Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

5 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers injured a Palestinian child in the Al-Biereh city, in the Ramallah and Al-Biereh governorate, in the central West Bank, and invaded several areas in Hebron in the southern part, leading to protests. A child, only 14 years of age, was shot with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the leg in Al-Biereh. The attack occurred after many Israeli army vehicles invaded the Jabal At-Tawil area in Al-Biereh, and closed streets, leading to protests. The soldiers fired live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs; several Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded the Bab az-Zawiya and Al-Manara areas in the southern West Bank city of Hebron, in addition to Sa'ir town and Beit Einoun village, northeast of Hebron, after closing their main streets, and attacked protesters with gas bombs. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian and injured four others, including two journalists, during an invasion into Deir Al-Hatab village, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers killed Ala' Nasser Ahmad Zaghal, 21, after shooting him with a live round in the head. The soldiers also shot with live ammunition four other Palestinians, including two journalists, and caused dozens to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The Israeli soldiers also shot Palestine TV journalists, Mahmoud Fawzi and Luay Samhan, with live fire in their arms. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers chased dozens of schoolchildren and fired gas bombs at an elementary school in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank, wounding many. Dozens of soldiers invaded an area around a school in Hebron, closed roads, and isolated them, denying the Palestinians from entering or leaving the area. The soldiers fired many gas bombs into the school near the Ibrahim Mosque and chased many children while heading home. Many children suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation, while others fell and suffered cuts and bruises while running away in fear of getting hurt. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)

- Israeli soldiers abducted Jerusalem governor Adnan Gheith after storming his home in Silwan town, in occupied Jerusalem, and ransacking it. Several Israeli army jeeps invaded the Al-Westra neighborhood in Silwan before the soldiers stormed Gheith's home and violently searched it. The soldiers abducted Gheith before moving him to an interrogation facility in the occupied city. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers fired many live rounds at Palestinian fishing boats and farmers in the central and the northern part of the besieged coastal region. Many Israeli navy ships attacked Palestinian fishing boats near the shore in northern Gaza and fired live rounds at them, forcing them to return to the shore. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers fired many live rounds and high-velocity gas bombs into Palestinian farmlands near the perimeter fence in the coastal region's central and northern parts. The soldiers fired live rounds and gas bombs into the Palestinian lands, east of Deir Al-Balah in central Gaza and east of Beit Lahia in northern Gaza. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation police detained six Muslim worshipers during their presence at the Aqsa Mosque in the holy city. Police officers kidnaped a Palestinian girl from the Aqsa Mosque's al-Asbat Gate and three other male citizens from its courtyards. Two Palestinian women were also taken prisoners by police officers as they were leaving the Aqsa Mosque. Since yesterday, Muslim worshipers have been exposed to different police restrictions preventing their entry to their Aqsa Mosque or their presence in its courtyards. Hundreds of Jewish desecrated the Aqsa Mosque yesterday and today under tight police guard to mark the Yom Kippur holiday. 461 of them defiled the holy site today during morning and afternoon tours. (PALINFO 5 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- A group of Jewish settlers destroyed a residential tent, a solar cell unit, and a water tank, in Khirbet al-Farisiya in the northern Jordan Valley. A group of settlers tore down a tent belonging to Raed Muhammad Fares Sobeih, and destroyed a solar cell unit, a water tank, and many of the tent's contents. (PALINFO 5 October 2022)

- Groups of Jewish settlers stormed al-Aqsa Mosque under heavy police protection, marking the so-called Yom Kippur. Hundreds of Israeli police forces deployed in large numbers throughout the al-Aqsa courtyards, broke into the al-Qibli prayer hall, and searched the Marwani prayer hall. Several settler groups stormed the Mosque from the Mughrabi Gate, organized provocative tours, received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount, and provocatively performed Talmudic prayers at the Bab Al-Rahma area. (IMEMC 5 October 2022)
- A shepherd was injured, as a result of an attack carried out by settlers on shepherds in Joret al-Khail area in the town of Sa'ir, northeast of Hebron. A number of heavily armed settlers from the Asfar settlement, which is built on Palestinian lands, attacked the shepherds and beat them, causing wounds to shepherd Ibrahim al-Shalalda in the mouth. Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) confiscated a bulldozer in Qarawat Bani Hassan town in western Salfit, provoking scuffles with Palestinian citizens. The IOF seized the bulldozer as it was working on reclaiming swaths of agricultural land belonging to Palestinian farmers at the pretext that the area is located in Area C of the West Bank, which is under Israeli military control. The IOF transferred the bulldozer to an unknown place and ordered the local residents to stay away from the area. (PALINFO 5 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) closed the military checkpoint at the main entrance of Atara village in northern Ramallah and prevented local residents from entering Birzeit City and other nearby areas. (PALINFO 5 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation authorities sold the equipment confiscated from a northern Jordan Valley Palestinian farmer by public auction. The Israeli authorities informed Suleiman Bani Odeh, a farmer from Ras al-Ahmar area, that they have sold two water tankers confiscated from him four months ago by the public auction. The military authorities impose exorbitant fines that owners of the confiscated property could not pay, paving the way for them to sell the confiscated property by public auction. (PALINFO 5 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

- Israeli forces sealed off the entrance of Birzeit town, north of the West Bank city of Ramallah, according to witnesses. The gun-toting soldiers set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the town, stopping commuters on their way out of the town and inspecting their identity cards. The soldiers blocked the entrance later on, denying Palestinians' free access into and out of the town on their way to Ramallah or the northern West Bank cities. The closure triggered confrontations, which saw the soldiers opening tear gas canisters towards the protestors. No injuries were reported though. (Wafa 5 October 2022)
