

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 27 June 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Many Israeli armored military vehicles invaded Jenin city, in the northern West Bank, and surrounded several homes and residential buildings before storming and ransacking them. During the Jenin invasion, the soldiers abducted four young men from the local Sheikh family and shot two with live ammunition. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- Several Israeli army jeeps invaded Silwad town, east of Ramallah, in the central West Bank. During the Silwad invasion, the soldiers broke into homes and abducted Tal'at Hamed, Mohammad Sobeh, and Mohammad Hammad. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded the al-Jalazoun refugee camp in Ramallah and searched many homes before abducting Issa Safi, Mustafa Zeid Kharroub, Ibrahim Qattash, and Yousef Saleh Abu Sharifa. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded the Deheishe refugee camp, south of Bethlehem, searched many homes, and abducted six Palestinians, including a husband, his wife, and their son. The abducted Palestinians are Karim Mustafa al-Atrash, 58, his wife 'Aida, 55, and their son, Mohammad, 29, in addition to Omran Issa Ma'ali, 43, Ma'ali Ahmad Ma'ali, 34, and Jihad Issa Ma'ali. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- In Jenin, in the northern West Bank, the Israeli soldiers abducted four siblings, Qussai, Odai, Ahmad, and Mohammad Ibrahim Sheikh. During the Invasion in Jenin, the soldiers shot a young man with a live round in the knee and his condition was described as moderate. Several Palestinian protested the Invasion. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- In Hebron, in the southern part of the West Bank, the Israeli soldiers violently searched many homes in the Wad as-Summan area and abducted Malek Hashem al-Atrash, 39, Ahmad Mahmoud Abu Turki, 60, and his brother Yahia, 38. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)

• In Nablus in the northern West Bank, violent clashes erupted in Beit Ur al-Tahta and Beit Liqya towns, west of Ramallah, after being violently stormed by the Issraeli occupation Forces. (PALINFO 27 June 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Dozens of Jewish settlers stormed al-Aqsa Mosque under heavy police protection. The settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. (PALINFO 27 June 2022)
- Israeli colonizers cut dozens of Palestinian olive trees in an orchard in Tammoun town, south of Tubas, in the northeastern West Bank. The colonizers invaded an orchard in the Khallet al-Khalayel area, east of Tammoun, and the trees. The orchard's owner, Mahmoud Abu Da'if, stated that the colonizers cut forty-six olive trees and fled to a nearby colony. The colonizers have lately been invading Palestinian lands in the area to install new illegal colonialist outposts. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- A group of illegal Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian homes in Yitma village, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers attacked several homes, causing damage. The locals intercepted the attack and forced the colonizers to leave their village. Following the attack, Israeli soldiers closed several streets leading to the village, blocking Palestinian traffic while the colonizers gathered at a near intersection. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- Israeli colonizers invaded the Khallet Khader area in the Northern Plains of the occupied West Bank and installed an outpost to turn the area into a segregated public park. The colonizers invaded the area and started the installation of an outpost, including building wooden benches and placing umbrellas and other facilities. The colonizers started rehabilitation the spring area a year earlier to turn it into a public park after forcing the Palestinian landowner out. At the time, Israeli soldiers demolished several structures, including the residence of the Palestinian. Israeli colonizers also occupied the nearby Ein al-Hilwa spring and installed a park after forcing the Palestinians out of their lands. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)

- Israeli colonizers demolished an irrigation pool in Birzeit town, north of the central West Bank city of Ramallah. Lafi Kassis, the pool's owner, stated that several army vehicles, including a bulldozer, invaded the town and surrounded his land. The soldiers then demolished his 250 cubic meters pool that was used to provide water for his 45-Dunam vineyard. The demolition was conducted without warning or notice, an issue that deprived him of the right to file an appeal. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- Hordes of Jewish settlers seized 10 dunums of Palestinian-owned lands in the West Bank city of Bethlehem. According to the activist, Ahmad Salah, Jewish settlers confiscated Palestinian-owned lands south of the al-Khader village south of Bethlehem and proceeded to cultivate the lands. In another development, the Israeli occupation authority (IOA) on Tuesday issued stop-work orders against three Palestinian houses in the al-Twani village, south of the West Bank city of al-Khalil, under the pretext of construction without a permit, according to the coordinator of the Protection and Resilience Committees, Fuad Al-Amour. Earlier in the morning, the IOA demolished an agricultural room belonging to the Palestinian citizen Muhammad Ghayatha after storming the Nahalin village west of the West Bank city of Bethlehem. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- Hordes of Jewish settlers seized 10 dunums of Palestinian-owned lands in the West Bank city of Bethlehem. Jewish settlers confiscated Palestinianowned lands south of the al-Khader village south of Bethlehem and proceeded to cultivate the lands. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) issued stop-work orders against three Palestinian houses in the al-Twani village, south of the West Bank city of al-Khalil, under the pretext of construction without a permit. The IOA demolished an agricultural room belonging to the Palestinian citizen Muhammad Ghayatha after storming the Nahalin village west of the West Bank city of Bethlehem. (IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- Palestinian citizens fended off a horde of settlers who attacked homes in Madama village, south of Nablus. Settlers from the illegal settlement of Yitzhar attacked homes in the southern area of Madama before local residents confronted them and forced them to escape. (PALINFO 27 June 2022)

- A Palestinian suffered a head injury and his car was torched after settlers assaulted local farmers in an agricultural area near the villages of al-Mughayyir and Turmus Ayya in eastern Ramallah. (PALINFO 27 June 2022)
- violent clashes broke out Between Palestinian youths and the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) in Husan village, west of Bethlehem. The clashes started after the IOF stormed Husan village and embarked on showering young men and homes with tear gas canisters. Dozens of young men reportedly suffered from their exposure to tear gas during the events. (PALINFO 27 June 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli soldiers invaded the Khirbat Ibziq village, east of Tubas in the northeastern West Bank, and confiscated a caravan owned by the Local Council, a solar power cell, and a water tank. The Israeli soldiers invaded the village before destroying and confiscating a solar power cell. The soldiers also confiscated a caravan used by the local council and a water tank that could hold two cubic meters. The soldiers also destroyed a residential tent, a tent, and an agricultural pool that could hold five cubic meters of water. (PALINFO, IMEMC 27 June 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces demolished a Palestinian-owned water pond in the town of Birzeit, north of Ramallah, which a local landowner named Lafi Qassis was using to irrigate his grape field. The Israeli soldiers accompanied by a bulldozer came to his land and demolished the pond, which can hold up to 250 cubic meters of water, Qassis had built to collect rainwater he was using to irrigate his 45-dunum plot planted with grapes. The demolition took place without any prior notice. (WAFA, PALINFO 27 June 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) issued a stop-construction order against a number of houses in the Al-Masara village, south of Bethlehem, for being allegedly built without Israeli permit. (PALINFO 27 June 2022)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) began the process of registering ownership of land adjacent to the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. As part of the process, the land at the Ophel Archaeological Park, which lies between the City of David National Park and the western wall of the al-Aqsa Mosque is also included in the land registry. The parcel of land in question is being registered with government funding earmarked for narrowing economic disparities and "improving the quality of life of Palestinian residents of Jerusalem". In practice, however, it is primarily being used to register land for Jews, while Palestinians are generally leery of cooperating with the effort. The registration process in the area could spark protests from the Waqf, the Muslim religious trust that administers the Mosque's compound, and from the Palestinians and the Jordanians, among others.
