



Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

14 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers killed a young Palestinian man north of Ramallah, in the central part of the occupied West Bank. The Palestinian is the third to be killed Friday, in addition to a detainee who died from his wound at an Israeli medical center. The Israeli army claimed that the young man, **Qais Emad Shojaya**, 23, from Deir Jarir village east of Ramallah, fired live rounds in the direction of Beit Eil colony, north of Ramallah, before he was shot. Qais was shot near the Al-Jalazoun refugee camp before the soldiers took his corpse away. The Israeli army initiated massive searches in the area. The army added that the two Palestinians reportedly approached the fence of Beit El before firing several rounds, mildly wounding a settler, 25, in the upper body while sitting outside his home. The wounded colonizer remained conscious and alert before he received treatment from a medic living in the colony and was later moved to an Israeli hospital. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers shot a young man and a child in Beit Ummar town, north of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded the town and attacked Palestinian protesters with live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldiers shot a young man with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the leg, and a child in the thigh before Palestinian medics rushed them to medical centers for treatment. Palestinian medics also provided the needed treatment to many Palestinians who suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. In related news, Israeli soldiers assaulted and injured a Palestinian child on his family's land, north of Beit Ummar, before the medics moved him to a clinic in the town. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers shot a young Palestinian man in Beit Duqqu town, northwest of Jerusalem, in the occupied West Bank. Many Palestinians protested in the town, condemning the serious Israeli escalation in various parts of the West Bank, especially in Jenin and Nablus, and the killing of three Palestinian, in addition to a detainee who died from his wounds. The soldiers attacked the protesters near the gate of the Annexation Wall at the main street between Beit Duqqu and Beit Ijza and fired many live rounds,

- rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs at them. Palestinian medics said the soldiers shot a young man in a rubber-coated steel bullet in the back, causing minor injuries. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers invaded Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem, leading to protests, and fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
 - Israeli soldiers injured 31 Palestinians during protests that took place after illegal Israeli colonizers invaded the town and destroyed property. The Palestinians tried to fend off an attack by the colonizers who damaged property, including stores and cars, in invasions that started a day earlier. The soldiers shot two young men with live rounds and caused 25 to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers also assaulted and injured three Palestinians, while another suffered burns due to gas bombs and concussion grenades. Furthermore, a Palestinian medic was injured after being rammed by an Israeli military jeep. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
 - Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians in the Bab az-Zawiya area, in the center of Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers attacked a procession against the Israeli escalation against the Palestinians by the army and the paramilitary colonizers across the occupied West Bank, especially in Nablus and Jenin. The soldiers invaded the area in large numbers and fired many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the protesters, surrounding stores, and homes. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
 - In occupied Jerusalem, the soldiers assaulted several young men in the Bab Al-Amoud area and abducted one, Ehab Kabaja. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
 - Israeli soldiers injured several Palestinians in Beit Dajan, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The Palestinians held the weekly procession in the town and chanted against the ongoing Israeli occupation, escalating violations, and illegal Israeli colonialist activities. The soldiers attacked the Palestinians with live fire, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldier shot a young man with a high-velocity gas bomb in the leg and another young man in the arm;

- several Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
- The soldiers killed two Palestinians, including a doctor, in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The doctor, Abdullah Al-Ahmad, 43, had died from serious wounds after an Israeli army sharpshooter shot him while trying to render first aid to wounded Palestinians. Dr. Abdullah was shot in the head in front of Jenin governmental hospital and was rushed to surgery but succumbed to his serious wounds. The slain doctor was a married father of three children. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
 - Israeli soldiers killed a young Palestinian man and injured at least six others, including two medics and one doctor who suffered serious wounds, while trying to provide essential treatment to a wounded young man, in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The invasion of Jenin and the Jenin refugee camp was carried out by more than fifty armored military vehicles before the soldiers stormed and ransacked many homes and abducted several Palestinians. The soldiers killed a young man, Mateen Dabaya, 25, from Jenin refugee camp, and deliberately targeted a doctor, Abdullah Abu At-Teen, while trying to provide treatment to a wounded Palestinian, seriously wounding him in the head. The doctor was on duty at Khalil Suleiman Hospital in Jenin city when he learned about injuries near the medical center and rushed to rescue the wounded before an army sharpshooter shot him in the head. The soldiers injured at least six Palestinians, including two medics, in Jenin and Jenin refugee camp, including two medics, especially after the army deliberately fired at many journalists and ambulances. (IMEMC 14 October 2022)
 - Israeli occupation forces (IOF) violently quelled Palestinian protest marches in various West Bank areas after the Friday prayer. Several Palestinian citizens were injured by the IOF live bullets in Huwara town, south of the West Bank city of Nablus. Three Palestinian citizens were injured, including one by the IOF live bullets, while they were confronting the settlers' attack in Huwara. Israeli soldiers attacked an ambulance, preventing it from reaching the town. (PALINFO 14 October 2022)
 - Scores of Palestinian citizens suffered breathing problems in Kafr Qaddoum village in Qalqilyia Governorate, while in Beit Dajan two Palestinian young men were hurt by tear gas bombs, one in the hand and

another in the foot. Moreover, IOF soldiers fired rubber-coated metal bullets, in addition to tear gas bombs and stun grenades at Palestinian protestors to quell a march in support of Al-Aqsa Mosque in the Bab al-Zawiya area in the center of the West Bank city of al-Khalil, causing breathing problems to several Palestinians. (PALINFO 14 October 2022)

- The Israeli occupation forces seized a bulldozer in Beit Dajan, east of Nablus, that was working to open roads on the eastern side of the town, to facilitate the citizens' access to their agricultural lands. (Wafa 14 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers last night attacked several vegetables and fruits stands in the northern Jordan Valley. The settlers vandalized stands, owned by a number of Palestinian farmers, used to sell vegetables and fruits on a road near the village of Bardala. The Jewish settlers also damaged the vegetables and fruits displayed on the stands. Several areas in the Jordan Valley have been subjected to ongoing Israeli settlers' violations against Palestinians and their properties. (MEMC 14 October 2022)
- A female nurse was injured after Israeli colonizers who invaded Huwwara town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, assaulted her, causing several injuries, including her face. The nurse, Hala Ahmad Halima, was attacked by many colonizers in Huwwara and suffered several injuries, including her face. The colonizers maced Hala and hurled stones at her while heading to her work at the Salfit governmental hospital. (MEMC 14 October 2022)
- Dozens of Israeli police forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. The Israeli forces broke into the Mosque and were deployed in large numbers in its courtyards. Meanwhile, hundreds of Jewish settlers carried out provocative tours and performed Talmud rituals at the Mosque's gates in flagrant provocation to Palestinian worshipers who starting flocking to perform the Friday prayer. (PALINFO 14 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers attacked the eastern side of Urif Town in Nablus, and attacked the town's school. The settlers also attacked a number of houses on the outskirts of Huwwara town, under the protection of the Israeli

occupation army. The settlers opened fire at the civilians, as a result, 3 Palestinians were wounded with live ammunition. (Wafa 14 October 2022)

- Israeli Settlers cut down a number of olive trees and stole their fruits in the lands of Qusra and Qaryut villages in Nablus Governorate. Settlers also stole fruits from the lands of Awarta town, Nablus governorate. (Wafa 14 October 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli authorities forced the Palestinian Ibrahim Hamed to self-demolish his house in Sur Baher, southeast of Occupied Jerusalem. Like many other Palestinian families in Jerusalem, Hamed opted to tear down his own 170-sq home, which houses his wife and their one-and-a-half-year-old daughter, rather than have the (Israeli) Jerusalem Municipality do it on their behalf in order to avoid the high cost of the demolition, which can go up to tens of thousands of shekels. (PALINFO 14 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

- Israeli troops have sealed off 130,000 Palestinians in five residential areas, imposing sweeping collective punishment including power cuts, spraying of foul-smelling 'skunk' water, and firing of tear gas in densely populated civilian areas; blockade violates Israeli law and Fourth Geneva Convention. Adalah – The Legal Center for Arab Minority Rights in Israel, in coordination with the Civic Coalition for Defending Palestinians' Rights in Jerusalem, sent an urgent letter yesterday, 13 October 2022, to senior Israeli security and legal officials demanding they act to immediately lift the blockade that Israel has imposed on five Palestinian residential areas in East Jerusalem. Israel's closure of the Shu'fat refugee camp, Dahiyat al-Salam, Ras Shahada, Ras Khamis and Anata residential areas imposes a sweeping collective punishment and violates the freedom of movement of some 130,000 Palestinian residents.
