



## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

21 November 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian and injured at least five in Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Mahmoud Abdul-Jalil Sa'adi, 18, has died from serious wounds he suffered after the soldiers shot him in the abdomen and was instantly admitted to surgery but succumbed to his serious wounds. The soldiers shot five Palestinians; two of them were shot in the chest, one in the abdomen, and another Palestinian in the shoulder, in addition to one who was shot in the leg. Palestinian medics were attacked by the soldiers who tried to prevent them from reaching the invaded area. Mahmoud was a high school student at a local school in Jenin. During the invasion, the soldiers surrounded a home in the Al-Hadaf area and abducted a young man, Rateb Al-Bali, after exchanging fire with him and firing several Energa shells at the property. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)
- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) launched a pre-dawn raid campaign in Jenin, which led to the outbreak of violent clashes. Dozens of army vehicles stormed the Al-Hadaf neighborhood, while reconnaissance planes were detected flying over the area. The IOF troops surrounded a local house and arrested an ex-prisoner in Jenin refugee camp despite his injury. Israeli snipers were also seen deployed on the neighboring buildings' roofs. Two other youths were injured during the raid. In Nablus, the IOF troops stormed Duma town and demolished several Palestinian facilities. A two-story house and two agricultural facilities were destroyed during the raid. Meanwhile, two Palestinians were detained after IOF stormed their family house in Tulkarem. (PALINFO 21 November 2022)
- A Palestinian young man was shot and killed near the West Bank city of Jenin, as clashes erupted during an Israeli military raid into the city. A Palestinian died of critical wounds he sustained by Israeli gunfire in Jenin. Earlier on same day, the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) launched a pre-dawn raid campaign in Jenin, which led to the outbreak of violent clashes. Dozens of army vehicles stormed the Al-Hadaf neighborhood, while reconnaissance planes were detected flying over the area. The IOF troops surrounded a local house and arrested an ex-prisoner in Jenin refugee camp despite his injury. Two other youths were injured during the raid. (PALINFO 21 November 2022)

- The Israeli navy targeted fishermen offshore al-Waha and al-Sudaniya areas in the northern besieged Gaza Strip. Israeli navy intercepted and opened machine gunfire, tear gas and water hoses towards fishing boats sailing offshore the areas, forcing them for safety. (Wafa 21 November 2022)
- Dozens of Palestinians today suffocated as Israeli forces targeted a school complex in Tuqu' town, east of Bethlehem. The gun-toting soldiers deployed in the vicinity of the schools complex at the northern entrance of the southern West Bank town provoked confrontations with the students and residents and showered them with volleys of tear gas canisters, causing scores to suffocate from excessive tear gas inhalation. (Wafa 21 November 2022)
- Dozens of Palestinians today suffocated during confrontations with Israeli forces in the center of the occupied West Bank city of Hebron. Israeli forces stationed at al-Shuhada Street fired live and rubber-coated steel bullets, and sound and tear gas grenades at Palestinians causing dozens to suffocate from inhaling tear gas. The soldiers also forced shop owners in the area to shut down. (Wafa 21 November 2022)
- Israeli soldiers fired many gas bombs at a soccer field in Al-Khader town, south of the West Bank city of Bethlehem, causing many players, around the age of 15, and spectators to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers invaded the outer yard of the stadium, in the vicinity of the schools' area and fired many gas bombs into the soccer field and the stands, causing many players and spectators to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The Palestinians watched a soccer match between Al-Khader Youth Soccer Team and Bethlehem Islamic Club when the army attacked them. The attack is not the first, as the soldiers attacked various teams during training or soccer matches. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)
- Several Palestinian citizens were injured during a raid by the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) in al-Khader Playground south of the West Bank city of Bethlehem. "IOF soldiers broke into the al-Khader playground through its outward yard as a soccer tournament was underway,". The soldiers fired tear gas bombs at the stadium and the pitch, causing breathing problems to a number of players and audience. (PALINFO 21 November 2022)
- The Israeli occupation Forces arrested a Palestinian young man at a military checkpoint east of the West Bank city of Qalqilya. The Palestinian young man was identified as Ali Husein, 32, from Azzun village and vehicle was

- confiscated while he was passing through a checkpoint near the crossroads of Nabi Ilyas village east of Qalqilya. (PALINFO 21 November 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured several Palestinians who intercepted an attack by illegal Israeli colonizers in the Safa area in Beit Ummar, north of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The locals prevented a group of colonizers from attacking their homes. Israeli soldiers invaded the town and started firing gas bombs and concussion grenades at the Palestinians, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)

## Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian homes in the Tayba area east of Tarqoumia town, west of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers came from the Adora illegal colony, built on stolen Palestinian lands in the area. The colonizers attacked several homes and hurled stones at them before the Palestinians intercepted them, forcing them to leave. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)
- As the world marks Children's Day, three Palestinian children suffered injuries on Sunday evening when Jewish settlers and Israeli forces assaulted them in Hebron and Bethlehem in the occupied West Bank. Groups of settlers severely beat a child identified as Yazan al-Rajbi in an area near the settlement of Kiryat Arba. The kid suffered severe injuries in his head and was rushed to Alia Hospital in Hebron. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)
- Hordes of Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem in the morning and later in the afternoon. At least 94 settlers entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under tight police protection. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. The Israeli police close al-Maghariba Gate, which is used by Jews to enter the Mosque, at 10:30 am after the settlers complete their morning tours at the holy site. Later in the afternoon, the same gate is reopened for evening tours by settlers. During the presence of settlers inside the Mosque compound, entry restrictions are imposed on

- Muslim worshipers at the entrances leading to the Mosque and their IDs could be seized until they leave the holy place. (PALINFO 21 November 2022)
- A group of Jewish settlers set fire to olive trees, wrote racist slogans on the walls of Palestinian houses, and damaged the tires of a number of vehicles in Ramin village, east of Tulkarm. Citizens were surprised by the racist slogans written in Hebrew on the walls of their homes on the outskirts of the northern town. Several vehicles were also damaged during the attack, while a number of olive trees were burned. Meanwhile, several Palestinian citizens were injured during a raid by the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) in al-Khader Playground south of the West Bank city of Bethlehem. (PALINFO 21 November 2022)
  - Israeli settlers vandalized several vehicles and torched olive trees in Ramin village, east of Tulkarm. Some villagers said that they were shocked to find out that a group of settlers had sneaked their way into the northern outskirts of the village, and punctured the tires of at least four vehicles and set fire to olive trees in the area. The vandals also spray-painted hate graffiti in Hebrew on the external wall of two houses. (Wafa 21 November 2022)
  - Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian homes east of Tarqoumia in the south of the West Bank, according to a local activist. Settlers from Adora settlement threw stones at the homes of Palestinians east of Tarqoumia causing panic among the residents. The Israeli occupation forces last week demolished two tin structures in the same area, while the settlers carry out almost daily attacks against residents, their properties, and trees, which are only a few meters away from the settlement of Adora, in an effort to push them out of their lands. (Wafa 21 November 2022)

## Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli soldiers invaded Nabi Elias village, east of Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and demolished an agricultural structure. Several army vehicles invaded the village and surrounded an area before demolishing the structure. The demolished agricultural structure is owned by a local farmer, Abdullah Abu Saleh, and said the army claimed it was built without a permit. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)
- Israeli soldiers invaded Douma town, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, before demolishing a home and two structural structures. The soldiers invaded the southeastern area of Douma and demolished a home.

Daghlas added that the home, owned by Mohammad Hasan Saray'a, was an inhabited two-story building. The soldiers also demolished an agricultural shed owned by Suleiman Dawabsha and a room owned by Qassem Mleihat. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)

- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) forced a Palestinian citizen to demolish a section of his house in the east Jerusalem neighborhood of Silwan, south of the Aqsa Mosque. The owner, Salah Abu Farha, said that he had to demolish around 45 square meters of his home in Silwan after receiving a demolition notice from the Israeli municipality. Abu Farah added that the municipality ordered him to raze that part of his house at his own expense if he wanted to avoid paying it exorbitant money if its demolition crew carried out the measure. He affirmed that the municipality had prevented him from expanding the house and rejected an application he submitted to obtain a construction permit. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)

## Others

- Israel is keeping a cancer-stricken Palestinian man in administrative detention despite his urgent need for medical attention. Abdul Baset Mu'tan, 48, from the town of Burqa, east of Ramallah, has colon cancer, and his health is constantly deteriorating. Mu'tan was slammed with six months in administrative detention in July, only three months after his release from a previous six-month administrative detention sentence. Following an appeal for his release to allow him to get treatment for cancer, a military court reduced his sentence to four months. However, the six-month order was reinstated following an appeal by the military prosecutor. (IMEMC 21 November 2022)
