



## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

14, 15 October 2011

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

### Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli occupation Army searched Palestinian houses in Yatta town south of Hebron Governorate where they were known; Jihad Khaleel Abu 'Abeed, and Rateb Mohammad 'Atieh Al Mhanieh, mess with contents after detaining their families and children in one small room.
- Israeli occupation Army stopped and beat Ahmad Ibrahim Qantor from Jerusalem city while passing near the entrance of Al Walajeh village northwest of Bethlehem city. Ahmad was taken to hospital after the attack.

- The Israeli occupation Army closed the main entrance of Beit Ummar town and stopped Palestinian cars, checked the ID cards and prevented the citizens from entering and exiting to and from the town

### **Israeli settlers Violence**

- Israeli settlers attacked number of Palestinian citizens while harvesting olive trees forcing them to leave their lands in 'Azmoote village in Nablus city. Furthermore, the Israeli forces hindered residents of Burin town and Qaryout village south of Nablus city from harvesting their olive trees.
- Hundred of Israeli settlers with the protection of Israeli Army raided Sha'ab Salman and Al Nahleh area in the lands of I'rtas village south Bethlehem city to establish military base.
- Al-Aqsa Organization for Waqf and Heritage revealed that a number of Israeli settlers extremists set fire to a large trees and destroying about 15 graves in Ma'man Allah Islamic cemetery in East Jerusalem. Furthermore, destroyed 15 tomb or parts of graves in different parts of the cemetery. Tens of Israeli settlers attacked residents of Iraq Burin south west of Nablus city while they were harvesting their olive trees .
- Israelis settlers of Nira settlement set fire to dozens of dunums of lands planted with olives, almonds trees in Ras Karkar village northwest of Ramallah. Burned 120 olive trees owned by Adnan Fkhida, No'man Nofel, Hafeth Sha'ban and Mohammad Dauod Soboh. The Israeli Army also hindered the land owners from reaching their lands to extinguish the fire.

### **Erection of Outpost**

- Israeli settlers razed on Friday Palestinian agricultural lands in Qenieh area located between Eskaka and Yasouf towns east of Salfit Governorate and put 6 caravans in the outpost located south Kfar Tapuah(est. 1978, pop.867). Where the number of caravans became in the area 11.

## **Expansion of Settlements**

- Plan no. [14295](#) was deposited for public review, for the construction of 2,610 housing units in a new neighborhood in East Jerusalem called "Givat Hamatos" East of Beit Safafa. This plan is the reparcellation scheme that enables the implementation of plan no. 5834A which was deposited three years ago and caused controversy.
