

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 6 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Hosam Salem, a Palestinian journalist in Gaza who put his life in danger many times over the past four years to report from the front lines for American and international audiences, was fired by the New York Times this week after the paper was subjected to a pressure campaign by a Zionist group calling itself "Honest Reporting". (IMEMC 6 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers searched many homes and abducted two Palestinian children near Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded Sa'ir town, northeast of Hebron, before the soldiers stormed and violently searched many homes. The soldiers abducted Ehab Issa Jaradat, 15, and Bassel Abdul-Mon'em Jaradat, 15, from their homes and took them to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 6 October 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers invaded Taffuh town, west of Hebron, before storming and ransacking the homes of three siblings, Shaher, Sa'ada, and Mahdi Sadeq Ezreiqat. The soldiers used military dogs during the search. (IMEMC 6 October 2022)
- A number of schoolchildren suffocated as Israeli forces attacked them in Tuqu' town, south of Bethlehem. Israeli soldiers the vicinity of Tuqu' Secondary Boys School in the southern West Bank town, and fired volleys of tear gas canisters towards the students, causing a number to suffocate. (IMEMC 6 October 2022)
- A number of Palestinian Citizens suffocated with tear gas, during clashes with the Israeli occupation forces, in the town of Sebastia, north of Nablus. Settlers stormed the archaeological area of the town, during which the Israeli forces fired tear gas bombs at Palestinians causing dozens of suffocation cases as a result of inhaling the tear gas. (WAFA 6 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces detained three students from Qalqas Elementary School in the southern area of Hebron city. The occupation forces detained three students from Qalqas Elementary School for Boys, aged between 12 and 14 years, on the school campus, and interrogated and

photographed them, under the pretext that they were throwing stones at the army. (WAFA 6 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Dozens of Israeli settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under tight police protection. The settlers entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (WAFA 2 October 2022)
- Israeli Settlers demolished a residential tent, a solar panel unit, a water tank, and many of the tent's contents in Khirbet al-Farisiya in the northern Jordan Valley, owned by Raed Muhammad Faris Sobei. (WAFA 6 October 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

• Israeli soldiers forcefully evicted a Palestinian family from their house in Khallet Tata, southwest of Hebron. the heavily-armed soldier cordoned off the family house of Mohammad al-Hroub in the area and fired volleys of tear gas canisters inside it. The soldiers afterwards dragged the family members out of the 100-square-meter house in preparation for planned demolition. (WAFA 6 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

- The Israeli soldiers closed Halhoul Bridge at Hebron's northern entrance and forced the residents to leave; the Palestinians had to take longer, unpaved roads to reach their destinations. (IMEMC 6 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces closed the archaeological site in Sebastia village, north of Nablus, and prevented citizens entering the area. The occupation forces stormed the archaeological site in the town with military reinforcements, and closed the area completely and prevented citizens from entering it. All this comes as a prelude to facilitate the entry of settler groups into the village. (WAFA 6 October 2022)
