## Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

01 September 2015

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

### Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation gunboats opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing at As-Sudaniya shore, northwest of Gaza city, and at Al Waha shore, northwest of Beit Lahiya town. (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) and bulldozers staged few meters into the eastern part of Ash-Shuaja'iyah neighborhood, east of Gaza city, razed land and opened fire at houses and land. (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)

- Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) near Rachel tomb, north of Bethlehem city. (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Jenin city and Jenin refugee camp. Clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired rubber bullets and teargas grenades at Palestinians and houses, causing dozens of suffocation cases and the injury of 6 people. During the operation, the IOA surrounded a Palestinian house and arrested its owner; Majdi Abu Al Hija' (45 years), then they demolished the house. (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded a Palestinian building in Um Ash-Sharaiyet neighborhood in Al Bireh city. As a result, clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA. (RB2000 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected a tent at Palestinian land in Aqraba village, southeast of Nablus city. The IOA took photos for the surrounded land. (Wafa 1 September 2015)

### **Israeli Arrests**

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 4 Palestinians after storming and searching their houses in the old city of Jerusalem. The arrestees were identified as: Shadi Musa Marqasto (15 years), Amir Qatenah, Yousif Abed Al Mute Hazenah (15 years) and Murad Abu Sobeh. (SilwanIC 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ramzi Ar-Rajabi after raiding and searching his house in Shufat refugee camp, north of Jerusalem city. (SilwanIC 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after stopping them at one of Al Aqsa mosque gate in the old city of Jerusalem. (SilwanIC 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Thair Nizar Tmizi (24 years) and his brother Mohammad (22 years) from Idhna town in Hebron governorate, after stopping them at Al Container military checkpoint. (Pal Today 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Salah Bassem At-Tamimi and his wife Narmeen from An-Nabi Saleh village in Ramallah governorate, after stopping them at a military checkpoint erected by the IOA at the entrance of An Nabi Saleh village. (Pal Today 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Bashar Mahmoud Shtiwi (26 years) after storming and searching his house in Kafr Qaddum village, east of Qalqiliya city. (Maannews 1 September 2015)

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested 6 Palestinians and summoned Hamza Ahmed Khalil Abu Hisham to interview the Israeli Intelligence Police, after raiding their houses in several areas in Beit Ummer town. The arrestees were identified as: Maisar Sadeq Abu Mariya (34 years), Sharef Fathi Abu 'Ayesh (23 years), Muhannad Abed Arar (18 years), Mohammad Jamal Abu Hisham (16 years), Muayyad Hussien At-Tit and Ashraf Khalid Sabarnah (21 years). (Al-Quds & Maannews 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians from Zawata village, northwest of Nablus city. The arrestees were identified as: Shadad Shaher Abu 'Amsha (32 years) and Mohammad Thabit Abu 'Amsha (42 years). (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ishaq Abed Al Aziz Ashqar after stopping him at Za'tara military checkpoint, south of Nablus city. (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Mahmoud Ja'ara (16 years) after raiding and searching his family house in Ayda refugee camp, north of Bethlehem city. (Al-Quds 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinian sellers while they were crossing Beit Hanun terminal, north of Gaza strip. The arrestees were identified as: Tamir Al Barem and Khalid Baraka. (Maannews 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four Palestinians from Aqbat Jaber refugee camp, south of Jericho city. The arrestees were identified as: Fakhir Awadat (52 years) and his son Sadam (20 years), Mohammad Bassam Hamidat (20 years) and Ra'fat Mahmoud Atta. (Raya 1 September 2015)

### **Israeli Settler Violence**

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city and toured in its courtyard. AT the same time, the IOA prevented Palestinians from entering the mosque and arrested three Palestinians; two of them were identified as: Abada Najeb and Mohamad Az-Za'tari (Maannews 1 September 2015)

### **Erection of Outposts**

- The far-right settler group Ateret Cohanim occupied a Palestinian house in Baten Al Hawa neighborhood in Silwan town in Jerusalem city. The targeted house is owned by Sarhan family. In the early morning a group of Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed the neighborhood and destroyed the main door

of the targeted house and occupied it. Noted that the targeted house located near a building occupied by the Israeli settlers a week ago. As a result, clashes erupted between Palestinians and the IOA, where the IOA fired teargas grenades at Palestinians and houses, causing dozens of suffocation cases. During the clashes, the IOA arrested Samah Sarhan and Maher Sarhan. (SilwanIC 1 September 2015)

### **Erection of Israeli checkpoints**

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected military checkpoints at the northern entrance of Hebron city, and at the entrances of Halhul and Sair towns. The IOA stopped and searched Palestinian vehicles and checked ID cards. (ARN 1 August 2015)

### **Israeli Closures**

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) closed for few hours the main road link between Salfit city and Biddya village, northwest of Salfit city. (RB2000 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Authorities decided to close the Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron on the 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2015, in front of the Palestinians, to allow the Israeli settlers to storm it. (PNN 1 September 2015)
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) prevented dozens of Palestinian students from At-Tur town in Jerusalem city from reaching their schools after they closed Suliman Al Faresi road with cement bloc. The targeted road consider the main entrance and road which links to three schools in the town. (Maannews 1 September 2015)

### **Other**

- After consultations between the Ministry of the Interior, finance and other relevant departments in the promotion of the fundamental law, which considers Jerusalem the capital of Israel, the occupation's municipality decides 260 million shekels to support the economy, education and other aspects of the city, as well as to strengthen the security in the city. Interior Minister; Silvan Shalom seeks to strengthen Jerusalem as the capital of the State of Israel, " adding that he would seek support Jerusalem's social and economic infrastructure and other areas. Where they decided to grant additional budget to the Jerusalem municipality with \$ 57.5 million shekels. (Maannews 1 September 2015)
