

Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 29 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli navy ships attacked Palestinian fishing boats near the shores of the northern parts of the besieged Gaza Strip. The navy fired many live rounds and gas bombs at Palestinian fishing boats in northern Gaza in the Al-Waha and the as-Sudaniyya areas. The attack led to damage and forced the fishermen to leave and return to shore to avoid further Israeli escalation. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers attacked and injured a young Palestinian man in Silwan town, south of the Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied Jerusalem, in the West Bank, and abducted him. The soldiers stopped the young man in the Al-Ein area in Silwan before repeatedly striking him, causing several injuries. The soldiers cuffed the young man and abducted him before moving him to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces physically assaulted and arrested two Palestinian sisters today in occupied Jerusalem. Hanadi and Shahd Hammuda were physically assaulted and arrested by the Israeli police as they were trying to enter the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city. Of note, the Israeli occupation forces control all the entrances to the holy site and who can pray there, despite allowing Jewish fanatics into the mosque on a daily basis in violation of the status quo there. Israeli Settler Violence

 Israeli colonizers fired live rounds at Palestinian homes and attacked several homes and cars in the Wad Al-Hasseen area, while Israeli soldiers shot a medic and a young man in the Wadi Al-Ghrous area, east of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers, from the Kiryat Arba colony, built on stolen Palestinian lands in the eastern part of Hebron, fired many rounds at several Palestinian homes, causing damage. The assault did not lead to physical injuries but caused several Palestinian children to suffer severe anxiety attacks. The attack occurred despite constant Israeli military deployment in the area and while a military helicopter was hovering overhead. Furthermore, Israeli soldiers fired many live rounds at a Palestinian Red Crescent ambulance in the Wadi Al-Ghrous area in Hebron, wounding one medic and causing damage. Medical sources said the medic, Ahmad Abu Khaled, was shot with a live round in the shoulder and rushed to the Al-Ahli Hospital in Hebron. The soldiers also shot a young man before abducting him; the extent of his injuries remains unknown at this report's time. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)

- Israeli colonizers attacked many Palestinian cars on streets near Huwwara, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and near Bethlehem, south of the occupied capital, Jerusalem. Many colonizers gathered near Salman Al-Farisi Junction and hurled stones at many Palestinian cars, causing damage. The colonizers also gathered on the Huwwara-Qalqilia road and hurled stones at Palestinian cars, causing damage. In Bethlehem, many colonizers gathered near the Al-Minya village, southeast of the city, and closed the Wadi Sa'ir Road before hurling stones at Palestinian cars, causing damage. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)
- Israeli colonizers assaulted a Palestinian man near Ramallah in the central West Bank, causing several wounds, and attacked cars, causing damage. Media sources said the colonizers assaulted Falah Issam Kahla from Rammun village east of Ramallah, causing several injuries. The colonizers surrounded the man and repeatedly struck and kicked him before fleeing the area. Palestinian medics were called to the scene of the attack and moved the wounded man to a hospital in Ramallah. The colonizers also gathered at a junction leading to the Al-Mo'arrajat area, east of Ramallah, hurled stones at Palestinian cars, causing damage. Furthermore, the colonizers attacked and caused damage to several Palestinian cars at the junction between Ras Karka and Deir Ammar village, west of Ramallah, and near Deir Nitham and Nabi Saleh villages, northwest of the city. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)
- Israeli colonizers attacked many Palestinian cars on streets near Huwwara, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and near Bethlehem, south of the occupied capital, Jerusalem. Many colonizers gathered near Salman Al-Farisi Junction and hurled stones at many Palestinian cars, causing damage. The colonizers also gathered on the Huwwara-Qalqilia road and hurled stones at Palestinian cars, causing damage. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)

- In Bethlehem, many colonizers gathered near the Al-Minya village, southeast of the city, and closed the Wadi Sa'ir Road before hurling stones at Palestinian cars, causing damage. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers continued their daily attacks against Palestinian civilians, mainly farmers harvesting their olive crops, with an attack on farmers picking their olives in the Tel Romeida neighborhood in the southern West Bank city of Hebron. The settlers from the settlement of Beit Hadasa, located in the heart of occupied Hebron, attacked, under Israeli army protection, Palestinian olive harvesters and volunteers helping them and stealing their harvest. Settlers have been attacking Palestinians harvesting their olive crops in several areas located near the settlements in the occupied West Bank and either prevent them from continuing in the harvest or steal their crops. None of the attackers have ever been arrested or persecuted for their actions while soldiers provide them with protection and attack the Palestinians who attempt to defend themselves or push the settlers back. (IMEMC 29 October 2022)
- The Israeli occupation army attacked Palestinian fishermen and their boats off the northern coast of the beleaguered Gaza Strip. Israeli gunboats opened machinegun fire at fishing boats during their presence within a few nautical miles off the shore of Beit Lahia town in northern Gaza. No one was reportedly hurt in the attack, which forced the fishermen to return ashore. Israeli naval forces and their gunboats are around Gaza fishermen almost every day, harassing them, shooting at them, damaging their boats, and making arrests. Sometimes fishermen are injured or killed during gunfire attacks. (PALINFO 29 October 2022)
- A number of Palestinian citizens were injured during Jewish settlers' attacks in several areas of the occupied West Bank. Local sources reported that a number of Palestinians suffered breathing problems after being attacked by pepper spray used by Jewish settlers against them in Al-Sahlah neighborhood near the Al-Ibrahimi Mosque in the center of the Old City of al-Khalil. Meanwhile, Palestinians organized a protest near the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) checkpoints at the entrance of Al-Shuhada street and Tal al-Rumeida neighborhood in Hebron, to condemn the ongoing IOF and Jewish settlers' attacks. (PALINFO 29 October 2022)
- Jewish settlers stole the olive harvest of Palestinian citizens after storming Palestinian lands in Deir Sharaf village west of the West Bank city of Nablus. Fire broke out in the Palestinian lands that were attacked by the

Jewish settlers, adding that the IOF prevented the civil defense crew from reaching the scene.

- Jewish settlers formed a few months ago an armed militia under the name of "civil guards" to carry out nighttime operations against the Palestinians in the occupied West Bank. These settler operations are aimed, in particular, at helping the Israeli occupation army to confront Palestinians on the road that passes through Huwara town in the south of Nablus. "These civil guards, which are fully supported by the Israeli army and operate under the nose of its forces, are an armed militia whose nucleus was launched from the settlement of Yitzhar in southern Nablus. - Israeli settlers continued their daily attacks against Palestinian civilians, ۰ mainly farmers harvesting their olive crops, with an attack on farmers picking their olives in Tel Rumeida neighborhood in the southern West Bank occupied city of Hebron. Settlers from the settlement of Beit Hadasa, located in the heart of occupied Hebron, attacked, under Israeli army protection, Palestinian olive harvesters and volunteers helping them and stealing their harvest. Settlers also stole olive harvest in the village of Deir Sharaf, west of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The settlers sneaked into the fields close to the illegal settlement of Shavi Shomron and stole the olive harvest, adding that fire broke out in this land and the Israeli soldiers prevented the village residents from reaching the land to put off the fire. Settlers have been attacking Palestinians harvesting their olive crops in several areas located near the settlements in the occupied West Bank and either prevent them from continuing in the harvest or steal their crops. None of the attackers have ever been arrested or persecuted for their actions while soldiers provide them with protection and attack the Palestinians who attempt to defend themselves or push the settlers back. (WAFA 29 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers stormed the Atouf and al-Ras al-Ahmar communities in the northern Jordan Valley and searched animal barns, according to Mutaz Bisharat, a local official. Bisharat did not give any more details except saying that on daily basis settlers break into Palestinian communities in the Jordan Valley and harass or attack residents. (WAFA 29 October 2022)
- Israeli settlers tonight attacked Palestinians' vehicles in several locations in the occupied West Bank districts of Bethlehem and Nablus. (WAFA 29 October 2022)
- In Bethlehem, south of the West Bank, settlers attacked vehicles outside the village of Al Maniya, to the southeast of Bethlehem, Palestinian security

sources said. A group of Israeli settlers gathered at the main road outside the village and embarked on pelting stones at Palestinian vehicles passing at the street, causing damage to some of them. No injuries were reported. (WAFA 29 October 2022)

• Israeli settlers gathered at the main road in the village of Huwwara, south of Nablus, and pelted Palestinian vehicles with stones, causing damage to some of them. (WAFA 29 October 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) forced a Palestinian family to demolish part of its home in Salahuddin street in east Jerusalem at the pretext of unlicensed construction. The homeowner, Azzam Abu Assab, said that the Israeli municipality already gave him 10 days to demolish a section of his home in order to avoid paying more fines. Another Jerusalemite citizen was also forced to demolish his 50-square-meter home in the east Jerusalem neighborhood of Shuafat under the same pretext. Ahmad Abu Issa said that his nephew, Abdul-Hadi, was forced to demolish his new home after the Israeli municipality threatened to make him pay more penalties. He added his nephew was planning to live in this house after getting married. (PALINFO 29 October 2022)
- Palestinian residents of occupied East Jerusalem were forced by the Israeli municipality of West Jerusalem to tear down their homes under the pretext they were built without a permit. Abdul Hadi, was forced by the municipality to demolish his 50-square-meter home in Shufat neighborhood of occupied East Jerusalem under the pretext it was built without a permit after he was fined more than \$20,000. He completed the small house where he planned to live after getting married but that his dream of a house has now vanished. (WAFA 29 October 2022)
- In the occupied city of Jerusalem, Azzam Abu Assab, had to tear down part of the house where his family of 10 people lives on Salah Eddin Street, the main business street in East Jerusalem, after the Israeli municipality issued him a demolition order and gave him only 10 days to tear it down or have to pay fines exceeding \$10,000. Abu Assab added to his house in order to accommodate his growing family but the municipality refused to give him a permit to expand it, forcing him to build without it. yesterday, another East Jerusalem resident tore down parts of his house in al-Tur neighborhood of the occupied city for similar reasons.
