



## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

28 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers shot a young man with live fire and caused many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation at the main entrance of the Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers attacked Palestinian protesters with live fire, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot one Palestinian with live fire in his leg, causing a moderate but stable injury. The soldiers also caused many Palestinians, including those in their homes, to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers shot a young Palestinian man and caused many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation in Beit Dajan, east of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Dozens of Palestinians marched in Beit and Beit Dajan, protesting the escalating Israeli violations and the illegal colonialist activities before the soldiers attacked them with live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Medical sources said the soldiers shot one Palestinian with a rubber-coated steel bullet in Beit Dajan and caused many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers attacked the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, wounding a child and causing many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. Many Israeli army jeeps invaded Kufur Qaddoum and attacked the protesters with rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. Many youngsters protested the invasion, burnt car tires, and hurled stones at the soldiers who fired a few live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot a child, 14, with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the back and caused dozens of Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers attacked the procession immediately after the Palestinians and international peace activists marched from the area of the local Omar Bin Al-Khattab Mosque. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers killed one Palestinian and injured two others, one seriously, near the Huwwara military roadblock south of Nablus, in the northern part

of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers fired many live rounds at the car of Emad Abu Rashid, 47, shooting him with several bullets in the abdomen and the head. The soldiers also seriously injured two Palestinians after shooting one in the abdomen and one in the chest. Palestinian medics rushed to the area, but the soldiers refused to allow them to provide any treatment to Emad or the other seriously wounded Palestinians. The medics were later allowed to take Emad to Rafidia Hospital in Nablus, where the doctors tried to save his life, but he succumbed to his wounds. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)

- Clashes were reported between Palestinian youths and Israeli occupation forces (IOF) in several areas of the West Bank following the start of the weekly anti-settlement marches. IOF soldiers fired rubber-coated metal bullets and tear gas bombs at Palestinian protestors to quell the anti-settlement marches in Beit Dajan village in Nablus and Kafr Qaddoum village in Qalqilya, leaving several Palestinian citizens injured and causing breathing problems to several others. A Palestinian citizen was wounded in the back by the IOF rubber-coated metal bullets in Beit Dajan. A 14-year-old Palestinian was injured in the back by an IOF rubber-coated metal bullet, while several others suffered breathing problems in Kafr Qaddoum east of the West Bank city of Qalqilya.
- Clashes erupted in the Qaryut village, south of Nablus, following a Jewish settlers' raid into the water spring of the village. In another development, a Palestinian citizen was lightly injured in the foot after a group of Jewish settlers attacked Palestinians and foreign activists while they were picking olives in Jiba village to the northwest of the West Bank city of Ramallah. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- The Israeli Occupation soldiers arrested two Palestinian young men, Hamouda al-Housh and Usama al-Rajbi, at the "160" military checkpoint near the Ibrahimi Mosque in the Old City of Hebron. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers blocked the roundabout of Salman al-Farisi in Huwara town in the Nablus governorate as part of the ongoing siege on Nablus for the 18th day in a row. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- A Palestinian youth was shot and injured and dozens of others suffocated as Israeli forces suppressed the peaceful anti-settlement rally in Beit Dajan to the east of Nablus. Forces attacked protesters with rubber-coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters, shooting and injuring a youth. Dozens of others suffocated due to tear gas inhalation. (Wafa 28 October 2022)

- Israeli forces prevented a Palestinian youth from entering his home village of Tel Rumeida in central Hebron, in the southern occupied West Bank. The youth, who was identified as 27-year-old Hazem al-Shirbati, said Israeli forces manning al-Shuhada street military checkpoint held him for hours at the checkpoint and informed him that he is not allowed to enter the area or to return to his home in the said village. (Wafa 28 October 2022)
- A Fourteen-year-old Palestinian was shot and injured by rubber-coated steel bullets and dozens of others suffocated as Israeli forces quelled the weekly anti-settlement rally in Kafr Qaddoum village to the east of the West Bank district of Qalqilia. Israeli forces attacked the rally with tear gas canisters and rubber-coated steel bullets, leading to violent clashes. A teenager was reportedly shot in the back by rubber-coated metal bullets, while dozens suffocated after inhaling the toxic gas. (Wafa 28 October 2022)

## Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli colonizers attacked many Palestinians near Salfit, in the central West Bank, wounding two Palestinians, and hurled stones at Palestinian cars near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied territory. Dozens of colonizers invaded Kafr Ed-Deek town, west of Salfit, and attacked many Palestinians, their homes, and other property. The colonizers injured two Palestinians, who suffered mild wounds.
- Israeli colonizers gathered at an intersection near Huwwara town and hurled stones at Palestinian cars. The colonizers also use the street to drive to and from their colonies, adding that they were attacking and throwing stones only at cars that carry Palestinian license plates. (IMEMC 28 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers attacked Palestinian olive pickers in the village of Jibiya to the northwest of Ramallah. A group of settlers from Halamish settlement attacked Palestinians and foreign activists who came to lend a helping hand, while they were harvesting the olive crops in their privately-owned lands in the village of Jibiya, causing light injuries to one of the olive pickers. Settlers further attacked activists and journalists' vehicles, causing material damage to a number of cars. (Wafa 28 October 2022)

## Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- A Palestinian family from Jabal Al-Mokabber and At-Tour towns in occupied Jerusalem in the West Bank were forced to demolish its home after the Israeli occupation authorities denied their appeals. Members of the Ja'abis family in Jabal Al-Mokabber had to demolish their home after Israel denied their appeals and refused to grant them permits. The demolition rendered seven family members, including five children, homeless. Family members said they had to demolish the property to avoid paying even more excessive fines and fees, in addition to excessive fees imposed on them if the city used its workers and equipment to demolish the property.
- A Palestinian family from the At-Tour town had to demolish the home it built two years earlier after the city denied their appeals and issued a final demolition order. Members of the local Imam family said they had to demolish the two-story home they had built using reinforced sheets of steel and tin. It is worth mentioning that the soldiers also invaded At-Tour and abducted a Palestinian teenage boy before moving him to a detention facility in the city. (MEMC 28 October 2022)
- A Palestinian resident of East Jerusalem was forced to demolish part of his privately-owned house after he received a demolition order from the Israeli municipality of West Jerusalem. The resident was forced to tear down part of his 130-square-meter house, a home for eight people, in the al-Tur neighborhood to avoid paying exorbitant fees if the Israeli municipality crews demolish it.
