## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine 7 February 2023

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and threats in the occupied demolition Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, settlers violence the Israeli against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and \or news sources.

## Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

Israeli soldiers killed a Palestinian child in Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Several armored military vehicles invaded Nablus, leading to protests before the soldiers fired a barrage of live fire, rubber-coated steel bullets, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. The soldiers killed Hamza Amjad Al-Ashqar, 17, from Askar Al-Jadid refugee camp in Nablus, after shooting him with a live round in the face. The soldiers shot the child when the military vehicles were withdrawing from the Housing Projects area in Nablus. The soldiers also shot six Palestinians, including one who suffered serious wounds, and caused at least three to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. The soldiers attacked one of its ambulances and stopped medics while rushing to provide aid to wounded Palestinians. (IMEMC 7 February 2022)

## Israeli Settler Violence

• Dozens of Jewish settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. At least 71 settlers entered the Mosque in groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police protection. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount, and a number of them performed Talmudic prayers in the eastern area of the Mosque. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement and entry restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's Other. (PALINFO 7 February 2023)
