Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

19 November 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians during protests that erupted after several army jeeps invaded the al-'Isawiya town, in the occupied Palestinian capital, Jerusalem. The Palestinians were protesting the death of a teenage boy who was killed by the (IOA). Medical sources in Jerusalem said the local medics provided treatment to 17 Palestinians who were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets to various parts of their bodies. It added that the medics also provided treatment to eleven Palestinians who suffered burns from Israeli gas bombs and concussion grenades, in addition to thirteen who fell while the soldiers were chasing them; two of the wounded suffered fractures to their extremities. It also said that the medics provided treatment to 95 Palestinians, including women and children, who suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians during a protest in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. Palestinians marched, after performing noon prayers, towards the Bab az-Zawiya area in Hebron city, while chanting against the ongoing Israeli occupation, its settlement activities, and constant violations. The IOA fired dozens of gas bombs and concussion grenades and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters, in addition to surrounding homes and stores, while local youngsters hurled stones at them. At least two Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation in addition to cuts and bruises. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)
- In Tulkarem, in northern West Bank, the Israeli Occupation Army (IOA) invaded Allar town, north of the city, and detained Mohammad Hosni Asrawi, 23, after storming his home and ransacking it. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)

- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) abducted a Palestinian man from his shop in Beit Kahil town, northwest of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. (MEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) invaded the village of al-Hashimiyya, south of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, and searched a home. The (IOA) stormed and ransacked the home of Khaled Hussin al-Fayed, causing damage. They added that the (IOA) interrogated the Palestinian and his family for a few hours, before leaving the property, and withdrew from the village. (MEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured many Palestinians in Kufur Qaddoum, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, during the weekly procession. Morad Eshteiwi, the coordinator of the Popular Committee against the Annexation Wall & Colonies in Kufur Qaddoum, said the Palestinians marched from the center of the town while carrying Palestinian flags and chanting for ending the illegal Israeli occupation. He added that the (IOA) attacked the protesters with rubber-coated steel bullets and dozens of gas bombs, causing many to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation. (MEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured dozens of Palestinians during a protest in Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The (IOA) also abducted a young man near Tulkarem. The Palestinians marched, after performing noon prayers, towards the Bab az-Zawiya area in Hebron city, while chanting against the ongoing illegal Israeli occupation, its colonialist activities, and constant violations. They added that the (IOA)s fired dozens of gas bombs and concussion grenades and rubber-coated steel bullets at the protesters, in addition to surrounding homes and stores, while local youngsters hurled stones at them. At least two Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets, and dozens suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation in addition to cuts and bruises. (MEMC 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) used fatal violence to disperse a rally called for to protest the construction of the new colonial settlement of Givat Eviatar atop Jabal Sabih (Sabih Mountain), near Beita, as well as the

- seizure of lands belonging to the villagers of Beita, Huwarra, and Za'tara to inaugurate a new settler-only bypass road. (Wafa 19 November 2021)
- The Israeli occupation army (IOA) suppressed an anti-land-pillage rally in Beita town and Beit Dajan village, south and east of the West Bank city of Nablus, injuring some 20 people. The (IOA) used fatal violence to disperse a rally called for to protest the construction of the new colonial settlement of Givat Eviatar atop Jabal Sabih (Sabih Mountain), near Beita, as well as the seizure of lands belonging to the villagers of Beita, Huwarra, and Za'tara to inaugurate a new settler-only bypass road. (Wafa 19 November 2021)
 - The Israeli occupation army (IOA) injured 38 Palestinians during the weekly processions in Beita and Beit Dajan, south and east of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The IOA shot three Palestinians with rubber-coated steel bullets and caused twenty-four others to suffer the effects of teargas inhalation, in addition to four who sustained cuts and bruises, during protests in Sbeih Mountain, threatened by Israeli settlers. Seven Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation during the protests in Beit Dajan village. (IMEMC 19 November 2021)

Israeli Settler Violence

- Israeli settlers slashed the tires of nearly a dozen Palestinian-owned vehicles in Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood in Occupied Jerusalem. A group settlers stormed a fenced-off area of Sheikh Jarrah before stabbing the tires of 13 parked cars, including one with diplomatic license plates. The cars belong to Palestinians from the local families of Shreiteh and al-Bashiti, and al-Ghazzawi, in addition to one car owned by a Palestinian who lives near the neighborhood. (PALINFO 19 November 2021)
- Several Israeli settlers hurled stones at many Palestinian cars, near Azzoun town, east of the northern West Bank city of Qalqilia, causing damage. (PALINFO 19 November 2021)

Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- The Israeli municipal authorities forced the Burqan family to self-demolish their house in Ras Al-Amoud neighborhood in Silwan, in Occupied Jerusalem. The Israeli authorities ordered the Burqan family to self-demolish their two-story home. The family, which consists of a couple and six children, was struggling to obtain an Israeli building permit over the past 20 years. (PALINFO 19 November 2021)

Other

- The Palestinian Civil Affairs Authority has reported, Friday, that Israel intends to transfer the corpse of a Palestinian woman who was killed by Israeli soldiers in Jerusalem, on September 30. (Wafa 19 November 2021)
