Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

5 June 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers abducted a young Palestinian man and searched many homes in Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers abducted a young man, Dia' Abu Aisha, after stopping him in the southern area of Hebron's Old City, and took him to an unknown destination. The soldiers also invaded and searched many homes in the Salayma neighborhood in Hebron, causing damage, and interrogated several Palestinians. Furthermore, the army installed roadblocks on various roads leading to Hebron city and several surrounding towns, stopped and searched dozens of cars, and interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 5 June 2022)
- Israeli soldiers abducted a wounded young Palestinian man from an ambulance, rushing him to a hospital in occupied Jerusalem. The soldiers attacked dozens of Palestinian protesters near the Shu'fat military roadblock in Jerusalem and fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. Many protesters hurled stones and used fireworks to target the military roadblock. The soldiers shot a young man with live fire and then abducted him from a Palestinian ambulance transporting him to a hospital. The army attacked the ambulance and the medics before abducting the young man, who was taken to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 5 June 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces (IOF) opened fire at Palestinian farmers and shepherds in the southern and central Gaza Strip. Israeli soldiers stationed in military watchtowers at the Sofa army base opened their heavy machine-gun fire towards agricultural lands to the east of Rafah city in the southern Gaza Strip and fired teargas bombs at the farmers. - The Israeli Occupation Forces (IOA) in Abu Mutabiq military site opened fire at Palestinian herders east of the al-Maghazi refugee camp in central Gaza Strip, forcing them to leave the area. The IOF regularly opens fire at Palestinian farmers and shepherds in the Gaza border areas. (PALINFO 5 June 2022)
- The Israeli Occupation Forces (IOA) stormed different areas of Jenin province, including the city and its refugee camp, and clashed with local

- youths. Clashes also took place near the Jalamah checkpoint in the northeast of Jenin. The IOF also stormed the villages of Tayba, Anin and Zububa and intensified its presence in areas near the towns of Silat al-Harithiya and Yamun in western Jenin. (PALINFO 5 June 2022)
- In Hebron, the Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF) kidnaped a Palestinian citizen identified as Diya Abu Eisha during his presence in the southern area of the Old City. The IOF also raided several homes in Salaymeh neighborhood in al-Khalil City, with no reported arrests. (PALINFO 5 June 2022)
 - The Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF) quelled Palestinian citizens and peace activists participating in a rally held to protest an Israeli demolition campaign and settlement expansion in Masafer Yatta, south of Hebron. Dozens of citizens and activists were assaulted by Israeli soldiers and suffered from their exposure to tear gas in Masafer Yatta. (PALINFO 5 June 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Dozens of illegal Israeli colonizers and police officers invaded the Al-Aqsa Mosque in the occupied capital, Jerusalem, in the West Bank. The colonizers, approximately 480, accompanied by the police, invaded the courtyards of the holy site in eleven groups. The soldiers surrounded the holy site and closed all gates and roads leading to it, before preventing the Palestinians from entering it. The soldiers also abducted at least two Palestinians in al-Aqsa and assaulted many others while trying to force them out of the holy compound. The soldiers also surrounded the al-Qibli Mosque in the Al-Aqsa compound and closed its gate with iron chains. The soldiers fired many rubber-coated steel bullets and gas bombs at the Palestinians in and near the al-Qibli Mosque. The colonizers toured the courtyards of the holy site after the army, and the police assaulted and removed the Palestinians. (IMEMC 5 June 2022)
- Many Israeli military vehicles invaded Jenin city, Jenin refugee camp, and many surrounding towns, leading to protests. Several army jeeps invaded many neighborhoods in Jenin city, leading to protests before the soldiers fired live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers also invaded the Jenin refugee camp, Silat al-Harithiya and the al-Yamoun towns, west of Jenin, and fired many flares. Protests were also reported near the al-Jalama military roadblock, northeast of Jenin, while the army also

deployed dozens of soldiers around Silat al-Harithiya and al-Yamoun, before closing many roads to isolate entire communities. (MEMC 5 June 2022)
