Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 4 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians in Rommana village, west of Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded the village, leading to protests before the soldiers fired a few live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, cuts, and bruises. Dozens of soldiers also invaded the areas around the villages of Zabbouba, Ta'nak, and Taybeh, near Jeni, and closed many roads. (IMEMC 4 October 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded Doura city, southwest of Hebron, stormed and searched two homes, and abducted Moath Odah. (IMEMC 4 October 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers opened fire at a Palestinian car and injured the driver before abducting him near Ramallah, in the central part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers fired many live rounds at the car while driving near Ofra colony, built on stolen Palestinian lands between Silwad and Ein Yabrud towns, northeast of Ramallah. The soldiers injured the driver, prevented Palestinian medics from approaching him, and took him to an unknown destination. The soldiers also installed many roadblocks between the towns of Beitin, Taybeh, Silwad, Ein Yabrud, and on the Ramallah-Nablus Road before stopping and searching dozens of Palestinian cars. - Israeli soldiers chased, assaulted, and detained a Palestinian child while returning home from school in Silwan town, in the occupied capital Jerusalem, in the West Bank. The child, Salah Natsha, 11, from the Ras Al-Amoud neighborhood in Silwan, was walking home when the soldiers chased him, and then they started beating him up before moving him to an interrogation facility. (IMEMC 4 October 2022)
- In Hebron several Palestinians suffered from teargas inhalation in Dura town after Israeli occupation forces (IOF) violently stormed the area amid heavy firing of teargas bombs. The IOF also tightened restrictions in the Old City in Hebron and closed gates and roads leading to the Ibrahimi Mosque. (PALINFO 4 October 2022)

- In Ramallah, clashes erupted at the Atara checkpoint amid intensified Israeli Forces firing of live ammunition and sound bombs. No injuries were reported. (PALINFO 4 October 2022)
- A Palestinian driver was arrested after the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) opened fire at his car near the Ofra settlement. The IOF prevented medical crews from reaching the injured man and took him to an unknown detention center. Several military checkpoints were also erected along Nablus-Ramallah road, where Palestinian vehicles were stopped and searched. (PALINFO 4 October 2022)
- Israeli forces shot and detained a Palestinian close to Silwad town, northeast of Ramallah city. The gun-toting soldiers stationed near the colonial settlement of Ofra, established on lands confiscated from Silwad and the nearby town of Ein Yabrud, opened fire at a vehicle, wounding the driver. The soldiers prevented medics from approaching the scene to treat the casualty, who was ultimately detained. (PALINFO 4 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers today chased off Palestinian shepherds in Khillet Makhoul community in the northern Jordan Valley, local sources confirmed. Aref Daraghmeh, an activist, told WAFA that the settlers chased the shepherds when solidarity activists were in the area to monitor the settlers' harassment of the Palestinians. Khillet Makhoul has been subject to daily attacks by Israeli settlers for two weeks now, whereas the area has also been targeted by settlers from a nearby illegal outpost. Such settlers' violations include raiding the area late at night, assaulting citizens, chasing off shepherds, and kicking them out of their grazing areas. This has raised concerns among Palestinian residents of the area that settlers may escalate their attacks, especially during the night. (WAFA 4 October 2022)
- Dozens of sraeli settlers blocked the main northern entrance to Ramallah, known as the DCO checkpoint, and obstructed the movement of Palestinian cars in and out of the city while soldiers were in the area. The settlers closed an iron gate at the checkpoint and threw big rocks on the road to block traffic in the presence of soldiers who did not intervene to stop them as the settlers threatened Palestinian drivers and attacked some with stones.
