Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

06 December 2016

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

The daily report does not necessarily reflect ARIJ's opinion.

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) seized two tractors, belonging to Muwaffaq Daraghmeh and Ahmed Abu Diab Khiezran. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) turned Yasser Mezhir house in Deir Nidham village northwest of Ramallah city, into a military base, and raised the Israeli flag on it. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) Stormed the wall resistance and settlement body 's headquarters in the old town of Hebron. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- The Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) Stormed Idhna village, west of Hebron city and searched several houses owned by: Mohamed Fadl Alasod, Ismail Alntah, Mohammed Abu Mtaleg Jehahh and Mahmoud Ali Abu Jehahh. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- The Israeli Occupation gunboats opened fire at Palestinian fishing boats while they were sailing at the northwest of Gaza shores. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

Israeli Arrests

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Abdulla Ammar Rkabban (22 years), after raiding and searching his house in Ad Duheisha Refugee Camp, south of Bethlehem city. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Rizk Rajoub after raiding and searching his house in Dura village, west of Hebron city. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested six Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Nablus city. The arrestees were identified as: Elias Dweikat, Ammar al-Jasser Dweikat, Ahad Sirhan Dweikat, Montasser Sirhan Dweikat, Muhammad Mazen Dweikat and Said Nabil Dweikat. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Jibreen Dhiyab Al Jiyawi (58 years), after raiding and searching his house and confiscated money and gold jewelers, in Idhna village, west of Hebron city. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two Palestinians after raiding and searching their houses in Jericho city. The arrestees were identified as: Sabrin Mohammed Ghawanmeh (25 years) and Sulaiman Sweilim Ghawanmeh (60 years). (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested four fishermen from the sea northwest of the Gaza Strip, and confiscated their boat. The arrestees were identified as : Majid Baker (55 years), Imran Majid Baker (27 years), Muhammad Ziyad Bakr (26 years) and Khalil Joohr Baker (22 years). (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested two students, Ibrahim Deek (12 years) and Arif Ghassan (12 years), from As Sawiya village, south of Nablus city, after they assaulted them, (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Ahmed Ismail Salah (22 years) from Al Khader village, west of Bethlehem city. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) arrested Hisham Younis Hassan Abu Zayed (52 years), and works trader residents from Az Zawayda village west of Deir al Balah governorate. On Beit Hanoun "Erez" terminal. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Military occupation court "Ofer" proven administrative detention for four months against the prisoners: Ala Bani Shamsa, Mao'man Fshavhh, Raafat Asfour, as was proved the administrative detention against Mohammad Zreik for three months. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) stormed Al Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem city, and they tried to perform Talmudic rituals in its courtyard. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli settlers accompanied by Israeli forces have bulldozed agricultural land with an area of 40 dunums in Jalud village, southeast of Nablus city, returning to Ahmed Nasser Al Haj Mohammed. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli Occupation bulldozers demolished a Palestinian residential building, consist of two floors, 300 square meters house in Silwan village, south of Jerusalem city. The targeted building is owned by Sa'id Abbasi and his brother. Noted that the targeted building inhabited by 12 family members. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli bulldozers demolished houses in Fasayil village, north of Jericho city, returning to Abdul Hadi Ali Hussein Abayat, Adnan Ibrahim Abu Kharabeesh and Mahmoud Zaid Ibrahim Abu Kharabeesh. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
- Israeli bulldozers demolished stable, for the second time, in Silwan village south of Jerusalem city, owned by Alaa Issa Shweiki, and confiscated an Arabian horse costs 350,000 shekels. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

Confiscation & Razing of lands

- Israeli bulldozers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) razed land in the southern part of Hebron city. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

- Israeli bulldozers escorted by the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) razed land in Al Fureidis village, south of Bethlehem city. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

Erection of checkpoints

- Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) erected several checkpoints at the entrances of Adh Dhahiriya and Sa'ir villages and Al 'Arrub Refugee camp in Hebron governorate, searched the citizens vehicles and checked their ID cards and hindered their movement. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).

Other

- Jerusalem Municipality announced that it has put up the blue line's plan of the light train for approval, after several amendments were made, especially, adding a section reaching the "Iemiq Rafeem" area, southwest of Jerusalem city, in order to connect the Israeli settlements in the northeast of Jerusalem with the southern settlements. According to this plan, the track will extend to 23 km, and will connect Ramot in the north, through the city center, with the Gilo and Al Malha areas. 42 waiting stations will be built every 500 meters of the path, the train will run about 90 trolleys to serve 250,000 passengers a day. Also, there are two more main routs of the light train, 23 km and 19 km respectively and many of secondary routs with total length up to 65 km in the proposed plans to connect the Israeli settlements in east Jerusalem with each other. All of these procedures aim to join the eastern part of Jerusalem with the other parts. (Wafa, 06 December 2016).
