

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 13 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers abducted a Palestinian woman, a former political prisoner, in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers stopped Ayyam Nimir Rajabi, 29, from Hebron city, at the military roadblock near the Ibrahimi Mosque and abducted her before moving her to an interrogation facility. Ayyam is a former political prisoner who was first abducted by the army on February 6, 2013, released on February 21, 2013, and was abducted again on June 16, 2021, and released on October 3, 2021. The abducted woman sells perfumes in the streets and alleys of Hebron city to support herself financially. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured seventeen schoolchildren in the southern part of the occupied West Bank in Hebron. The soldiers surrounded the school and fired many gas bombs at it and surrounding areas. Seventeen children suffocated due to the severe effects of tear gas inhalation before receiving the needed treatment. The soldiers also abducted two children while walking near the school and took them to an interrogation facility. A day earlier, the soldiers stormed the school in the Abu Sneina neighborhood and forced the children to leave before forcing the education facility to close. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)
- Dozens of Israeli colonizers invaded Huwwara town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, attacked many Palestinians, and caused damage to 15 shops and twenty cars before Israeli soldiers attacked the Palestinians, wounding many, including a journalist. The soldiers shot a photojournalist, Majdi Eshteyya, with a gas bomb in the knee and caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation during protests that took place after many paramilitary colonizers invaded the town's center. The soldiers also fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades at several shops in the town, causing serious damage and several injuries. Furthermore, the illegal colonizers attacked many shops in the town's center, causing damage to fifteen shops, in addition to damaging twenty cars parked on the sides of the street. earlier, the soldiers stormed the school in the Abu Sneina neighborhood and forced the children to leave before forcing the education facility to close. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)

- Israeli soldiers injured dozens of Palestinians in several parts of the Hebron governorate in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers invaded several areas in Sa'ir town, northeast of Hebron, leading to protests before firing many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldiers shot a young man with a live round in the leg near the main entrance of Sa'ir and caused dozens, including many in their homes, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. Protests also took place near Beit Einoun junction, northwest of Hebron, before the soldiers shot at least three young men with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, cuts, and bruises. Furthermore, the soldiers installed many roadblocks on Hebron's northern and southern roads and closed Beit Einoun, blocking access to Hebron city and Sa'ir town. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers invaded Kafr Dan village, west of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, searched homes, and abducted one Palestinian, in addition to shooting two and causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation during ensuing protests. The soldiers invaded and ransacked several homes in the town, interrogated many Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards, and abducted Mohammad Ibrahim 'Aabed after causing serious damage to his property. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)
- For the fifth day in a row, the Israeli Occupation Forces (IOF) continue to ۲ impose a siege on Shu'fat refugee camp and 'Anata village in Occupied East Jerusalem, including the closure of entrances and military checkpoints, as part of collective punishment measures against tens of thousands of people. On 08 October 2022, IOF completely closed the entrances to Shu'fat refugee camp and 'Atana village in occupied East Jerusalem, as part of their collective punishment policy. The IOF arrested four Palestinians while crossing the checkpoint at the entrance to 'Atana village. IOF moved into the camp amid violent clashes with Palestinians. As a result, a Palestinian was shot with a rubber-coated bullet, and tens of others suffocated. Additionally, IOF arrested three Palestinians, including a woman. Next morning, 09 October 2022, IOF continued a complete closure of the entrances to the Shu'fat camp and 'Anata village, blocking movement in and out of them and turning them into a military outpost. Also, they spread into groups all over the camp's streets and alleys. Due to the measures imposed, the daily life in the camp and the village was disrupted as employees, workers and students were unable to go to their workplaces

and schools. In the evening, IOF raided and searched several mosques and dozens of shops and confiscated the recorders of the surveillance cameras. During their widescale raids, IOF arrested 15 Palestinians from Shu'fat camp and 'Anata village. Next day, 10 October 2022, IOF imposed-closure on Shu'fat and 'Anata village continued, as they conducted widescale raids of houses and shops, confiscated the recorders of surveillance cameras, and arrested 4 Palestinians from al-Tamimi family, including the parents of 'Odai al-Tamimi (22), whom the Israeli media accused of carrying out the shooting at the checkpoint. Also, IOF raided and took photos of all houses and shops belonging to al-Tamimi family. Moreover, two Palestinians were wounded during IOF's suppression of Palestinians protesting against the punitive measures imposed on Shu'fat camp and al-Salam Suburb in occupied East Jerusalem. On Tuesday, 11 October 2022, IOF continued their closure on the camp and village, disrupting all aspects of life and denying employees and students' access to their workplaces and schools for the third day. In the morning, IOF raided 'Odai al-Tamimi's house in al-Salam Suburb in 'Anata village and took its measurements as a prelude to demolish it. IOF's incursions into the neighborhoods and streets of the camp and 'Anata village recurred several times during the day, enticing anger among the residents of the area who gathered in the evening on the camp's streets and decided civil disobedience and a comprehensive strike all over the area, calling on all Jerusalem neighborhoods to go on a strike until IOF end their collective punishment policy against the residents of the area. Afterwards, hundreds participated in a mass protest that made its way to the camp's checkpoint chanting national slogans. When they reached the checkpoint, IOF suppressed the protest by firing rubber-coated metal bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades at the protesters. IOF summoned skunk carrying vehicles that broke into the camp's streets and alleys and pumped skunk water at the residential houses and shops. Up to publishing this press release, IOF continue to lock down and impose a closure on Shu'fat refugee camp and 'Anata village, where they conducted raids and arrests. Due to this closure, the fieldworker could not determine the final number of arrestees, but the initial reports say that at least 25 Palestinians were arrested within the past few days. The mayor of 'Anata, Taha No'man, stated that IOF have turned 'Anata, Ras Khamis, Shuafat refugee camp and Ras Shehada into a prison as the IOF's collective punishments target 130,000 people distributed over the mentioned areas, disrupting all aspects of life. As a result, 30,000 Palestinians could not go to

work, and more than 4000 students could not attend schools. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)

- A number of Palestinian schoolchildren suffered from their exposure to tear gas on Thursday morning after the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) attacked their school and its nearby area in the east of Juhor ad-Dik town in central Gaza. A number of child students from the Qaysaria School suffered from the effects of tear gas after the IOF showered the areas in the east of Juhor ad-Dik with tear gas canisters. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) continued to besiege Nablus for the second consecutive day as part of the Israeli collective punishment policy. The Israeli forces closed the Huwara and Beit Furik checkpoints, preventing the Palestinian movement in both directions. The IOF soldiers also closed entrances to Deir Sharaf and Surra villages. Earlier Wednesday, a general strike was declared throughout Nablus in response to the Arin al-Osoud (Lion's Den) armed group's call for mobilization in solidarity with its besieged compatriots in Shuafat refugee camp. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- Several Palestinians suffocated this evening after inhaling tear gas fired at them by Israeli forces during clashes that erupted in the town of Dura to the south of Hebron. Israeli forces raided several commercial shops in the town of Dura, leading to clashes. Forces attacked residents with tear gas canisters and stun grenades, causing several people to suffocate. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- A Palestinian in his 30s was shot and injured in the foot during clashes with Israeli forces which broke out near Aqbat Jabr camp to the south of Jericho, according to security sources. An army foot patrol fired live bullets toward Palestinian youths, shooting and injuring a 30-year-old man in the foot. He was taken to hospital for treatment. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- Dozens suffocated as Israeli forces quelled the funeral procession of a slain Palestinian in Beit Ummar town and al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron. Israeli forces cracked down on the funeral procession of 17-yearold Osama Mahmoud Hassan <u>Adawi</u>, who was shot in the abdomen with live ammunition and pronounced dead. The funeral procession set off from Al-Ahli Hospital in Hebron city and made its way to the refugee camp as thousands of participants were forced to take long alternative routes through Sa'ir town due to the lockdown imposed on the refugee camp. The gun-toting soldiers fired barrages of concussion grenades and tear gas canisters at the participants, causing dozens to suffocate. (WAFA 13 October 2022)

- Israeli soldiers stationed at the entrance of Beit Ummar intensively fired tear gas canisters towards civilian houses, resulting in dozens of suffocation cases. Osama is the sixth teenager (including five minors) killed by Israeli fire in the occupied West Bank in less than a week. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- Israeli military forces today attacked an elementary school in the northern part of Hebron city with tear gas canisters, causing dozens of Palestinian students and faculty members to suffocate and lose consciousness. Israeli forces deliberately targeted the schoolyard with tear gas canisters, causing at least 17 students to faint and dozens of others, including teachers, to suffocate. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces stormed the villages of Rummana and Al-Taybeh, west of Jenin. They raided shops in Rummana, checked the identities of citizens and interrogated them, which led to the outbreak of confrontations. The occupation forces also closed the Al-Jalama military checkpoint, northeast of Jenin. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers, who are stationed in a military watchtower at the entrance of Beit Ummar town north of Hebron, fired tear gas bombs at the Palestinian homes in the town. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- The Israeli Occupation Forces arrested six Palestinian boys, in addition to attacking Palestinian citizens in the Huwara town, south of the West Bank city of Nablus. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Groups of Israeli colonizers continued their invasions of Huwwara town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and fired many live rounds at Palestinian homes, in addition to burning cars and buildings. A large group of colonizers, accompanied by Israeli soldiers, invaded the town and attacked Palestinian shops and buildings. The colonizers fired many live rounds at Palestinian homes on the sides of the town's main road, damaged and burnt cars and buildings, including shops, leading to protests. Instead of removing the colonizers, Israeli soldiers started firing live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the Palestinians and their homes. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)
- Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian homes in the <u>Sheikh</u> <u>Jarah</u> neighborhood in occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank, wounding eighteen Palestinians before Israeli soldiers abducted seven. Twenty

Palestinians were injured due to Israeli soldiers and colonizers attacks. The attack was led by Itamar Ben-Gvir, a Member Of the Knesset and leader of the fanatic far-right Otzma Yehudit Party, who also pointed his weapon at the Palestinians and threatened to shoot them in front of police and soldiers. Instead of removing the assailing colonizers and the agent provocateur Ben Gvir, the soldiers attacked many Palestinians and abducted seven. (IMEMC 13 October 2022)

- Scores of Palestinians suffered breathing problems after the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) fired tear gas bombs in several areas north of the West Bank city of Hebron. IOF soldiers fired tear gas bombs and stun grenades at Palestinian citizens who participated in the funeral procession of the martyr Usama Adawi in al-Arroub refugee camp north of al-Khalil, causing breathing problems to dozens of citizens. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- Jewish settlers, protected by Israeli soldiers, torched three trucks and started a fire in a park in Huwara town and attacked the Civil Defense firefighting truck that arrived at the scene to extinguish the flames. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- Furthermore, settlers attacked Palestinian property, breaking the storefront windows of 15 stores and 20 vehicles at the main street of Huwara, in addition to attacking 6 houses in the town. Earlier today, Jewish settlers from the illegal settlement of Elon Moreh attacked Palestinian citizens in the village of Azmut east of Nablus while they were picking olives, according to Ghassan Douglas, who is in charge of settlements file in the northern part of the West Bank. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers torched a park and three trucks in Huwara town, south of Nablus city. The settlers, under the cover of the Israeli military, set fire to the Huwara Park as well as to privately-owned three trucks, with the flames consuming them entirely. The assailants, who came from Yitzhar, a nearby colonial settlement, attacked Palestinian storefronts and cars, including a Palestinian Civil Defense firefighting truck that arrived at the scene to extinguish the flames, smashing its windshields and spewing pepper spray in the faces of the firefighters. They also attacked six houses in the town, hurling stones at them and smashing their windows. Meanwhile, Israeli soldiers backing the settlers detained six Palestinians for confronting the assailants. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian olive pickers in the village of Azmut to the east of Nablus. Settlers from the illegal Israeli settlement of Elon Moreh

attacked Palestinians while they were harvesting olives in the village of Azmut. No injuries were reported. (WAFA 13 October 2022)

- A journalist was injured and others suffocated as Israeli settlers, backed by Israeli forces, attacked Palestinians passing through the main street in central Huwwara to the south of Nablus. Palestinians fended off the attack, leading to clashes with Israeli army soldiers who provided protection to settlers. Forces attacked Palestinians and commercial shops in the area with a barrage of tear gas canisters, causing several people to suffocate. A journalist was also injured in the attack after being struck in the knee with a tear gas canister. Forces also attacked shop owners and destroyed at least 15 stores and 20 vehicles that were parked along the main street. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
- Israeli Settlers, under the protection of the Israeli occupation forces, set up tents in Khirbet "Ain Fara'a", west of Hebron. Dozens of settlers set up tents on the ruins near the settlement of "Adora", and held "Talmudic prayers" there under the pretext of Jewish holidays. (WAFA 13 October 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Three agricultural structures and one car were destroyed when Jewish settlers launched arson attacks in Qusra village, south of Nablus City, under military protection. A a crew of its firefighters dealt with a number of blazes that were started by settlers in Qusra village. The civil defense added that the fires destroyed three poultry farms and killed 30,000 chickens, pointing out that the settlers burned a vehicle near the farms. It also said that its firefighters faced obstacles as they were heading for the area to tackle the fires. (PALINFO 13 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation authorities forced Ibrahim Hamed to demolish his house in Sur Baher, southeast of occupied Jerusalem. The area of the house is 170 square meters. It houses Hamed, his wife and their one and a half year old daughter. (WAFA 13 October 2022)
