Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

20 December 2021

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli occupation Army

- Israeli forces shot and injured, two Palestinians, one seriously, in the central West Bank the village of al-Mazraa al-Gharbiyeh, northwest of Ramallah, according to Palestinian Security sources. The army opened fire with live rounds, shooting and seriously injuring an unidentified 19-year-old youth in the back. The young man was transferred to hospital for emergency treatment, his condition was reported as critical. Meanwhile, Israeli troops fired rubber-coated steel rounds, injuring a 17-year-old child in the hand, neither the condition or identity of the teen was known at the time of this report. - Several Israeli military vehicles, including bulldozers, invaded Palestinian farmlands, Monday, east of Khan Younis, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip. Media sources said six military vehicles, including armored bulldozers and Merkava tanks, invaded the Palestinian farmlands east of the al-Fakhari area, east of Khan Younis, and advanced dozens of meters. They added that the soldiers bulldozed the lands, and installed sand hills near the perimeter fence, in addition to firing smoke bombs and live rounds to force the Palestinian farmers away. - Israeli soldiers detained and interrogated, a Palestinian man and his son, and in Masafer Yatta, south of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The soldiers summoned for interrogated Mahmoud Hamada and his son, Moath, after storming their home and ransacking it. He added that, two days ago, the soldiers invaded farmlands owned by Mahmoud, before confiscating his tractor. (IMEMC 20 December 2021)
- Israeli soldiers injured, sixty-seven Palestinians during protests that erupted after the army invaded Burqa village, northwest of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. Fifteen Palestinians were shot with rubber-coated steel bullets. 52 Palestinians were also injured due to the effects of tear gas inhalation, in addition to cuts and bruises. The invasion took place shortly after illegal Israeli colonizers hurled stones at Palestinian cars in the area, wounding four Palestinians and causing damage to the vehicles. Israeli Settler Violence

- Illegal Israeli colonizers attacked a Palestinian home and two cars in Kufur Qaddoum town, east of Qalqilia, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. The colonizers hurled stones at the home and the car of Nasser Darwish Barham, in the western area of the town, causing property damage. The colonizers also caused damage to the car of another Palestinian, identified as Maher Fathi Jom'a. The attacked properties are near the illegal Kedumim Israeli colony, which was built on stolen Palestinian lands. (IMEMC 20 December 2021)
- Dozens of Jewish settlers escorted by police forces desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem. At least 85 settlers entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under tight police protection. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (PALINFO 20 December 2021)

House Demolition and Demolition Threats

- Dozens of Israeli soldiers invaded, Siolet al-Harhiya town, west of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, took measurements of four Palestinian homes in preparation for demolishing them. More than twenty Israeli military vehicles invaded the town before the soldiers stormed and ransacked the home of Ahmad Mohammad Jaradat. Several Israeli army sharpshooters took positions on the rooftop of the house before Palestinian resistance fighters exchange fire with the invading forces. The soldiers took measurements of the invaded property in preparation for demolishing it later; the army has not yet set a date for demolishing the property. The Israeli soldiers invaded the home of Mohammad Gheith in Siolet al-Harhiya town, west of the northern West Bank city of Jenin and took measurements of the property in preparation for demolishing it. The Israeli soldiers invaded the homes of two political prisoners, identified as Ibrahim Mousa Tahaina and Mahmoud Ghaleb Jaradat in Siolet al-Harhiya town, west of the northern West Bank city of Jenin, and also took

measurements of the properties in preparation for demolishing them. The four homes provide shelter for 30 Palestinians, including children and seniors. (IMEMC 20 December 2021)
