Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

7 November 2022

In the daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- A gang of Israeli settlers attacked a Palestinian children's playground, scattering the children who were playing there, and destroying their play equipment. The attack took place in Susiya village, southwest of Hebron in the southern occupied West Bank. The children ran from the armed men, and villagers, mainly mothers of the children, came to the site to stand up to the armed invasion. The armed colonizers also brought a German Shepherd dog with them, which they used to try to attack the children. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2022)
- The israeli occupation army (IOA) opened fire at Palestinians protesting the army invasion of al-Biereh city, north of occupied Jerusalem in the central West Bank, injuring two teenagers, one of them seriously. The (IOA) stormed al-Biereh city, which prompted local Palestinian youths to resist, soldiers in turn opened fire with rubber-coated steel rounds and tear gas canisters, striking two children, both aged 16, with rubber-coated steel rounds. One of the injured teens, who was struck in the head with a steel bullet, was rushed to Palestine Medical Center in Ramallah for emergency surgery. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2022)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) shot and injured another child in Beit Ummar town, northwest of Hebron in the southern occupied West Bank. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2022)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured a 12-year-old Palestinian boy with gunfire in the town of Beit Ummar, north of Hebron in the south of the occupied West Bank. The child was hit with a rubber-coated steel round in the head by the (IOA) while he was spending time with his family in a farm of theirs near the town. The child was rushed to Alia Hospital in nearby Hebron city for medical treatment, where his condition was described as stable. (WAFA 7 November 2022)
- Two Palestinian teenagers sustained injuries by the (IOA) gunfire last night, one of them seriously, during clashes with the Israeli occupation army forces who raided the city of Al-Bireh, in the center of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) fired rubber-coated rounds and teargas canisters

during the clashes in the city, injuring two Palestinian teens, aged 16 both. One of the two teens was hit with a bullet in the head, and his condition was described as serious. The teen is undergoing a surgery for his injury at Palestine Medical Center in Ramallah. (WAFA 7 November 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinian homes in Burin village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, causing damage, and wounding three Palestinians. Ghassan Daghlas, a Palestinian official who monitors Israel's illegal colonialist activities in the northern West Bank, the settlers attacked many homes in the eastern part of the village. The colonizers also assaulted Adel Eid, Khalid Bashir, and his brother Ahmad when they tried to defend their homes. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2022)
- Illegal Israeli settlers attacked many Palestinians while harvesting their olive trees in their orchards in Teqoua Palestinian village, east of Bethlehem, in the central occupied West Bank. The settlers came from the illegal Tekoa colony which was built on stolen Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2022)
- Three Palestinian citizens were injured when a horde of extremist Jewish settlers attacked homes in Burin town, south of Nablus in the occupied West Bank. The settlers escorted by soldiers hurled rocks at homes in the eastern area of Burin and assaulted local residents. Three young men were injured as they and others tried to fend off the settlers and defend themselves, adding that Israeli soldiers fired a volley of tear gas and stun grenades at the young men to protect the settlers and secure their withdrawal from the area. The wounded young men were identified as Adel Eid, Khaled Basheer, and Ahmed Basheer. (PALINFO 7 November 2022)
- A Palestinian citizen, his wife and another woman were injured when a horde of extremist Jewish settlers assaulted locals in the Bedouin community of Tha'ala, east of Yatta town in al-Khalil province. Several settlers stormed the community and brutally attacked the local residents. (PALINFO 7 November 2022)

Confiscation & Razing of lands

• Israeli settlers, illegally squatting on Palestinian lands, cut more than 45 Palestinian olive trees and destroyed a well, near Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The settlers invaded Palestinian olive orchards near the Yitzhar colony and cut more than 45 trees. The attack is not the first as the settlers frequently invade Palestinian farmlands and orchards, before cutting and uprooting trees, in addition to attacking the Palestinians and their homes. In related news, a group of settlers, also from Yitzhar, destroyed a Palestinian water well, used by the farmers in the Be'er an-Nabe' as-Sofly area Madama village, south of Nablus. The well was an essential source of water to the farmers, especially since Israel keeps cutting water supplies to ensure a constant flow of water to the illegal settlements. (IMEMC 7 NOVEMBER 2022)
