

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 2 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians during protests that erupted after illegal Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian cars near the northern entrance of the Al-Biereh city, in the Ramallah and Al-Biereh governorate in the central West Bank. Many Israeli colonizers gathered near the northern entrance of Al-Biereh before hurling stones at Palestinian cars and a nearby home, causing damage. The colonizers tried to invade several Palestinian homes before the locals intercepted them and hurled stones at them. Israeli soldiers then started firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation and cuts and bruises. Also, the colonizers attacked several Palestinian homes in Beitin village, east of Ramallah. (IMEMC 2 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured several Palestinians, including two children, in Beit Ta'mir village, east of Bethlehem, in the occupied West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded the area surrounding the Tahadi 5 school in the Zawahra neighborhood in the village to confiscate a Palestinian truck. They added that the invasion led to protests before the soldiers randomly fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing many Palestinians, including children, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 2 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured at least thirty Palestinians at the main entrance of Beita village, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. More than ten armored military vehicles invaded the town and initiated massive searches of homes and buildings, leading to protests. During the invasion, the soldiers fired rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades and chased dozens of Palestinians. The soldiers shot two Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused 25 to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to three who were injured after falling when the soldiers chased them. - Israeli soldiers shot three young Palestinian men with live fire at the northern entrance of the Al-Biereh city in the Ramallah and Al-Biereh

governorate, in the central part of the occupied West Bank. Dozens of Palestinians held a procession to protest the escalating Israeli violations, including the Monday killing of two young men, <u>Bassel Qassem Basbous</u>, <u>19</u>, and Khaled Fadi Anbar, 21, from the Al-Jalazoun refugee camp, near Ramallah. The soldiers fired many live rounds at the Palestinians, shooting a young man, 19, with a live round in the thigh, and another, 18, with an expanding bullet to the leg, in addition to a third Palestinian who was shot in the abdomen after the bullet went through his arm. Three Palestinians were wounded and suffered moderate wounds. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 2 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli colonizers attacked a Palestinian ambulance near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, while transporting a patient to a hospital in Ramallah, in the central West Bank. The Palestinian ambulance from Jenin, in the northern part of the West Bank, was driving near the illegal Yitzhar colony, south of Nablus, when many colonizers attacked it. The colonizers attacked the Palestinian ambulance and tried to break into it in front of Israeli soldiers who failed to intervene. A medic team in the attacked ambulance, was transporting a patient to the hospital when the colonizers hurled stones at it and tried to break into it. The attack caused serious damage to the ambulance, including its windows, but did not lead to injuries. (IMEMC 2 October 2022)
- A group of Israeli colonizers gathered near the main entrance of Beit Furik town, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and hurled stones at Palestinian cars. The colonizers hurled stones at Palestinian cars near Beit Furik Israeli military roadblock, causing damage. The colonizers attacked the Palestinian's car when the Israeli soldiers reopened the roadblock after closing it in both directions for several days. After the attacks, Israeli soldiers closed the iron gate at the main entrance of Beit Furik town, roadblock once again, punishing the Palestinians, instead of the illegal colonizers who attacked them. - A group of Israeli colonizers bulldozed large areas of Palestinian agricultural lands in Burin town, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers brought many bulldozers and

started bulldozing and uprooting the Palestinian lands near the illegal Yitzhar colony. The lands are part of six villages and towns south of Nablus and are subject to escalating Israeli violations amidst the increasing construction and expansion of the illegal colonies. The lands have been surrounded and isolated, and their Palestinian owners have been denied access. (IMEMC 2 October 2022)

- Dozens of Israeli settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under tight police protection on Sunday morning and later in the afternoon. At least 155 settlers, including students of religious institutes, entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (PALINFO 2 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian vehicles and an ambulance today near the village of Huwwara, to the south of Nablus, causing damage to some of them. A group of Israeli settlers from the colonial Israeli settlement of Yitzhar rampaged at the main street near Huwwara and embarked on pelting stones at vehicles and passers-by, causing damage to some vehicles but no injuries. The settlers also attacked an ambulance with stones while it was moving a patient in an urgent condition to a nearby hospital. Earlier today, colonial Israeli settlers hurled stones today at Palestinians' vehicles near the entrance to the village of Beit Furik, nearby, causing damage to some of them but no injuries. Home Demolition & Demolition threats

• The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) demolished a Palestinian home in Hebron in the south of the West Bank. The IOF demolished a Palestinian house in Beit Ainun, near bypass road No. 60, east of Hebron. The demolished house's owner, Hisham Eida, affirmed his two-story house was destroyed. The first floor was inhabited by his son Montaser along with his wife and five children. The second floor has been under construction to be inhabited by his second son Moataz and his family. (PALINFO 2 October 2022) • The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) notified eight Palestinian-owned homes with demolition in Al-Dirat and Irfaiya villages in Masafer Yatta to the south of Hebron. The Israeli forces stormed Al-Dirat village and notified four local houses with demolition, including a house under construction. Four other houses were notified with demolition in the nearby Irfaiya village. (PALINFO 2 October 2022)

Expansion of Israeli settlements

• The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) bulldozed swaths of annexed Palestinian land in northern Salfit in the occupied West Bank to expand the cemetery of Ariel settlement. The Ariel municipality resumed the bulldozing of tracts of land between the separation wall and the illegal settlement in order to expand its cemetery. Despite the small numbers of buried settlers in the illegal settlements of the West Bank, the IOA continues to expand and build cemeteries for Jewish settlers. (PALINFO 2 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

- Israeli occupation forces shut down Huwwara and Beit Furik checkpoints, to the south and southeast of Nablus in the West Bank, blocking access of the Palestinian traffic and causing a traffic jam. The checkpoints were shut down in the early morning hours, forcing Palestinians to use longer alternative routes to reach their destinations. Both checkpoints are permeant Israeli barriers on the roads linking Nablus with the central and southern provinces of the West Bank, and their closure means more suffering for Palestinian drivers. - The Israeli soldiers invaded the Al-Mazra'a al-Gharbiyya town, north of Ramallah, and installed a roadblock at its main entrance before stopping and searching dozens of cars and residents. (IMEMC 2 October 2022)
