Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

1 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers killed a Palestinian in the Al-Ezariyya town, southeast of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. The Palestinian has been identified as Fayez Khaled Damdoun, 18, and confirmed that the Israeli soldiers shot him with a live round in the neck. The Israeli soldiers fired live rounds at the slain Palestinian while driving his motorcycle near a local mosque in the town. The slain Palestinian “was driving a scooter during an exchange of fire” when the soldiers shot him and alleged that Palestinian protesters also hurled an explosive charge. (IMEMC 1 October 2022)
- Israeli navy ships fired a few shells and many live rounds toward Palestinian fishing boats in the northern part of the Gaza Strip. The fishing boats were sailing not far from the shores of the Al-Waha and As-Sudaniyya areas when the navy fired the shells, live rounds, and gas bombs. The fishing boats had to leave and return to the shore to avoid further Israeli escalation. The attacks were carried out almost simultaneously in the two areas of the coastal region. There have been no reports of injuries. (IMEMC 1 October 2022)
- Dozens of Israeli soldiers invaded the al-Jalazoun refugee camp north of the central West Bank city of Ramallah, shot one Palestinian during ensuing protests before searching several homes, and illegally confiscated cash. Many army jeeps invaded the refugee camp, leading to protests before the soldiers fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot one Palestinian with a rubber-coated steel bullet, where his condition was described as stable. The soldiers also stormed and ransacked many homes before illegally confiscating large sums of cash from the properties. Damage was reported due to the violent invasions and searches of the homes. (IMEMC 1 October 2022)
- Dozens of Palestinian and foreign activists suffered from their exposure to tear gas after the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) stormed Khamat al-Dabaa village in Masafer Yatta and quelled a weekly solidarity rally. The IOF intensively fired tear gas canisters and stun grenades at participants in a march held in solidarity with the Khamat al-Dabaa villagers, who are

- threatened with displacement. Dozens of Palestinian and foreign activists participated in the march, carrying Palestinian flags and chanting national slogans, before the IOF attacked them. Meanwhile, the IOF kidnaped a local resident called Sa'eid Awad during the same event as he was standing on his own land in the village. (PALINFO 1 October 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces blocked access of activists to al-Tuwani village in Masafer Yatta in the south of the West Bank as soldiers raid the village, shooting tear gas at homes causing suffocation cases. Israeli occupation soldiers fired tear gas indiscriminately in the village, causing many cases of suffocation from gas inhalation. The Israeli army shut down the main entrance to the village in the morning to prevent international activists from accessing the village to express solidarity with its residents who are facing Israeli eviction threats in favor of the colonial Israeli settlement enterprise. Israeli Settler Violence

- A group of Jewish settlers from the illegal outpost of Havat Ma'on set fire to olive trees belonging to Palestinian citizens from al-Tuwani village in Masafer Yatta. (PALINFO 1 October 2022)
- A group of colonizers gathered near the main entrance of Beit Furik town, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and hurled stones at Palestinian cars. The colonizers hurled stones at Palestinian cars near Beit Furik Israeli military roadblock, causing damage. The colonizers attacked the Palestinian's car when the Israeli soldiers reopened the roadblock after closing it in both directions for several days. After the attacks, Israeli soldiers closed the iron gate at the main entrance of Beit Furik town, roadblock once again, punishing the Palestinians, instead of the illegal colonizers who attacked them. - Armed Israeli settlers performed provocative march through the old city of Hebron, south of the occupied West Bank. Israeli settlers, armed with rifles and guarded by army, walked through the alleys of Hebron's old city while shouting racist slogans targeted at local Palestinian residents. (Wafa 1 October 2022)
