- A group of settlers stoned Palestinian cars near Silwad town in Ramallah.
 (PALINFO 8 April 2022)
- Israeli settlers carried out retaliatory attacks on Palestinian citizens' vehicles near the nearby village of Singil and threw stones at them. The settlers

gathered at Ein Ayub, west of Ramallah, threw stones at citizens' vehicles, and chased youths. (PALINFO 8 April 2022)

Israeli Closures

• Israeli soldiers closed many roads leading to villages and towns south of Hebron in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Media sources said the soldiers closed the entrance of the al-Fawwar refugee camp south of Hebron and the Halhoul Bridge area north of the city and prevented the Palestinians from entering or leaving it, leading to protests. The soldiers fired many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the Palestinians and surrounding homes. In addition, the army closed the main roads leading to Doura and ath-Thaheriyya towns south of Hebron and prevented the Palestinians from crossing. The soldiers stopped and searched dozens of cars and interrogated the Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 8 April 2022)
