Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

21 June 2012

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) raided a number of Houses in 'Aqqaba village in Tubas Governorate, searched them and messed with their contents. Of the targeted houses, the following were known: The house of Khader Seqqi Sawafta, Muhammad Ibrahim Abu 'Arra, Raed Mustafa Abu 'Arra, Firas Muhammad Abu 'Arra, Hatem Muhammad Abu 'Arra and Basem Muhammad Abu 'Arra. The IOA also took photos of Mahmoud Hasan Abu 'Arra's house after raiding it and messing with its contents. Wafa (June 21, 2012).

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) seized a number of water tanks and agricultural tractors in Wadi Al Maleh area in the northern valleys. Wafa (June 21, 2012).
- Around Tens Israeli military Jeeps raided Dura town south of Hebron city and toured in the alleys and streets. Clashes erupted between the Israeli Army and Palestinians in the area. Safa (June 21, 2012).

Israeli Arrests

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested six Palestinian fishermen in As Sudaniya area northwest of Gaza City. The Israeli army (IO) forced the fishermen to take off their clothes, swim towards the Israeli boats and then transferred them to Ashdod detention and interrogation center. The Arrestees are: Fadel Saleh Abu Warda, Nu'man As Seksek, Abed Subhi Sa'adallah, Mahmoud Muhammad Abu Warda, Hazem Saleh Abu Warda and Muhammad Matar Khallah. Wafa (June 21, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested citizens Melad Hamdallah Dahdoul and Muhannad Fawzi Az Zeir from Salfit city and took them to unknown destination. Wafa (June 21, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested citizen Ubeida Hashem Al Hadmi (33 years) from Shuyoukh Al 'Arroub north of Hebron city after raiding his house and messing with its contents. Mr. Al Hadmi was taken to unknown destination. Wafa (June 21, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Dia' Ghneimat from Sureef village west of Hebron, a student in Hebron University. Safa (June 21, 2012).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) renewed the administrative detention of prisoner Hasan Zaher As Safadi from Nablus city for another six months. Safa (June 21, 2012).

Israeli Settlers' Violence

- Clashes erupted between Israeli settlers and Palestinians as more than 2000 Israeli settlers raided Joseph tomb east of Nablus city and practiced religious rituals. PNN (June 21, 2012).

Erection of Israeli checkpoints

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) set up an iron gate at the entrance of Al Salayma neighborhood in Hebron city. This new gate will threaten the entry and exit of Palestinians to and from the neighborhood. Safa (June 21, 2012).
