



Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

24 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

The Violations are based on reports provided by field workers and/or news sources.

The text is not quoted directly from the sources but is edited for clarity.

Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- On Monday evening, Israeli soldiers abducted a Palestinian man after assaulting him and his mother in front of their home in the Bab az-Zawya area in the center of Hebron city, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. The mother was moved to a hospital in the city. The Palestinian News & Info Agency (Wafa) said the soldiers assaulted Yahia Mohammad Tamimi, 29, and confiscated his mobile phone before attacking his mother, who tried to defend him. The soldiers attacked the young man again and forced him into their jeep before taking him to an unknown destination. Wafa added that Mohammad and his mother, 67 years of age, were walking to a nearby pharmacy to buy medicine for her when the soldiers assaulted them and abducted the young man. Palestinian medics were called to the scene and rushed the wounded mother to the Hebron governmental hospital. (IMEMC 24 October 2022)
- On Monday dawn, Israeli soldiers injured a Palestinian child, closed main roads, and stormed homes, near Jenin, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank. Media sources said several army jeeps invaded the Zababda town south of Jenin, leading to protests before the soldiers fired several live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades. They said one child was injured by bullet shrapnel in the head and was moved to Jenin governmental hospital. Furthermore, the army closed the three entrances of Jaba' town, near Jenin, before the soldiers invaded it and occupied rooftops to use as sniper posts and monitoring towers. Also, many Palestinians protested an invasion of the main area of the Ejja nearby town, especially after the soldiers installed a military roadblock on its southern entrance. (IMEMC 24 October 2022)
- Israeli gunboats opened machinegun fire at Palestinian fishermen while working on Sunday evening off the northern Gaza Strip coast. Local sources said that soldiers aboard the gunboats fired live bullets and teargas canisters at the Palestinian fishermen working off al-Sudaniya and al-Waha in northern Gaza forcing them to return ashore. Israeli navy boats harass Palestinian fishermen off the Gaza coast on a semi-daily basis, which threatens their only livelihood. Since the start of 2022, Israeli navy forces

- arrested 49 fishermen and injured many others in similar attacks. (PALINFO 24 October 2022)
- Several Palestinians were injured on Monday after Israeli occupation forces (IOF) fired tear gas bombs and stun grenades at Palestinian citizens southeast of the West Bank city of Bethlehem. Local sources reported that a number of Palestinian young men suffered breathing problems after clashes erupted between IOF soldiers and Palestinian youths at the northern entrance of Taquu town southeast of Bethlehem. The sources added that Israeli soldiers blocked the iron gate established at the northern entrance of Taquu town, in addition to setting up a military checkpoint at the western entrance of the town, which restricted the movement of Palestinian citizens. Meanwhile, Israeli soldiers disguised as Arabs kidnapped two Palestinian ex-prisoners from Al-Lubban al-Gharbiya village west of the West Bank city of Ramallah while they were heading to their work in a nearby village. Moreover, IOF soldiers blocked the entrance of Nabi Saleh village northwest of Ramallah, while Israeli military vehicles razed Palestinian-owned lands adjacent to the military tower established at the entrance of the village. In a related incident, Israeli soldiers sealed off three gates installed along the separation wall, denying Palestinian farmers from Salfit access to their olive groves isolated by the wall. IOF soldiers in the morning hours forced Palestinian farmers from al-Zawiya town in the Salfit governorate to leave their lands in the western area of the town, according to local sources. Palestinian farmers reported that they were shocked when Israeli soldiers stormed their lands and forced them to leave despite the fact that they were granted permits to enter. They added that more than 30 farmers, including women and elderlies, were isolated behind the wall for more than 5 hours while being exposed to the sun. (PALINFO 24 October 2022)

Israeli Settler Violence

- On Monday, illegal Israeli colonizers attacked Palestinian shepherds and international peace activists on Palestinian lands in the Al-Auja town northeast of Jericho in the West Bank, wounding an international activist. In addition, Israeli soldiers invaded a village and confiscated solar panels and equipment. Nonviolent activist against Israel's illegal colonialist activities in Jericho, Ayman Ghrayyeb, said several colonizers hurled stones and assaulted Palestinian shepherds and international peace activists while

- trying to force them out of a grazing area. Ghrayyeb added that one of the colonizers injured an international peace activist and that the colonizers were still in the area, an issue that raises fears of further potential attacks and violations. In related news, Israeli soldiers confiscated tools and equipment for installing solar panels for the Palestinian Bedouin families in the Wadi Al-Faw village in the northern plains of the occupied West Bank. Mo'taz Bisharat, a Palestinian official who monitors Israel's colonialist activities in Tubas, said the soldiers confiscated a trailer loaded with solar panels, equipment, and tools, provided by the Palestinian Energy and Natural Resources Authority to the families in the area. - Furthermore, illegal colonizers invaded Teqoa and hurled stones at home and cars owned by members of the Al-Amour family, causing damage. On Sunday night, the colonizers hurled stones at homes and cars near the main entrance of the Al-Minya village, east of Bethlehem, causing damage. (IMEMC 24 October 2022)
 - Dozens of extremist Jewish settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under tight police protection on Monday morning and later in the afternoon. At least 114 settlers entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard, according to al-Qastal News website. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (PALINFO 24 October 2022)
