



## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

13 November 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

### Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army suppressed Al Walaja demonstrations, arrested Mazin Qumsieh and Mustafa Al Jori and took them to unknown destination. The IOA fired tear gas bombs at protesters demonstrating in Al Walaja, causing injuries to Mahmud Khalifa (60 years old), Mo'ad Muhammad Odeh (18 years old) and Nadi Awdallah.
- The Israeli Occupation Army arrested Fayez Hatim 'Abidi (14 years old) from Bruqin village at a flying checkpoint that was erected near Arraba village junction and checked his ID card. Furthermore, the IOA

arrested Mahmud Atieh (20 years old) from B'ir Ayoub neighborhood in Silwan town.

- The Israeli Occupation Army raided the house of Smoud Karja (23 years old) in Saffa village west of Ramallah city, handed her notification to interview the Israeli Intelligence in Ofar military camp west of Ramallah.

### **Israeli Military Orders**

- The Israeli Occupation Army handed Ahmad Smireen family from Wadi Hewla in Silwan town an order issued by the Jerusalem Municipality stating to detain his own vehicle and salary in an attempt to drive him out of his house and bring settlers of El 'Ad settlement movement to live in the house instead. The family was ordered to leave the house by 28<sup>th</sup> of November 2011. It is worth to point out that Al Ad settlers occupied the land that belongs to the family.
