



Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

3 December 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided Hai Abu Zaytona in Ash Shawawra village east of Bethlehem city, stormed the house of Mahmud Issa Rabae'a and handed him notification to interview the Israeli intelligence in Gush Etzion settlement bloc west of Bethlehem city.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Yaser Ibrahim Badrsawi (45 years old) from Balata refugee camp and took him to an unknown destination.

Israeli Settlers Violence

- The Israeli settlers attacked and beat Najeh Abd Al Kader (60 years old) while he was working in his land from Salem village east of Nablus city.

Expansion of Settlements

- The Israeli regional committee for planning and construction at the Israeli Municipality of Jerusalem ratified the construction of 625 units in Pisgat Ze'ev settlement north of Jerusalem city under plan number 11647.
