Israeli Violations' Activities in the oPt

7 December 2019

Brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israel, released to Jordan, the body of a the Palestinian prisoner who recently died in Israeli custody, due to deliberate medical negligence custody. The Israeli occupation authorities handed over the body of Sami Abu Diak, who died on November 26 in Israeli prison. The Israeli occupation authorities have handed over Abu Diak's body to Jordan through the King Hussein border crossing following his family's request. Abu Diak's body was transferred to the King Hussein Medical Center in the Jordanian capital, Amman. Abu Diak, 36, suffered from terminal cancer, Israel refused to give him compassionate, leave to be with his family, as well as his last dying wish to spend his last days with his mother. Abu Diak first complained of abdominal pain in 2015, and was treated with painkillers, until two weeks later, he was transferred to the Israeli Soroka hospital after losing consciousness. Abu Diak underwent surgery to remove parts of his intestines at that time, and was diagnosed with cancer, he then underwent other surgical procedures that reportedly left him unconscious for more than one month.
