



## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

10 February 2023

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians during the weekly procession in Kufur Qaddoum, east of Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Dozens of Palestinians marched in Kufur Qaddoum before the soldiers attacked them with rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldiers shot two Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused many others to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
- Several Israeli army vehicles invaded the northern West Bank city of Jenin, stormed and ransacked homes leading to protests before shooting a young man and abducting another. Many army jeeps invaded the Eastern and the Al-Almaniyya Neighborhoods in Jenin, leading to protests before the soldiers fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. They added that the soldiers shot a young man with a live round in the thigh. The soldiers also stormed and ransacked many homes, causing damage, and abducted a young man Waqqas Saba'na. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
- A young Palestinian man was injured after an Israeli military jeep rammed his motorcycle near the Al-Jalama military roadblock northeast of Jenin in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The army jeeps chased the Palestinian motorcycle and rammed into it, causing it to crash and wounding the driver. It remained unclear why the military jeeps chased the driver, especially since the soldiers did not attempt to abduct him after they caused his motorcycle to crash. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
- Israeli navy ships attacked Palestinian fishing boats, abducted two fishermen, and confiscated fishing gear in the northern part of the besieged Gaza Strip. The navy ships fired live rounds and gas bombs at Palestinian fishing boats in the Al-Waha and As-Sudaniyya areas and near Beit Lahia, in the northern part of the Gaza Strip. The attack led to property damage but did not result in injuries among the Palestinian fishermen. Furthermore, the navy abducted two fishermen in a separate attack in northern Gaza and confiscated their fishing gear before moving them to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)

- Israeli soldiers killed a young Palestinian man near the entrance of the Al-Fawwar refugee camp, south of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The Israeli army claimed that the young man attempted to stab a soldier before other soldiers at a nearby roadblock opened fire and killed the Palestinian. The young man was identified as Sharif Hasan Rabba', 22, from the Ath-Thaheriyya town, south of Hebron, and the soldiers fatally shot him after they stopped his car in the Al-Dalba area near the main entrance of the refugee camp. Sharif was heavily bleeding before the soldiers cut his clothes off and checked for a pulse, but refused to allow Palestinian medics to approach him before the army took him away. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
- Israeli occupation forces (IOF) arrested two Palestinian young men on Friday after storming their houses in the Nablus Governorate, which triggered clashes. The two Palestinian young men Issam Mansour and Samih Dweikat were arrested after the IOF stormed their homes in Kafr Qallil town in the Nablus Governorate. (PALINFO 10 February 2023)
- The Israeli Occupation soldiers set up a military checkpoint at the roundabout of Deir Sharaf northwest of Nablus, stopping the Palestinian citizens' vehicles and searching them. (PALINFO 10 February 2023)
- The Israeli occupation soldiers fired rubber-coated metal bullets and tear gas bombs at Palestinian protestors to quell the anti-settlement marches in Beita and Beit Dajan villages in Nablus and in Kafr Qaddoum village in Qalqilya, causing breathing problems to several Palestinian citizens. The Palestinian Red Crescent Society reported that 35 Palestinian citizens suffered breathing problems while another suffered burns on the hand after he was hit by a tear gas bomb. (PALINFO 10 February 2023)
- Clashes erupted between Israeli occupation soldiers and Palestinian youths after the Israeli occupation soldiers fired tear gas bombs and rubber-coated metal bullets at Palestinian citizens at the entrance of Beit Ummar town in the West Bank city of Hebron. (PALINFO 10 February 2023)
- The Palestinian citizen Sufian Al-Ju'ba, 38, was injured in the Qalqas area south of Hebron after a Jewish settler ran over him and fled the scene. (PALINFO 10 February 2023)
- Israeli forces shot a Palestinian and detained four others from the occupied West Bank, according to local and security sources. Israeli forces showed up at a house in Beit Rima town, northwest of the city of Ramallah, broke inside, conducted a thorough search and eventually detained a young man. In the northern West Bank, a sizable army force barged its way into the

- northern West Bank city of Jenin to provide cover to an undercover force that sneaked its way into the city earlier, with snipers seizing positions on the rooftops of houses. During the ensuing confrontations, the snipers shot a youth by a live round in the thigh. The soldiers forcibly entered a house in the city and rounded up another. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
- In Nablus district, the gun-toting Israeli soldiers surrounded two houses in Kafr Qallil village, south of the city, conducted a thorough search and detained two others. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
  - A Palestinian sustained a fracture in a settler car-ramming attack in Qalqas area, south of the occupied West Bank city of Hebron. An Israeli settler intentionally rammed his car into Sufyan Mohammad al-Ju'beh, 38, and fled the scene. The casualty suffered from a hand fracture. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
  - At least two Palestinians were injured by Israeli occupation forces during the weekly anti-colonization protest in the village of Kafr Qaddum, in the West Bank province of Qalqilia. Israeli occupation soldiers attacked the protesters with rubber-coated rounds and tear gas canisters, injuring two Palestinians by rubber-coated rounds and causing many cases of suffocation from gas inhalation. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
  - A Palestinian young man was shot dead by Israeli settlers at Nabi Samuel junction in occupied Jerusalem. The family of Hussein Khaled Qaraq, 30, said Israeli settlers opened gunfire at their son while he was driving his vehicle at the junction, critically injuring him. The young man was pronounced dead a few minutes later. Qaraq is married, and is a father of two children, his family said. He is a resident of Al-Isawiya neighborhood in occupied Jerusalem. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
  - Israeli police cracked down on an anti-house-demolition sit-in in the East Jerusalem neighborhood of Silwan. Following the conclusion of the Friday midday prayer, a sizable police force barged their way into a building at the imminent threat of demolition in Wadi Qaddum neighborhood, dispersed the participants in the sit-in using volleys of tear gas canisters and concussion grenades to disperse them and removed a Palestine flag from the site. Dozens of Silwan residents performed their Friday prayer in front of the building, which comprises 13 residential apartments, as a means to protest the demolition order. If carried out, the demolition would result in the displacement of 100 people, including a large number of children. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
  - Israeli forces cracked down on anti-settlement rallies in Beit Dajan village, east of the West Bank city of Nablus, causing dozens to suffocate. Israeli

- forces used fatal violence to disperse a rally to defend Palestinian-owned land threatened with confiscation, east of the village, to make room for the construction of a new colonial settlement, showering them with concussion bombs and tear gas canisters. Scores of protestors for tear gas suffocation at the scene. Another who sustained hand burns after being struck by a canister. (Wafa 10 February 2023)
- Several Israeli army vehicles invaded the northern West Bank city of Jenin, stormed and ransacked homes leading to protests before shooting a young man and abducting another. Many army jeeps invaded the Eastern and the Al-Almaniyya Neighborhoods in Jenin, leading to protests before the soldiers fired many live rounds, rubber-coated steel bullets, and gas bombs. The soldiers shot a young man with a live round in the thigh. The soldiers also stormed and ransacked many homes, causing damage, and abducted a young man Waqqas Saba'na. Undercover forces first infiltrated Jenin before breaking into homes and using their rooftops as firing posts. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
  - A young Palestinian man was injured after an Israeli military jeep rammed his motorcycle near the Al-Jalama military roadblock northeast of Jenin in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The army jeeps chased the Palestinian motorcycle and rammed into it, causing it to crash and wounding the driver. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
  - The Israeli soldiers abducted Ahmad Walweel, 18, near the eastern entrance of Qalqilia, in the northern West Bank. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
  - Israeli navy ships attacked Palestinian fishing boats, abducted two fishermen, and confiscated fishing gear in the northern part of the besieged Gaza Strip. The navy ships fired live rounds and gas bombs at Palestinian fishing boats in the Al-Waha and As-Sudaniyya areas and near Beit Lahia, in the northern part of the Gaza Strip. The attack led to property damage but did not result in injuries among the Palestinian fishermen. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
  - The Israeli navy abducted two fishermen in a separate attack in northern Gaza and confiscated their fishing gear before moving them to an unknown destination. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)

## Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli soldiers issued halt construction orders targeting eleven Palestinian homes and a farm near Nablus and Jenin in the West Bank's northern parts. Several army vehicles invaded Douma village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, and handed halt-construction orders for eight homes and a farm. The homes in Douma are owned by Ezzeddin Qais Dawabsha, Anwar Fawzi Salawda, Mamoun Rashid Dawabsha (three-story home), Hazem Abdul-Jalil Dawabsha (two-story home), Amin Rashid Dawabsha, Mohammad Nidal Dawabsha (three-story home), Ibrahim Abdul-Razeq Dawabsha, and another home owned by a Palestinian from Hizam town, near Jerusalem, and the farm is owned by Ibrahim Abdul-Razeq Dawabsha. (IMEMC 10 February 2023)
- In Jenin, the Israeli army handed halt construction orders targeting two homes owned by Jamal and his brother Hisham Abu Farha, near the main entrance of Al-Jamala village, northeast of Jenin. The soldiers also ordered ten Palestinians to remove their commercial stands on the Jenin-Nazareth Roadblock for, according to the army, being "too close to the Al-Jalama roadblock." (IMEMC 10 February 2023)

## Other

- The Israeli army minister Yoav Gallant signed an order imposing economic sanctions on 87 Jerusalem residents who received funds from the Palestinian Authority. According to Gallant office, the order would seize the funds, totaling millions of shekels, paid by the Palestinian Authority to current and released prisoners, for their time in jail. Meanwhile, Israel's National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir ordered police to prepare for "Operation Defensive Shield 2," referring to the extensive military operation carried out in the West Bank during the second intifada. Opposition leader MK Yair Lapid reacted to Ben-Gvir's plans on Twitter: "The Minister of TikTok and pita [bread] "ordered" to start the Defensive Shield 2 operation. No cabinet, no assessment of the situation, no coordination between the security forces. If it wasn't dangerous, it would be ridiculous. Just like him." This came shortly after a Palestinian motorist was shot and killed after he slammed his car into a bus stop in Occupied Jerusalem. Two Jewish settlers died in the incident, while several others were injured, three of them in critical condition. Israeli police stormed the motorist's family house in

Issawiya town and arrested four of his family members, including his wife.
