Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt 21 January 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided the house of Mohammad Ikhilil and arrested his son Muhammad (19 years old) from Beit Ummar town north of Hebron city and took him to unknown destination.
- The Israeli Air Force shelled at an open area in Rafah town south of Gaza Strip leading to no injuries.

Others

- An Israeli court in Jerusalem city has issued an injunction to freeze construction of the Talmudic gardens(A-11092) on 740 dunums of land in al-Tour and al-Issawiyyeh villages. The decision follows a petition by the Jerusalem Center for Legal Assistance and Human Rights, and it demands a response from the municipality and environmental authority by February
