Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 12 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- A Palestinian child was killed by Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF) fire in al-Arroub refugee camp in Hebron, south of the West Bank. This is the fourth child killed by the IOF within one week in addition to the death of a fifth child after succumbing to previous wounds. Palestinian young men gathered in central al-'Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron, amid a strike announced in protest to the IOF siege on Shu'fat refugee camp in occupied East Jerusalem. The young Palestinians headed to al-'Arroub refugee camp's entrance, where IOF deploy along the road connecting with the Bypass Road (60), and threw stones at IOF military vehicles. Meanwhile, IOF heavily fired teargas canisters at the stone-throwers and nearby residential houses. As a result, many residents and stone-throwers suffocated, and clashes sporadically continued until 16:30, as the Israeli soldiers deployed at the camp's entrance and in the surrounding lands. The IOF fired live bullets at the protestors, wounding Osama Mahmoud 'Adawi (17) with a live bullet in the abdomen and later succumbed to his serious wounds. The live bullet penetrated his abdomen and caused gastrointestinal laceration and severe bleeding. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Dozens of Israeli colonizers invaded many Palestinian areas in occupied Jerusalem and hurled stones at the Palestinians, their homes, and their cars, leading to protests. The colonizers invaded several areas in Silwan town and closed streets, especially Ras Al-Amoud, and hurled stones at the Palestinians, their homes, and cars. The colonizers invaded the Be'er Ayyoub area in Silwan, smashed the windows of many Palestinian cars, and punctured their tires, in addition to attacking homes. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers shot six young Palestinian men during protests in Beit Ummar town, north of Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers shot two Palestinians, 17 and 24 years of age, with live fire and four with rubber-coated steel bullets. The attacks occurred when the soldiers invaded the town's center in the evening and started firing at dozens of Palestinians marching in solidarity with the Shu'fat

<u>refugee camp</u> in Jerusalem, subject to ongoing invasions and strict siege. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)

- Israeli soldiers shot a young man near Ramallah and abducted two near Salfit in the occupied West Bank. Dozens of Palestinians held a procession at the northern entrance of Al-Biereh city near Ramallah, protesting the Israeli military escalation in the West Bank, especially in the Shu'fat refugee camp in occupied Jerusalem. The soldiers attacked the protesters with a few live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldiers shot a young man with a live round in the leg; his condition was described as stable. Furthermore, the soldiers abducted Mohammad Rayyan and Qaisar Salah, from Qarawat Bani Hassan town, west of Salfit, while working at a construction site. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers shot one Palestinian with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the eye and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation at the main entrance of Bethlehem city, south of occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank. Many Palestinians protested the escalating Israeli violation across the West Bank, especially in Jerusalem's Shu'fat refugee camp, and marched toward the northern entrance of Bethlehem before Israeli soldiers attacked them with live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot a young man with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the eye. The soldiers also fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing dozens of Palestinians, including many schoolchildren, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. In addition, the army targeted Palestinian journalists to stop them from documenting the unfolding events. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- A Palestinian doctor sustained injuries and bruises after he was beaten by Israeli soldiers at the entrance of the village of Bayt Lid, east of the occupied West Bank city of Tulkarem. Atef Jom'a, 28, sustained injuries in most parts of his body after he was brutally assaulted by Israeli soldiers after they forced him to get out of his vehicle at a checkpoint set up at the entrance of the said village. Israeli settlers attacked a vehicle carrying a number of dialysis patients, near Huwwara military checkpoint, south of the occupied West Bank city of Nablus. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) opened fire at swaths of agricultural land in the east of Khan Yunis, south of the besieged Gaza Strip. Israeli

soldiers at military posts behind the border fence fired machine guns at swaths of cultivated land in the east of al-Fakhari town in Khan Yunis, which prevented Gazan farmers from entering the area to work their lands. No one was reportedly hurt in the shooting attack. (PALINFO 12 October 2022)

- Israeli occupation forces attacked Palestinians protesting the Israeli siege imposed on Shufat refugee camp and nearby Anata town, northeast of Jerusalem, for the fifth consecutive day. Clashes broke out in the town of al-Ram, north of Jerusalem, as Israeli forces attacked protesters with tear gas canisters, stun grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets. Similar clashes broke out near the northern entrance to al-Bireh city at the DCO checkpoint where one person was shot by a live bullet in the leg. (WAFA 12 October 2022)
- A Palestinian youth was struck in the eye with a rubber-coated steel bullet fired by Israeli military forces during clashes that erupted today at the northern entrance to Bethlehem. A 22-year-old youth was hit in the eye, after Israeli forces attacked Palestinians who clashed with soldiers at the northern entrance of Bethlehem in protest against the army's tight closure and measures against Shufat refugee camp and nearby towns. (WAFA 12 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces set fire into large areas of Qatanna village, northwest of occupied Jerusalem. Large areas of lands were set to fire as result of the gas bombs that were fired by the Israeli occupation soldiers stationed near "Har Adar" settlement. (WAFA 12 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- In Qusra village south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, dozens of colonizers burnt two chicken farms, attacked several nearby homes, and hurled stones at many buildings and cars. Approximately 30.000 chickens were burnt. Dozens of Palestinians intercepted the attack and protested it before the colonizers started firing live rounds, wounding many Palestinians. The colonizers also set several structures and buildings ablaze before the Palestinian firefighter and locals managed to extinguish the fire. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers assaulted and injured Mohammad Saleh Shehada and abducted his son, Abdullah, 18, in their home in Huwwara in Nablus Governorate. Protests were reported in several parts of Huwwara after

dozens of soldiers and paramilitary colonizers invaded it and fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The paramilitary colonizers also attacked and caused damage to several Palestinian cars driving in Huwwara. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)

- Dozens of Israeli colonizers invaded the Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank, before Israeli soldiers, who accompanied them, abducted two civilian guards of the holy site. Dozens of colonizers invaded the courtyards of the holy site through the Al-Magharba Gate, accompanied by soldiers and police officers. The colonizers invaded the holy site in groups headed by member of Knesset, Itamar Bin-Gvir. The Israeli army and the police attacked the Palestinian worshippers in the holy compound and forced dozens to leave so the colonizers could carry out their provocative tours. The soldiers also assaulted two civilian guards of Al-Aqsa, Khalil Tarhouni and Hamza Nibali, causing cuts and bruises, before abducting them. More than 1032 Israeli colonizers, accompanied by dozens of soldiers and police officers, invaded the courtyards of the holy site after Muslim worshipers were forced out. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Israeli colonizers attacked four Palestinian homes in Sinjil town, north of the central West Bank city of Ramallah, causing damage. The colonizers invaded the town and hurled stones at four Palestinian homes, causing damage to windows and anxiety attacks among the children. The colonizers came from the nearby illegal colonies of Givat Harel, Haroeh, Shilo, and Ma'ale Levona, built on stolen Palestinian lands in Sinjil and several surrounding villages and towns. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Dozens of colonizers gathered at the intersection of Hares village, west of the central West Bank city of Salfit, and marched in the area carrying Israeli flags and chanting slogans calling for expelling the Palestinians from their homes and lands. (IMEMC 12 October 2022)
- Israeli Knesset member Itamar Ben Gvir was among scores of Jewish settlers who desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. Dozens of settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police escort. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them performed Talmudic rituals and prayers. A group of settlers also performed provocative dances and prayers at some

- entrances leading to the Aqsa Mosque and at its western wall. (PALINFO 12 October 2022)
- A group of Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian vehicles passing near the
 vicinity of Beit El illegal settlement north of Ramallah. Under Israeli
 occupation forces' protection, the settlers stoned the Palestinian vehicles,
 smashing the windows of one of them. A similar settler attack was reported
 near Ein Ayoub area in Ramallah Area, where several vehicles were stoned
 and attacked. (PALINFO 12 October 2022)
- In Nablus, a Palestinian was injured after being hit in the head by a stone during a settler attack near the village of Al-Lubban Al-Sharqiya, south of the city. Several vehicles were also damaged during the attack at Nablus-Ramallah road. (PALINFO 12 October 2022)
- A group of settlers closed the road leading to the northern Jordan Valley and attacked Palestinian vehicles. The IOF soldiers were deployed in the area and did not intervene to stop the attack. (PALINFO 12 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers closed the main Huwwara street to the south of Nablus and attacked Palestinian commuters. A group of settlers gathered along the main street in the town, rampaging in the area and attacking Palestinian vehicles. A Palestinian man sustained bruises and cuts after being attacked by settlers in the town of Huwwara. Settlers also broke into a supermarket in the area and attacked the owner with pepper spray. (WAFA 12 October 2022)
- Israeli Settlers set fire to a barracks used for poultry as well as to a poultry transport truck belonging to a Palestinian resident in the town of Qasra to the south of Nablus. Settlers attacked the southern part of the said town and set fire to a barracks and a cargo truck owned by a local resident in the town of Qasra. Residents attempted to fend off the settlers' attack, leading to clashes. The Israeli settlers also set fire to electricity poles in the area. (WAFA 12 October 2022)
- Israeli Settlers attacked citizens' vehicles near the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya, on the road between Ramallah and Nablus. Settlers attacked citizens' vehicles with stones near the town of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya, in the area called Wadi Ali. A number of vehicles sustained damages. (WAFA 12 October 2022)
- Israeli Settlers burned two poultry farms, and a truck for loading chickens in the town of Qusra, south of Nablus. The settlers attacked the southern area of Qusra town and burned two poultry farms, one of which belonged to Adly Abu Rezeq, as well as a truck. The settlers also burned electricity poles on the road between Qusra and Jalud. (WAFA 12 October 2022)

 Israeli Settlers attacked four houses in Sinjil village, north of Ramallah, under the protection of the Israeli occupation forces, and smashed their windows, terrifying Palestinians, especially children and women. (WAFA 12 October 2022)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

The heavy firing of tear gas canisters by Israeli forces during clashes that
erupted in the town of Qatanna to the northwest of occupied Jerusalem,
caused fire to break out in vast areas of land. Clashes broke out between
Israeli soldiers and Palestinian residents in the town of Qatanna, during
which the former fired a barrage of tear gas canisters, which caused large
areas of nearby lands to catch fire. (WAFA 12 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

• The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) imposed a security siege on Nablus and closed all entrances leading to the city at dawn Wednesday. The IOF troops closed the main entrance to Deir Sharaf and the Hawara and Awarta checkpoints to the south of the city. Makeshift checkpoints were also erected at the entrances to Sebastia and Beit Furik towns. Meanwhile, a general strike was declared throughout the city since the early morning hours in response to the Arin al-Osoud (Lion's Den) armed group's call for mobilization. (PALINFO 12 October 2022)
