Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 3 January 2023

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Dozens of Palestinian citizens suffered breathing problems during a raid by the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) northwest of the West Bank city of Jenin. The IOF soldiers fired tear gas bombs at Palestinian citizens after storming the Rummanah village, adding that clashes were reported between Palestinian youths and IOF soldiers. - The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) confiscated tents in Masafer Yatta, south of the West Bank city of Hebron. The tents were set up for the schoolchildren of the nearby Bedouin communities whose school was demolished by the IOF last November. (PALINFO 3 January 2023)
- A Palestinian teenager was killed when the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) stormed al-Deheisha refugee camp in southern Bethlehem and clashed with local youths. 16-year-old Adam Ayyad was pronounced dead at the Beit Jala Hospital after he succumbed to a serious bullet injury in his chest, which he sustained during clashes with Israeli forces in al-Deheisha camp. Ayyad was critically injured when a large number of Israeli troops stormed the camp in the morning and embarked on raiding homes and randomly firing live and rubber bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades at local youths. Another teenager also suffered a bullet injury in one of his hands during the events. The IOF also kidnaped a young man identified as Anan Sarabata after ransacking his home in the camp. (PALINFO 3 January 2023)
- Israeli soldiers invaded Abu Dis town, east of the occupied capital Jerusalem, in the West Bank, leading to protests, and fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at random, causing a fire in one home. The soldiers fired many gas bombs, striking the home of Fadi Mohammad Awwad, burning the property and causing his seven family members to suffocate and suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The invasion came from several directions and the soldiers randomly fired many live rounds, gas bombs, concussion grenades, and rubber-coated steel bullets. Some of the homes were hit by the army fire, including one that caught fire after high-velocity gas bombs broke through a window and entered the property. (IMEMC 3 January 2023)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli forces demolished five Palestinian inhabited houses in Yatta town, south of the city of Hebron. Israeli forces escorted two bulldozers to Ma'in community, where the heavy machineries tore down a 170-square-meter inhabited house belonging to Hamad Mohammad, purportedly for being built without a license. (WAFA 3 January 2023)
- The Israeli soldiers demolished four other houses in Shi'b al Butum, one of the hamlets making up Masafer Yatta. The gun-toting soldiers used a bulldozer to raze four houses, each of which occupying an area of 80 square meters, belonging to four members of the Jabarin family, reducing them to rubble, citing the same flimsy pretext. This was the fourth time for these houses to be demolished within two years as a means to force displace the indigenous Palestinian communities and take over their land for colonial settlement expansion. Israeli Closures

• The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) closed the Ibrahimi Mosque in the Old City of al-Khalil to Muslim worshipers. The IOF closed the Mosque and kidnaped a Palestinian young woman after assaulting her in the Old City. (PALINFO 2 January 2023)
