

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 21 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- On Friday evening, Israeli soldiers shot a Palestinian teenage boy with a live round in the 'Aida refugee camp north of Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank. Media sources said the soldiers attacked Palestinian protesters near the eastern entrance of the refugee camp and fired several live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The sources added that the soldiers shot a teenage boy, 17 years of age, with a live round in the thigh before he was moved to a hospital in Bethlehem. The soldiers also chased many Palestinians and closed the main street in the area, obscuring Palestinian traffic. On Friday night, Israeli soldiers invaded a morning house <u>Odai Kamal Tamimi</u>, 19, who was killed by Israeli on October 19, 2022, near Ma'ale Adumim illegal colony, east of the occupied capital Jerusalem in the West Bank. On Friday dawn, the Palestinian Health Ministry confirmed that Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian, <u>Salah Breke</u>, 19, and injured at least three others in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. - On Friday night, Israeli soldiers invaded a morning house of a young man • who was killed by Israeli on October 19, 2022, near Ma'ale Adumim illegal colony, east of the occupied capital Jerusalem in the West Bank. Media sources said the soldiers invaded the mourning house of Odai Kamal Tamimi, 22, set up by the extended Tamimi family in the Jabal Abu Romman area in the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The sources added that the soldiers removed flags, posters, and national symbols from the house and surrounding areas. The invasion led to protests before the soldiers fired many gas bombs and concussion grenades, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. It is worth mentioning that Odai was killed by Israeli soldiers near the Ma'ale Adumim illegal colony, east of the occupied capital Jerusalem in the West Bank, after he opened fire at security guards, mildly wounded one. The Israeli army said the Palestinian, from Shu'fat refugee camp, northeast of occupied East Jerusalem in the West Bank, shot a security guard, 24, mildly wounding him in his hand and added that another security guard at the scene fired at the Palestinian and killed him. On Friday dawn, the Palestinian Health Ministry confirmed that Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian, Salah Breke, 19, and injured at least

three others in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 21 October 2022)

- On Friday, Israeli soldiers shot and seriously injured a Palestinian child in Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Media sources said dozens of Palestinians held a procession near the permanent Israeli military roadblock at the northern entrance of Qalqilia. They added that the soldiers fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Medical sources said the soldiers shot a child, 15, with a live round in the abdomen before the medics rushed him to Darwish Nazzal hospital in Qalqilia, where he was admitted to surgery, and his wounds have been described as serious. - Israeli soldiers injured, Friday, a Palestinian child and an international solidarity activist during the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum, east of Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The Palestinian and peace activist marched from the center of the town, chanting against the ongoing illegal Israeli occupation, its colonies, and escalating violations. The soldiers attacked the procession with rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades and chased many. Medical sources said the soldiers shot a child, Mahmoud Riyad, 14, and an international peace activist with rubber-coated steel bullets to their chests. (IMEMC 21 October 2022)
- On Friday afternoon, Israeli soldiers attacked Palestinian protesters near the Huwwara military roadblock south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. Media sources said dozens of Palestinians marched near the roadblock, demanding the army to reopen it and end the siege on Nablus before the soldiers fired many live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Ahmad Jibril, the head of the Emergency Department of the Nablus office of the Palestinian Red Crescent Society (PRCS), said the medics provided treatment to six Palestinians who suffered the severe effects of tear gas inhalation. Also, the soldiers <u>shot one Palestinian with live fire, and two</u> with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation near the Beit Furik military roadblock, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. In related news, illegal Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian farmer while picking their olive trees, north of Huwwara, and tried to force them out of the Palestinian orchards. On

Friday dawn, the Palestinian Health Ministry confirmed that Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian, <u>Salah Breke</u>, 19, and injured at least three others in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 21 October 2022)

- On Friday, Israeli soldiers shot one Palestinian with live fire, and two with • rubber-coated steel bullets and caused many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation near the Beit Furik military roadblock, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers also chased and abducted a young man and took him to an unknown destination. Several Palestinians suffered cuts and bruises. Media sources said dozens of Palestinians marched in the area, demanding the army to reopen the roadblock and lift the siege on the area before the soldiers attacked them with live fire, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldiers also detained medics of the Palestinian Red Crescent Society (PRCS) and the Palestinian Medical Relief Society (PMRS) and confiscated some medical supplies from them before preventing them from crossing the roadblock. It is worth mentioning that hundreds of Palestinians gathered near the Huwwara military roadblock, south of Nablus, and Beit Furik roadblock, east of the city, in addition to Deir Sharaf junction that was blockaded with sand barriers installed by the army, and held noon prayers there, as part of many activities meant to break the Israeli siege, imposed on Nablus more than ten days ago. In Hebron, in the southern part of the West Bank, the soldiers abducted Samih Salim Qfeisha after invading his home and ransacking it. On Friday dawn, the Palestinian Health Ministry confirmed that Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian, Salah Breke, 19, and injured at least three others in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 21 October 2022)
- On Friday, Israeli soldiers attacked a Palestinian government minister and one of his aides while picking olive trees with dozens of farmers on a Palestinian orchard in Qaffin town, north of Tulkarem, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The WAFA News Agency said the Palestinian Minister, the head of the Wall and Colonization Resistance Commission, Moayyad Sha'ban, was with his aides and dozens of Palestinian farmers, picking olive orchards when the soldiers invaded the Palestinian lands and assaulted them. WAFA said the soldiers fired a barrage of gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians, causing Sha'ban to suffer the severe effects of tear gas inhalation. Also, the soldiers shot Sha'ban's aide,

Ali Sabarini, with a rubber-coated steel bullet fired at his thigh from close range. Palestinian medics rushed the Minister and his aide to Dr. Thabet Thabet governmental hospital in Tulkarem. Walid Sabah, the Mayor of Qaffin, said Israeli soldiers and illegal colonizers surrounded the Palestinians and tried to stop them from entering their orchards. "Just as we tried to reach the olive trees, the soldiers assaulted us, fired many gas bombs and rubber-coated steel bullets, wounding the minister and his aide," Sabah added. On Thursday, Palestinian Prime Minister Mohammad Shtayyeh denounced the dangerously escalating attacks by the illegal colonizers and soldiers and added that Sha'ban was recently subject to a vicious campaign by Israeli fanatics on social media, describing him as a "terrorist" and calling for "punishing him." - On Friday dawn, the Palestinian Health Ministry confirmed that Israeli • soldiers killed one Palestinian and injured at least three others in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Media sources said several armored Israeli military vehicles invaded the center of Jenin city before the soldiers stormed many buildings, ransacked them, and used their rooftops as sniper posts and monitoring towers. They added that many Palestinians protested the invasion and hurled stones at the military vehicles before the soldiers fired a barrage of live rounds, wounding four, including one who suffered life-threatening injuries. Medical sources said the seriously injured young man, Salah Breke, 19, succumbed to serious wounds he suffered after a soldier shot him with a live round in the neck. The soldiers also stormed and ransacked many homes, causing excessive damage, and abducted a young man, Bara' Kifah Alawna, 20. Furthermore, the army destroyed several motorcycles and the Martyrs' Monument during the invasion of the city's center. The young man's death brings the number of Palestinians killed by Israeli army fire since the beginning of this year, 2022, to 175, including 41 children; 51 Palestinians were killed in the besieged Gaza Strip. - Israeli police forces stormed the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem soon after the Friday prayer and removed banners glorifying a number of Palestinian martyrs including Uday al-Tamimi. Dozens of young men had organized a demonstration following the prayer in support of families of martyrs. Tamimi, 22, was killed a couple of days ago by Israeli security guards near the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim in eastern Jerusalem following an armed confrontation. (PALINFO 21 October 2022)

Israeli occupation forces (IOF) on Friday quelled the Palestinian demonstrations that condemned the closure imposed on Nablus for 11 days. IOF soldiers fired rubber-coated metal bullets and tear gas bombs at Palestinian protestors near the Huwara, Beit Furik, and Deir Sharaf checkpoints in the Nablus governorate, injuring several Palestinians and causing breathing problems to several others, according to local sources. The sources added that the IOF arrested the Palestinian young man Rebhi Malitat at the checkpoint of Beit Furik, east of the West Bank city of Nablus. Meanwhile in a press statement on Friday, the Arab Parliament stressed that the Nablus siege represents a flagrant violation of all international laws and norms, adding that the closure has led to a sharp deterioration in the economic conditions in the governorate, in addition to the daily suffering of its residents. Israeli Settler Violence

 On Friday, paramilitary Israeli colonizers attacked and injured several Palestinians in Burin town, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers invaded the town and attacked many Palestinians while trying to force them out of their lands. Ahmad Jibril, the head of the Emergency Department of the Nablus office of the Palestinian Red Crescent Society (PRCS), said the colonizers injured one Palestinian in the head and another in the eye before the medics rushed them to a hospital in Nablus. Jibril added that the medics also provided treatment to several Palestinians who suffered cuts and bruises. (IMEMC 21 October 2022)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

• On Friday, illegal Israeli colonizers bulldozed and destroyed a Palestinian agricultural road leading to farmlands in the Khirbat Al-Farisiyya village in the Northern Plains of the Jordan Valley in the occupied West Bank. Mo'taz Bisharat, a Palestinian official with the Tubas governorate who monitors Israel's illegal colonialist activities in the Jordan Valley, said the colonizers invaded the area and bulldozed the road. Bisharat added that the colonizers are trying to prevent the Palestinians from entering, planting, and rehabilitating their lands in preparation for illegally annexing them. Khirbat Al-Farisiyya is subject to repeated Israeli violations that escalated nearly two weeks ago, leading to the destruction of property and the

uprooting of Palestinian lands. A month ago, Israeli soldiers invaded the area, confiscated Palestinian tractors, agricultural tools, and equipment, and have been barring the Palestinians from bringing tractors or other agricultural machines into their lands. In Hebron, in the southern part of the West Bank, the colonizers attacked many Palestinian cars near the city's southern road, close to the illegal Hagai colony, and obstructed traffic on various streets leading to nearby towns.
