



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

20 November 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli settler while crossing the main Jerusalem-Hebron road (Israeli bypass Road 60), opened fire at Nimer Alkam's funeral in Beit Ummar town north of Hebron city, where Palestinians responded by throwing stones at the settler who was firing his gun at them randomly. As a result, Israeli soldiers re-closed the entrance of the town and prevented residents from entering or leaving it. Furthermore, one of the Israeli soldiers fired tear gas bomb inside a Palestinian vehicle owned by Ibrahim Ibregith, took over his car and used it as a shield during the confrontations with the Palestinians.

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided 2 Palestinian houses in Beit Ummar town north of Hebron, occupied their roofs and turned them to military posts
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Yazid Mohamad Yousef Al Nawaj'a (25 years old) from Yatta town south of Hebron city, after storming his house and messing with the contents. Also the IOA raided Nuba, Halhul, Ras Al Joura and Faresh Al Hawa communities in Hebron city. Furthermore, the Israeli occupation troops set up a military checkpoint at the entrance of An Nabi Yunis and Wad Qaboun area.
- Official sources indicated that the Israeli government gave the green light to settlements' associations to seize Palestinian properties (houses and lands) in Jerusalem, most specifically in the Old City of Jerusalem, Silwan, Ras Al 'Amoud, Wadi Al Jouz and Ash Sheikh Jarrah. The campaign will include taking control of Samrin House in Wadi Hilwa (Hilwa Valley) in Silwan city, located few meters away from Al Aqsa Mosque and the houses of Zalloum family in As Sa'diyya neighborhood in the old city of Jerusalem. The associations will attempt to give money to Palestinian owners to voluntarily leave the houses and in case of refusal; the associations, with the help of Israeli settlers, will forcibly control the properties

Erection of Israeli Checkpoints

- The Israeli occupation troops set up a military checkpoint at the entrance of Rummana and Zububa villages west of Jenin city.

Uprooting & Destruction of fruit trees

- Israeli settlers of Yizhar settlement destroyed 20 olive trees owned by Mashir Rezek Qadous in Khalayel Abu Toffah area south of Burin village in Nablus Governorate.
- Israeli settlers of Revava settlement flooded waste water into the lands of Faris Daoud from Deir Istiya village, causing the destruction of 20

olive trees and another 100 olive trees in his land were flooded with wastewater.
