



Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

30 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- In Beit Ummar, the Israeli soldiers attacked many Palestinians holding a procession condemning the escalating Israeli violations and ongoing colonialist occupation and fired many rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at them. The soldiers caused many Palestinians to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation and a few injured by shrapnel from concussion grenades. It is worth mentioning that the army continued closing the town's main entrance, preventing the Palestinians from entering or leaving Beit Ummar. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
- The Israeli soldiers attacked protesters at the main entrance of the Al-Arroub refugee camp, north of Hebron, shot three with rubber-coated steel bullets, and caused many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
- In Hebron city, the Israeli soldiers shot two Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets in the Bab az-Zawiya area in the center of the city. One of the wounded was shot in the ear and one in the leg; dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. Furthermore, many Palestinians protested in Hebron city's southern area before the soldiers fired live rounds and rubber-coated steel bullets. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
- In Bethlehem, the Israeli soldiers shot a Palestinian child with a live round in the leg during protests near the city's northern entrance. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
- A crew from the Israeli municipality and police forces raided on Sunday morning a number of Palestinian homes in Silwan district in Occupied Jerusalem. According to local sources, a municipal crew and police officers broke into and searched several homes in Wadi Hilweh neighborhood in Silwan and handed their owners summonses for questioning from the municipality in the holy city. The Israeli municipality summons Jerusalemite citizens to question them about their homes and structures before issuing demolition orders or imposing heavy penalties on them. Every once in a while, Israeli municipal employees and police forces storm

neighborhoods in Silwan and hand several Jerusalemite citizens demolition orders against homes and structures. The Jerusalemites have no choice but to build without licenses because there are no structural maps that respond to the natural increase in their numbers. The Israeli occupation authority (IOA) always justifies the demolition of Palestinian homes in the holy city by claiming they lack building permits despite the fact that it does not provide such permits for Palestinian citizens. The IOA also orders the Jerusalemites to raze their own homes and property or pay demolition fees to the municipality if they refuse to carry out demolition orders at their own expense. Israel's Judaization activities started in Silwan district and its nearby areas in 1996 when the Jewish neighborhood of Ma'ale Hazeitim emerged as a small settlement on the Mount of Olives in east Jerusalem. - A Palestinian child was injured during a raid by Israeli occupation forces (IOF) at the northern entrance of the West Bank city of Bethlehem. A Palestinian child was injured in the foot by IOF live bullets during clashes that erupted between Palestinian youths and Israeli soldiers at the northern entrance of Bethlehem. (PALINFO 30 October 2022)
- The Israeli Soldiers stormed the Rummanah village to the west of the West Bank city of Jenin and set up two makeshift checkpoints at the entrance and in the center of the village, stopping the Palestinians' vehicles and asking for ID cards. (PALINFO 30 October 2022)
- Israeli police arrested the Palestinian young man Nour Abu al-Hummus after storming his house in Al-Isawiyah town east of Occupied Jerusalem. (PALINFO 30 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Jewish settlers from the illegal settlement of Yitzhar hurled stones at Palestinian houses and vehicles near Burin village west of Jenin(PALINFO 30 October 2022)
- In Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank, Israeli colonizers from Kiryat Arba' colony attacked many Palestinian cars, smashing their windshields, doors, and windows, especially in the Ar-Ras

- area and Wad Al-Hassin. The colonizers also hurled stones at Palestinian cars on many roads in Farsh Al-Hawa, west of Hebron, Beit Einoun junction north of Hebron, and near Bani Na'im town, east of the city. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
- In Ramallah, in the central West Bank, the Israeli colonizers attacked a Palestinian bus and many cars near Taybeh village, east of the city, causing damage. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
 - In Nablus, in the northern West Bank, the colonizers attacked many Palestinian cars and several homes near Burin town, southwest of the city, causing damage. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
 - The Israeli colonizers attacked many cars near the Beit Furik military roadblock east of Nablus, causing damage to several cars and wounding at least three Palestinians, including one who was also physically attacked in front of Israeli soldiers. Furthermore, Israeli soldiers fired many gas bombs at Palestinians who intercepted an attack by the illegal colonizers on their homes in the Al-Lubban Ash-Sharqiya village south of Nablus. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 30 October 2022)
 - Israeli settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under tight police protection. At least 149 settlers entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshippers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (PALINFO 30 October 2022)
 - Israeli police officers savagely assaulted a Palestinian young man from Shuafat refugee camp at a military checkpoint before kidnaping him. Eyewitnesses said that police forces showered passersby at the Shuafat checkpoint with stun grenades and tear gas canisters as they tried to save 22-year-old Amir Mohamed after his exposure to a severe beating at the hand of soldiers. (PALINFO 30 October 2022)
 - Israeli settler vandalized and shattered the glasses and windshields of parked Palestinian-owned vehicles in the city of Hebron, south of the occupied West Bank. Scores of vehicles were damaged by Israeli settlers

from the illegal settlement of Kiryat Arba who broke into in the southern neighbourhoods of the city. Israeli settlers also hurled stones at Palestinian vehicles at intersections and bypass roads across the Hebron province, causing damage to some of them. (Wafa 30 October 2022)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) mapped the house of martyr Mohamed al-Jabari, in Hebron city. A large number of Israeli soldiers stormed Beit Einun town in northern Hebron, raided the house of Jabari before military engineers embarked on taking its measurements as a prelude to demolishing it later. The IOF also kidnaped martyr Jabari's brother, Kamal, from Beit Einun and two other citizens from the Old City of Hebron and Bani Naim town. (PALINFO 30 October 2022)

Israeli Closures

- Israeli occupation forces shut down all the entrances to the Bethlehem province in the south of the occupied West Bank. Israeli occupation forces abruptly shut down several roads leading in and out of the province, denying entry and exit of the Palestinian traffic and commuters. (Wafa 30 October 2022)
- Israeli occupation forces shut down all the entrances to the city of Hebron and the neighboring towns and villages in the south of the occupied West Bank. The occupation forces also raided and searched several homes in the city and the nearby town of Bani Na'im, and at least two Palestinians were arrested during the raids. The developments come after a Palestinian man, Mohammad Kamal Jabari, in his 30s, was shot dead outside the Israeli settlement of Kiryat Arba. A paramedic was also injured by Israeli gunfire shortly after the incident. Israeli occupation soldiers opened gunfire at an ambulance of its in the area, injuring paramedic Ahmad Abu Khaled by a live shot in his shoulder. (Wafa 30 October 2022)
