

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 16 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats, homes, and farmlands, wounding a young woman in her home, in Rafah and Khan Younis, in the southern part of the besieged Gaza Strip. Israeli navy ships fired many live rounds and gas bombs at Palestinian fishing boats near the shores of Khan Younis, forcing them to leave.
- In Rafah, the soldiers fired a barrage of live rounds into farmlands and nearby homes, wounding one woman in her home. The wounded woman, Dalia Mohammad Abu Mousa, 22, was shot in the neck before Palestinian medics rushed her to a hospital; her wounds have been described as stable. (IMEMC 16 October 2022)
- Mujahed Ahmad Mohammad Daoud, 31, was pronounced dead as a result of critical wounds he sustained when the invading Israeli soldiers shot him with live fire in the chest near Salfit. The Palestinian was seriously injured Saturday afternoon when Israeli soldiers invaded the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan, northwest of Salfit in the central West Bank. Mujahed was one of <u>5 civilians who were injured</u> during protests that erupted in Qarawat Bani Hassan between Palestinian youths and the occupation forces on Saturday afternoon. Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli soldiers and colonizers detained seven young Palestinian men northwest of the central West Bank of Ramallah and repeatedly assaulted them. The soldiers and the colonizers stopped the seven young men near the illegal Halamish colony, built on stolen Palestinian lands northwest of Ramallah, and repeatedly assaulted them. The seven young men suffered various lacerations and bruises after the soldiers and the attacked them. (IMEMC 16 October 2022)
- Many Israeli colonizers hurled stones at Palestinian cars near Taybeh village, northeast of Ramallah, causing damage. In addition, Israeli soldiers installed a roadblock on the main street leading to Ein Siniya town, north of Ramallah, before the soldiers stopped and searched dozens of cars and

interrogated the Palestinians while inspecting their ID cards. (IMEMC 16 October 2022)

- Israeli colonizers invaded a Palestinian school in Orif village, south of Nablus in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, before causing serious damage and burning the administration room. The colonizers invaded the school and caused serious damage, especially to windows and doors. The colonizers also broke into the school's administration room and burnt it before fleeing the scene. During the invasion of Orif, the colonizers also caused serious damage to several shops and homes, in addition to throwing rocks at Palestinian cars driving on roads linking Nablus with surrounding areas. - Hundreds of Jewish settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem to mark the seventh day of the Sukkot holiday. At least 841 settlers entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under tight police guard, according to al-Qastal news website. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, dozens of Muslim worshipers spread in different areas of the Aqsa Mosque compound and chanted slogans protesting the presence of Jewish settlers in the Islamic holy site's courtyards. - The Israeli occupation authority and Zionist groups are working towards turning the Al-Qataneen Market into a roofed synagogue. Jewish settlers had set up tables and chairs and performed Talmudic rituals on the seventh day of the so-called "Jewish Throne Day". The settlers provocatively danced and chanted racist and obscene songs at the alleys of the market, which has been blocked since the beginning of the Jewish holiday last Monday. Palestinian merchants have been forced to shut down their shops in the Al-Qataneen Market for the seventh day in a row to facilitate the settlers' raids and rituals. (PALINFO 16 October 2022)
- Army-guarded Israeli settler attacked Palestinian farmers harvesting olives in their own lands near the village of Qaffin, southeast of the occupied northern West Bank city of Nablus. A group of army-guarded Israeli settlers attacked the Palestinian farmers while they were harvesting their olive crops and clashed with them. (WAFA 16 October 2022)
- A group of Israeli settlers last night vandalized and shattered solar cells for Palestinian owners in the village of Al-Farisiya in the northern Jordan

Valley region, northeast of the occupied West Bank. A group of Israeli settlers sneaked into the village and destroyed power-generating solar cells belonging to Mansour and Saleh Abu Amer, two local Palestinian residents.

- Israeli settlers attacked a school and set fire to a classroom in the village of Urif, to the south of Nablus. (WAFA 16 October 2022)
- Scores of Israeli settler fanatics guarded by police today broke into the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in occupied Jerusalem and performed rituals across its courtyards, according to witnesses. Nearly 250 Israeli settlers entered the compound through the Moroccan Gate in groups and performed rituals and Talmudic prayers there under the protection of Israeli police officers. This comes amid calls by far-right settler organizations on fans to break into the holy site in large numbers on the seventh and final day of the Jewish Sukkot holiday. (WAFA 16 October 2022)
- Israeli settler extremists last night attacked a school and set fire to a classroom in the village of Urif, to the south of Nablus in the occupied West Bank. A group of Israeli settlers from the nearby Israeli settlement of Yitzhar snaked into the village in middle of the night, attacked a school, shattered some of its windows, set a classroom on fire and vandalized some of the equipment at the school. This comes amid heightened Israeli military restrictions and shutdown of several roads in the province by the Israeli occupation army, coupled by a noticeable increase in attacks by extremist Israeli settlers on vulnerable Palestinian communities in the region. Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli occupation forces (IOF) demolished a caravan near Tell town, south of the West Bank city of Nablus. The IOF demolished the caravan belonging to the Palestinian citizen Khalil al-Faqih near Al-Marabaa road in the town of Tell and blocked the road leading to the town. A number of Jewish settlers chased Palestinian farmers at the entrance of Burqa town, northwest of Nablus, while they were picking olives. (PALINFO 16 October 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces (IOF) set up two military checkpoints at the entrances of Rummanah and Zabouba villages in the Jenin governorate, stopping Palestinians' vehicles and checking their ID cards, in addition to detaining and interrogating a number of youths. (PALINFO 16 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

• The Israeli occupation government has decided to completely close off the West Bank and the Gaza Strip on the final two days of the Sukkot holiday. The Israeli occupation army released a statement on Sunday saying that a closure will be imposed on Palestinians in those territories starting from today at 1:00 pm and ending at dawn Tuesday. Israel's official broadcaster, Kan, said that Israel's security and military forces were put on high alert across the West Bank and Jerusalem to deal with any Palestinian protests or operations during these two days. The Israeli government and its army had already imposed such closure on the West Bank and Gaza on the first day of the week-long Sukkot holiday. During the occasion's intermediate days, a partial closure was imposed on the occupied Palestinian territories, including besieged Gaza. (IMEMC 16 October 2022)
