Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 3 June 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians in Beit Ummar town, north of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The army closed the town's main entrance before several army jeeps invaded it, leading to protests. The soldiers fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians and surrounding homes. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation before local medics provided them with the needed treatment. (IMEMC 3 June 2022)
- Israeli soldiers killed a Palestinian child in the al-Midya village, west of the central West Bank city of Ramallah. The soldiers shot Odah Mohammad Odah Sadaqa, 17, with an expanding bullet in the chest. Odah was playing with other children near the Wall when a soldier shot him in the back. The situation was calm, as there were no protests in the entire area when a soldier killed the child. (IMEMC 3 June 2022)
- Israeli gunboats attacked Palestinian fishermen off Gaza shores. The fishermen came under gunfire attack from Israeli gunboats as they were working within a few nautical miles off the shores of as-Sudaniya and Waha areas in the north of Gaza City. (PALINFO 3 June 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli colonizers started the installation of a new outpost on stolen Palestinian lands in the Khirbat al-Farisiyya area in the Northern Plains of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers started setting up the new outpost on the stolen lands to install a Yeshiva for the nearby illegal Givat Salit colony, built on private Palestinian lands, even without a permit from the Israeli government but was later "retroactively legalized." The colonizers closed the area and are ongoing with the work of building their outpost and have, for the last two months, been bulldozing and uprooting the Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 3 June 2022)
- Israeli colonizers started, the installation of a new outpost on stolen Palestinian lands in the Khirbat al-Farisiyya area in the Northern Plains of

the occupied West Bank. The colonizers started setting up the new outpost on the stolen lands to install a Yeshiva for the nearby illegal Givat Salit colony, built on private Palestinian lands, even without a permit from the Israeli government but was later "retroactively legalized." The colonizers closed the area and are ongoing with the work of building their outpost and have, for the last two months, been bulldozing and uprooting the Palestinian lands. A few days ago, Israeli soldiers invaded the area and confiscated several Palestinian cars, bulldozers, and tractors. (IMEMC 3 June 2022)

• Israeli soldiers injured a young man after the locals intercepted an attack by illegal Israeli colonizers against Nabi Saleh village, northwest of Ramallah, in the central West Bank. Many colonizers from the illegal Halamish colony, built on stolen Palestinian land, invaded the southern area of the village to remove a Palestinian flag that was recently installed on a pole in the village. The colonizers tried to reach the flag, but dozens of Palestinians rushed to the area and scuffled with the assailants, forcing the colonizers, who fired several live rounds, to retreat before Israeli soldiers invaded the village and started firing live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs at the Palestinians. The soldiers shot a young man with a rubber-coated steel bullet under his left eye before being rushed to a hospital in a moderate-but-stable condition. (IMEMC 3 June 2022)

Expansion of Israeli settlements

• The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) has endorsed plans for building 952 new housing units in southern Jerusalem – Har Gilo West – on 942 dunums of land. The IOA municipality's so-called Local Planning and Building Committee said that the two-phased project would be carried out in the southern areas of Jerusalem. The first stage would include the building of 560 housing units (on 204 dunums of land) while in the second stage 392 housing units would be built. (ARIJ, PALINFO 3 June 2022)
