



Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

18 November 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers shot a Palestinian child in the 'Aida refugee camp north of Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank. Many Palestinians marched near the eastern entrance of the refugee camp before the soldiers attacked them with live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot a child, 14, with a live round in the thigh before Palestinian medics rushed him to a hospital. The soldiers also caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation and obstructed traffic around the refugee camp. (IMEMC 18 November 2022)
- In Hebron, in the southern part of the West Bank, the soldiers invaded Palestinian farmlands and confiscated a tractor owned by Mahmoud Yousef Jabarin while plowing his land. The army claimed the Palestinians entered "a closed military zone," although he was on his land, plowing it and preparing to plant it. (IMEMC 18 November 2022)
- Israeli soldiers attacked the weekly procession on Sbeih Mountain in Beita, south of Nablus city causing many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers also fired many high-velocity gas bombs at PRCS ambulances while trying to provide the needed aid to wounded Palestinians. (IMEMC 18 November 2022)
- In Beit Dajan village east of Nablus city, the soldiers shot a child, 7, with a gas bomb in the abdomen and caused 25 to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers invaded the village, started firing gas bombs and concussion grenades randomly, and attacked the residents during the weekly procession against the illegal colonies on their lands. (IMEMC 18 November 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces (IOF) violently stormed Palestine Technical University – Kadoorie in the West Bank city of Tulkarem. The IOF soldiers broke into the Kadoorie campus and stole the CCTV footage of the area. The IOF soldiers intensified their presence in the area in a bid to search for resistance fighters who carried out a shooting attack at the military checkpoint of Kadoorie. (PALINFO 18 November 2022)

- A Palestinian young man was injured after Israeli soldiers fired live bullets at Palestinians in the al-Aroub refugee camp north of the West Bank city of Hebron. Furthermore, confrontations were reported between Palestinian youths and IOF soldiers in the Bab al-Zawiya area in the center of Hebron. (PALINFO 18 November 2022)
- A Palestinian child was shot and injured by Israeli occupation forces in Aida refugee camp, in the southern West Bank city of Bethlehem. A 14-year-old Palestinian was injured by a live Israeli shot in his thigh bone during confrontations between Palestinians and Israeli occupation forces in the camp. The child's condition was described as stable. (WAFSA 18 November 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces confiscated a Palestinian-owned tractor in Masafer Yatta region, to the south of Hebron in the southern West Bank. Israeli occupation soldiers confiscated a tractor belonging to Mahmoud Yousef Jabarin, a Palestinian farmer, while he was plowing his own land, under the pretext that the area is a close military zone. (WAFSA 18 November 2022)
- At least four Palestinians were injured by Israeli occupation forces during the weekly anti-colonization protest in the village of Kafr Qaddum, in the West Bank province of Qalqilia. Israeli occupation soldiers attacked the protesters with rubber-coated rounds and tear gas canisters, injuring four Palestinians by rubber-coated rounds and causing many cases of suffocation from gas inhalation. (WAFSA 18 November 2022)
- Israeli forces cracked down on anti-land-pillage rallies in Beita town and Beit Dajan village, south and east of the West Bank city of Nablus, injuring some 30 people. Israeli forces used fatal violence to disperse a rally in protest of the legalizing of the new colonial settlement of Givat Eviatar atop Jabal Sabih (Sabih Mountain), near Beita in addition to another rally to defend Palestinian-owned land threatened with confiscation, east of Beit Dajan. Five people suffered from excessive tear gas suffocation in Beita while noting that the soldiers directly targeted medics at the scene by volleys of tear gas canisters. 23 others suffocated from tear gas and a seven-year-old minor was hit by a tear gas canister in the abdomen in the course of confrontations in Beit Dajan. (WAFSA 18 November 2022)
- Israeli forces stormed the campus of the Palestine Technical University (Kadoori), west of Tulkarm city. A convoy of army vehicles barged their way into the university campus from the western direction, deploying at the main entrance, sparking confrontations. The soldiers opened volleys of gunfire and tear gas canisters at students who attempted to block their

entry. No casualties were reported. By the time the raid was over, the soldiers had confiscated the recordings of the surveillance cameras of the university. (Wafa 18 November 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Jewish settlers protected by Israeli soldiers proceeded to plant trees and install mobile houses after storming al-Khalayel area west of the West Bank city of Salfit. (PALINFO 18 November 2022)
- Israeli colonizers caused damage to several parked Palestinian cars while Israeli soldiers caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers attacked several parked Palestinian cars in the eastern part of Hebron city. The colonizers caused damage to several Palestinian cars parked on the street near his home not far from Kiryat Arba' colony in the eastern part of the city. A surveillance video documented the colonizers invading the area and attacking the Palestinian cars before fleeing. Also, Israeli soldiers caused many Palestinians, including those in their homes, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation after the army attacked protesters at the entrance of the Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron. (IMEMC 18 November 2022)
- Israeli colonizers, squatting on stolen Palestinian lands, attacked a Palestinian teenage boy in the Al-Mo'arrajat area near Jericho in the northeastern West Bank before Israeli soldiers arrived at the scene and abducted him. The colonizers attacked the child, Ali Mohammad Mleihat, 17, causing him to lose consciousness suffering various lacerations and bruises. Palestinian medics rushed to the scene, but the soldiers refused to allow him to approach the boy, before abducting him and taking him to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 18 November 2022)
- Israeli settler fanatics tonight attacked Palestinians' homes in the old city of Hebron, south of the occupied West Bank. No injuries were reported. Rampaging settlers hurled stones and empty bottles at homes of Palestinians at Jaber neighborhood in the old city of Hebron, forcing the local Palestinian residents to stay home to avoid being hurt. No injuries were reported. Groups of Israeli settler fanatics also pelted stones at Palestinian-owned vehicles in many areas of the city. (Wafa 18 November 2022)

- Israeli settlers assaulted and beat up a Palestinian boy near the village of Mu'arrajat, to the west of Jericho city in the east of the occupied West Bank, before he was arrested by the Israeli occupation forces. A group of Israeli settlers brutally assaulted Ali Mohammad Mlehat, 17, causing him bruises and a loss of consciousness. He said an Israeli army force arrived at the scene of the attack shortly after while and detained the boy, denying him access to hospital for medical treatment. (Wafa 18 November 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces fired teargas at Palestinians' homes in the city of Hebron, south of the occupied West Bank, as hundreds of illegal Israeli settlers stormed the archaeological Ibrahim Mosque in the old city. Hundreds of Israeli settlers broke into the holy site under the pretext of celebrating the Jewish holidays. The soldiers who were accompanying the settlers fired teargas at homes of Palestinians in the vicinity of the site. The Israeli occupation forces also shut down several roads in the area during the provocative incursion of the Israeli settlers into the holy site, denying movement of Palestinians into and out of the area. (Wafa 18 November 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Dozens of Palestinian families are threatened to be displaced from their homes in Silwan town south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem in favor of the Zionist organization Ateret Cohanim. "Five Palestinian families comprising 35 members are at risk of being expelled," the Israeli left-wing association Ir Amim underlined, adding that Ateret Cohanim claims that the Palestinian homes were established on lands owned by Jews before 1948. Ir Amim association condemned the racist Israeli policy that impedes Jerusalemite families from returning to their houses evicted in 1948 while it allows the forcible expulsion of the Palestinians from their homes in the Silwan and Sheikh Jarrah neighborhoods. The association stressed that the Ateret Cohanim which is leading the eviction of Palestinian families from Silwan was not established before 1948, adding that such an Israeli policy is aimed at Judaizing Palestinian neighborhoods after forcing Palestinian families to evict their houses around the Old City of Jerusalem. An Israeli court in Occupied Jerusalem rejected a petition submitted by the Palestinian family of Shehadeh against the Israeli decision that forces them to evict their homes in Batan al-Hawa in Eastern Jerusalem. 80 Jerusalemite families nearby the Shehadeh families are threatened with

- forcible expulsion. 17 families have been already displaced from their homes in Silwan. (PALINFO 18 November 2022)
- The Israeli occupation authorities (IOA) forced a Palestinian family to evacuate its house in Hebron as a prelude to demolish it. The evicted house was owned by the Palestinian municipality and inhabited by Al-Batsh family before turning it into a hotel. However, the Israeli forces stormed the building and forced the family out before throwing their belongings. (PALINFO 18 November 2022)
 - The Israeli army expelled a Palestinian family from their house in Hebron city in the southern occupied West Bank. The soldiers tore down the door of the house of Bader al-Batsh in the Old City of Hebron and forced him along with his entire family in the cold while searching and ransacking the property. The al-Batsh family had been living in the house, which belongs to Hebron Municipality and was recently transformed into a hotel, until their expulsion. (WAFA 18 November 2022)
 - The Israeli occupation army issued an order to demolish the under-construction three-classroom for Isfey al Fauqa school located in Area C, northeast of Masafer Yatta and informed the residents of the order. Before the school's existence, students were forced to travel to the nearby Khirbet Al Fakheit or to Khirbet Al Majaz communities, located at least 4 km away from Isfey. Such a journey is exacerbated by the harassment of violent settlers and the absence of roads forcing children to walk through dirt paths, which become inaccessible during the rainy season, the statement read.
